**THE TWINS:** After completing their nine-day, seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-0 at Detroit, 0-2 at Milwaukee and 1-2 at San Diego), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a win over the Tigers last night...tonight, the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three against Detroit...later this week, Minnesota will welcome the Blue Jays for four games from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins are 28-22 at home and 26-26 on the road.

**GIO, DAD STRENGTH:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 5-3 in 10 innings at Target Field, recording their seventh walk-off victory this season...Gio Urshela hit the two-run walk-off homer, his first career walk-off home run...Aaron Sanchez was the starter, making his Twins debut, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts...Jharel Cotton (2.2), Joe Smith (0.1), Jhoan Duran (1.0) and Griffin Jax (1.0) combined to allow one unearned run in 5.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded 12 hits, including three from Nick Gordon...Jose Miranda drove in three of the five runs and went 2-for-4...  
 ☞ Urshela's walk-off homer marked the fourth for the Twins this season (Buxton 2x and Miranda 1x), their most walk-off homers since recording four in 2018...the last time they had more than four in a season was 2004 (5)...their record is six, done in 1987.

**TWINS GET LÓPEZ:** The Twins acquired right-handed pitcher Jorge López and cash considerations from the Baltimore Orioles, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Yennier Cano, and minor league left-handed pitchers Cade Povich and Juan Rojas, and right-handed pitcher Juan Nunez...López, who was named to the 2022 AL All-Star team, has gone 4-6, 1.68 ERA (48.1 IP, 9 ER), 19 saves (23 opportunities), 17 walks, 54 strikeouts, a 0.97 WHIP, a .174 opponent batting average, a .529 opponent OPS and just three home runs allowed...the 29-year-old ranks tied for fifth in the AL in saves and second (minimum 45.0 IP) in opponent batting average, third in ERA, fourth in opponent OPS, ninth in WHIP and 15th in strikeouts-per-9.0 IP (10.06)...the Caguas, Puerto Rico native has pitched parts of seven major league seasons with the Brewers, Royals and Orioles, going 16-37, 5.51 ERA (398.1 IP, 244 ER), 155 walks and 351 strikeouts in 146 games (58 starts)...he was originally selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Caguas Military Academy in Caguas, PR.

☞ López allowed four runs (2 homers) on seven hits in 2.2 innings pitched against the Twins this season...against every other team in 2022, he has allowed five earned runs in 45.2 innings pitched (0.99 ERA) with one home run.

**MAHLE TIME:** The Twins acquired right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle from the Cincinnati Reds, in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajar...Mahle, 27, made 19 starts for the Reds this season, going 5-7, 4.40 ERA (104.1 IP, 51 ER), 39 walks, 114 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP and a .232 opponent batting average...in his last nine starts, Mahle (rhymes with rally) has gone 3-2, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER), 16 walks, 64 strikeouts, a .212 opponent batting average and seven quality starts...in 33 starts for the Reds last season, he went 13-6, 3.75 ERA (180.0 IP, 75 ER), 64 walks and 210 strikeouts, while ranking tied for the NL lead in starts and ninth in strikeouts...he has produced a 10.41 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched ratio since the start of 2020, the fifth-best in the NL and 10th-best in baseball among pitchers with a minimum of 300.0 IP in that span...the 6-foot-3, 210-pound right-hander has pitched parts of six seasons with Cincinnati, going 31-38, 4.35 ERA (593.2 IP, 287 ER), 222 walks, 637 strikeouts, a 1.32 WHIP and a .248 opponent batting average...the Newport Beach, California native was originally selected by the Reds in the seventh round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of Westminster High School in Westminster, California.

**HEART OF A LÉON:** The Twins acquired catcher Sandy León from Cleveland in exchange for right-handed pitcher Ian Hamilton...León, 33, has split the 2022 season between Triple-A Louisville (CIN) and Columbus (CLE), combining to hit .226 (19-for-84) with three doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI...he has appeared in eight games with the Guardians this season...the Maracaibo, Venezuela native has played in 510 career major league games over 11 seasons with Washington, Boston, Cleveland, Miami, and the Guardians, combining to hit .211 (306-for-1452) with 57 doubles, two triples, 31 home runs, 141 RBI, 148 runs scored and a .595 OPS...he will report to St. Paul.

