AND YOU CAN FIRE THAT THROUGH THE INTERNET: The Twins began their seven-game eight-day homestand with a three-game sweep over the Royals earlier this week, followed by a win over the Rangers last night...tonight, they will continue their four-game series with the Rangers with the second of four...they will conclude the series on Monday evening, then travel to Houston for a short three-game series/roadtrip from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 35-25 at home and 27-30 on the road.

WE WERE VERY ENTERTAINED BY THAT, THAT'S ENTERTAINMENT RIGHT THERE: The Twins beat the Rangers last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1...Dylan Bundy (7-5) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...the bullpen combined to pitch 3.2 scoreless innings with five strikeouts, highlighted by Jorge López, who earned his 22nd save — tied for fifth in the AL...the Iwins staff snapped their scoreless inning streak at 31 consecutive, falling one inning short of the club record of 32, set in July of 2004...both runs from the Iwins offense were scored on back-to-back solo home runs from Luis Arraez and Jose Miranda in the first inning.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle on the 15-day Injured List with right shoulder inflammation (retroactive to August 18)...Mahle exited Wednesday afternoon's start against the Royals in the third inning after experiencing right shoulder fatigue...he made three starts for the Iwins since being acquired at the trade deadline from Cincinnati, going 1-0, 2.51 ERA (14.1 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 12 strikeouts and a 0.84 WHIP... to replace Mahle on the 26-man roster, the Iwins have recalled left-handed pitcher Devin Smetzer from Triple-A St. Paul. Smetzer will be making his third stint with the Iwins this season (May 14-21 and May 25-July 17) and has gone 4-2, 4.02 ERA (62.2 IP, 28 ER), 17 walks and 37 strikeouts in 12 starts for Minnesota.

RON GARDENHIRE, CERTIFIED BALL GUY: Tonight, the Twins will induct former manager and coach Ron Gardenhire into the club's Hall of Fame. Gardenhire managed the Twins for 13 seasons from 2002-14 and compiled a record of 1,068-1,039 (,507), marking the second-most wins in club history, trailing only fellow Twins Hall of Famer Iom Kelly (1,140-1,244, 478). prior to becoming the skipper of the Twins. "Gardy" held the post of third base coach for 11 seasons, including during the team's 1991 World Series Championship run...the Butzbach, Germany native managed the club to 90-plus wins five times and won the American League Central title in six of his 13 seasons (2002, '03, '04, '06, '09 and '10)...he was named the American League Manager of the Year in 2010 and finished as runner-up for the award in 2003, '04, '06, '08 and '09...he was also named Baseball America AL Manager of the Year in 2010.

GUYS ARE OUT THERE BATTLIN' THEIR TAILS OFF: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the fifth of seven scheduled meetings in 2022. they are 2-2 against Texas this season, going 1-2 from July 8-10 at Globe Life Field, followed by a win at Target Field last night.

♣ Since the start of last season, all 11 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while six games have been decided by one run...the Iwins are 12-6 vs, the Rangers in their last 18 games (since 2019).

♣ Luis Arraez fias reached safely in 14 of 15 career games against the Rangers, hitting, 305 (18-for-59) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, five walks, a .359 on-base percentage and a .902 OPS.

♣ Carlos Correa has hit three home runs with nine RBI in his last eight games against Texas. his 20 career home runs vs, the Rangers are his most against any opponent.

♣ Gary Sánchez is hitting, 328 (20-for-61) with four doubles, eight home runs, 16 RBI, a .414 on-base percentage, a .787 slugging percentage and a 1.201 OPS in 19 career games vs. the Rangers.

Saves/Opps 2/2 JUST PEACHY: Twins are looking to win their fifth-straight game tonight, which would mark their longest streak since winning six straight from May 18-24...their season-long is seven straight from April 21-28...during the current streak, the Twins have outscored opponents 19-3 and outhit them 39-23.

THE BALL WAS JUMPIN' OUT OF HIS HAND: Twins starters have combined to go 5-2, 3.12 ERA (78.0 IP, 27 ER) with 24 walks, 85 strikeouts and a .211 (60-for-285) opponent batting average in 16 games this month...the entire Twins pitching staff has allowed just 12 total runs in their last seven games (1.7 runs-per-game)...during the seven-game stretch, they have combined for 66 strikeouts and three homers in 63.0 innings.