**A DAY FUL OF TRADES:** The Twins acquired right-handed pitcher Michael Fulmer from the Detroit Tigers, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Sawyer Gipson-Long...Fulmer, 29, has gone 3-4, 3.20 ERA (39.1 IP, 14 ER), two saves, 18 holds, 20 walks, 39 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP, a .203 opponent batting average, a .580 opponent OPS and just one home run allowed in 41 games...he has held right-handed batters to a .140 (12-for-86) batting average and left-handed batters to a .298 (17-for-57) batting average...his 18 holds are tied for second-most in the AL and tied for fourth-most in baseball...to make room for Fulmer on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Aaron Sanchez for release or assignment.

**MORE ON THE ROSTER:** The Twins have placed outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff on the 10-day Injured List with right wrist inflammation...to replace Kirilloff on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of outfielder Jake Cave from Triple-A St. Paul...Cave has played in 84 games for the Saints, hitting .273 (88-for-322) with 20 doubles, 14 home runs, 57 RBI, 63 runs scored, 43 walks, a .370 on-base percentage, a .509 slugging percentage and an .879 OPS...Cave posted a 49-game on-base streak from May 3-July 8, the third-longest such streak in the minors this season...since May 18, he has hit .304 (68-for-224) with 14 home runs, a .603 slugging percentage and a .990 OPS in 56 games...to make room for Cave on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton for release or assignment...additionally, infielder Miguel Sanó has been transferred to the 60-day IL (left knee inflammation) for Mahle.

**TIGER KINGS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the 15th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 9-5 against Detroit this season, going 6-1 at Target Field and 3-4 at Comerica Park.  
 ☞ The Twins have won 26 of their last 40 over the Tigers and 31 of their last 48.  
 ☞ Jorge Polanco is a career .296 (112-for-378) hitter with 21 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 55 RBI, 29 walks, 52 runs scored and an .815 OPS in 97 games against the Tigers.  
 ☞ Gio Urshela is a career .336 (40-for-119) hitter with an .873 OPS in 38 games against the Tigers...he is hitting .417 (20-for-48) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI and eight runs scored in 13 games vs. the Tigers this season.  
 ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .400 (10-for-25) in eight games vs. the Tigers this season.

**MIRANDA R.O.M.:** Jose Miranda has been voted the American League Rookie of the Month for July...he earned his first career monthly award and is Minnesota's first Rookie of the Month winner since his All-Star teammate Miguel Sanó in August 2015...the 24-year-old posted a slash line of .353/.405/.603 with 13 runs scored, 24 hits, two doubles, five home runs and 19 RBI over 20 games played...he recorded three hits in three consecutive games from July 24-27, becoming the first Twins rookie to post such a streak since Danny Valencia logged four consecutive three-hit games in July 2010...he hit .426 with 20 hits during a 13-game span from July 5-27, scoring 10 runs with six extra-base hits and 15 RBI during the stretch.

**SHORT SLEEVE SUMMER POLO:** Jorge Polanco snapped his 0-for-17 by going 2-for-5 last night...Polo has a career batting average in August of .307 (193-for-629) with 37 doubles, eight triples, 24 home runs, 105 RBI, a .506 slugging percentage and an .858 OPS in 160 games, all his highest of any month.

- ☞ Will make his third start of the season against Detroit (0-0, 2.00 ERA; 9.0 IP, 2 ER) and the 14th of his career (2-3, 3.44 ERA; 68.0 IP, 26 ER).
- ☞ Went 0-2, 11.74 ERA (7.2 IP, 10 ER) in two July starts, after going 2-1, 1.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 5 ER) in six June efforts.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took his second-consecutive loss as the Twins were defeated, 10-4 by the Milwaukee Brewers on July 27 at American Family Field...pitched just 3.0-plus innings and allowed a season-worst six runs (all earned) on three hits, while striking out two and matching his career high with six walks for the second time in three starts...fell behind 3-0 before recording an out, settled down to retire eight of the next 11 batters, then walked the first three hitters in the fourth inning...departed with the bases loaded and nobody out in a 3-3 game; all three (plus 2 more) came around to score off Jharel Cotton, and the Brewers rolled to the victory.

- ☞ Six earned runs allowed were his most since yielding seven on June 11, 2019 at Atlanta (with PIT).
- ☞ Rowdy Tellez' three-run home run in the first inning was the first allowed by Archer this season with runners on base (previous multi-run HR off Archer was a two-run shot by Minnesota's Jorge Polanco on September 4, 2021 at Tropicana Field).
- ☞ Became the first Twins pitcher since Lance Lynn in 2018 to have two six-walk games in one season; prior to Archer's first such outing on June 30 at Cleveland, the last Minnesota pitcher to walk six in a contest was Kyle Gibson on August 8, 2019.
- ☞ Now has four six-walk games in his career (also May 15, 2017 at Cleveland with Tampa Bay and May 26, 2019 vs. Los Angeles-NL with Pittsburgh).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was saddled with the loss on July 17, as the Twins dropped an 11-0 decision to the Chicago White Sox at Target Field in the final game prior to the All-Star Break...blanked the White Sox on two singles (with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts) over his first 4.0 inning and retired the first two batters he faced in the top of the fifth inning on just two pitches, before his day quickly unraveled...allowed the next four batters to reach (1 BB, 3 H) and departed training 2-0 with two on...both runners came around to score, ending his day with a line of 4.2 innings pitched, five hits, four runs (all earned), one walk and the five strikeouts.

- ☞ Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to the game, after having missed the Twins' prior 13 games with left hip tightness (was placed on the IL on July 5, retroactive to July 2).

**VS. THE TIGERS:** Archer is set to make his third start of the season against Detroit, and the 14th of his career...has posted a 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER) in 2022 against the Tigers, while not factoring into the decision in either game (Twins are 1-1)...is 2-3, 3.44 ERA (68.0 IP, 26 ER) lifetime vs. Detroit.

- ☞ Faced the Tigers on May 23 here at Target Field, a game the Twins won, 5-4, on Gio Urshela's walk-off single (4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 4 K).
- ☞ Was excellent on June 2 at Comerica Park (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K)...departed with a 2-1 lead and was in line for the win, before Daz Cameron's two-run home run in the eighth gave Detroit a 3-2 victory.

**ARCHER ON TARGET:** Is 2-1, 3.07 ERA (14.2 IP, 5 ER) with eight hits allowed, six walks and 12 strikeouts in his last three home starts...he pitched the Twins to a 6-0 shutout victory over Colorado on June 25 (5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) and an 8-1 win over New York-AL on June 25 (5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 4 BB, 2 K).

- ☞ In eight home starts overall this season, he is 2-3, 4.13 ERA (32.2 IP, 15 ER) with a .226/.305/.347 opponent slash line (28-for-124 with 9 2B and 2 HR)...in nine road starts, is 0-2, 3.96 ERA (36.1 IP, 16 ER) with a .205/.331/.402 opponent line (27-for-132 with 5 2B and 7 HR).
- ☞ In 14 career starts at Target Field (8 with Minnesota, 5 with Tampa Bay and 1 with Pittsburgh), Archer is 6-3, 3.18 ERA (68.0 IP, 24 ER).

**HOPING FOR MORE EVEN-MONTH SUCCESS:** Archer's 2022 season has rotated between solid and poor months...he is a combined 2-1, 2.13 ERA (42.1 IP, 10 ER) with a .170 opponent batting average (25-for-147) in 10 "even" month starts (April and June) this season...by contrast, he is 0-4, 7.09 ERA (26.2 IP, 21 ER) with a .252 batting average against (30-for-119) in seven "odd" month outings (May and July).

- ☞ June was Archer's best month of the season so far, as he went 2-1, 1.67 ERA (27.0 IP, 5 ER) with a .156/.280/.244 opponent slash line (14-for-90 with 14 BB, 2 2B and 2 HR) in six starts.
- ☞ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List on July 5 (retro to July 2) and came back to post his worst statistical month of the campaign, going 0-2, 11.74 ERA (7.2 IP, 10 ER) with a .267/.405/.400 opponent slash line (8-for-30 with 7 BB, 1 2B, 1 HR) in two starts.