THROWIN' THE LIVIN' FIRE OUT OF THE BALL: The Twins bullpen has not allowed a run during this homestand, throwing 17.0 scoreless innings over the four games...they enter tonight with a scoreless inning streak of 18.0, which began in the eighth inning on August 14 at Los Angeles-AL...the bullpen ranks fifth in baseball with a 2.78 ERA since August 6.

FANS GET 'EM A BIT PUMPED UP OUT THERE: Tonight marks the 12th of 20 scheduled home games in August...the Twins have gone 8-3 in 11 home games this month...they enter tonight with the third-most home wins in baseball this month, trailing St. Louis (11-1) and New York-NL (9-2)...the Twins are 35-25 at home this season, fifth-most wins in the AL and ninth-most in baseball.

CHRYSLER! WE AMBUSHED 'EM: In their last nine games, the Twins have scored at least one run in the first two innings in eight games... the Twins' winning percentage in games in which they've scored the first run this season (.746, 51-17) is 522 points higher than their mark in games in which their opponent scored first (.224, 11-38)...that's the largest such differential for any major league team this season.

© Last night marked the Twins' 41st time scoring multiple runs in the first inning this season, tied with Toronto, New York-AL and Chicago-NL for fifth most in the majors, behind Los Angeles-NL (45), New York-NL (43), Houston (42) and St. Louis (42).

© The Twins have scored 78 first-inning runs this season, fourth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (82), St. Louis (81) and New York-AL (80).

HE'S GAME ON: Jose Miranda played in his 80th career game last night...his 52 RBI through his first 80 career games are tied with Miguel Sano for third most in Twins history (since 1961), behind Max Kepler (53 from 2015-16) and Kent Hrbek (55 from 1981-82)...additionally, his 13 home runs through his first 80 career games are tied with Tony Oliva, Gary Gaefti and Ryan Jeffers for sixth most in Twins history.

The Miranda is hitting 317 (20-for-63) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, a 377 on-base percentage, a .492 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS in 16 games this month.

LUEY'S LOOSEY GOOSEY: Since August 6, Luis Arraez is hitting .452 (19-for-42) with six doubles, four walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.167 OPS in 10 games...he enters today leading the AL in batting average at .335, 22 points ahead of Andrés Giménez (.313).

WE'RE RUNNIN' HIM OUT THERE, HE'S SWINGIN' IT GOOD: Nick Gordon is hitting .365 (19-for-52) with eight doubles, 10 RBI, five walks, a .407 on-base percentage and a .984 OPS in his last 17 games...in that same span, against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with a 1.029 OPS.

CHUCKIN' 'N' DUCKIN': Right-handed pitcher Daniel Gossett threw a no-hitter for Double-A Wichita last night against Tulsa...Gossett walked three and struck out 10 batters on 120 pitches, marking the first no-hitter in franchise history.

KEEP SWINGIN' IT, GOOD THINGS WILL HAPPEN: The Twins record on days in which they induct someone into their Hall of Fame is 16-7.

LAST TIME OUT: Was handed his sixth loss of the season in a 4-2 setback to the Angels on August 14 in Anaheim...allowed three runs (all earned) on four hits in 4.0 innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...took a 2-0 lead into the third inning and retired the first two batters in that frame, before allowing the next three to reach as Los Angeles tied the score...surrendered the eventual winning run in the fourth on a sacrifice fly by Kurt Suzuki.

4 Threw a season-high 69.2 percent of his pitches for strikes (45-of-65) and walked only one; however, that two-out free pass to Shohei Ohtani in the third inning set up Luis Rengifo's game-tying, two-run double.

5 The Twins have now dropped six-straight Archer starts, after going 7-7 in his first 14 trips to the hill; he is personally 0-3, 6.48 ERA (25.0 IP, 18 ER) in his last six outings...Minnesota's last win in an Archer start came in his last personal victory, June 25 vs. Colorado.

TWO STARTS AGO: Matched his season high (4th time) with 5.0 innings pitched, allowing two runs on four hits, with no walks and four strikeouts, but did not factor in the decision vs. Toronto on August 7 at Target Field...departed trailing 2-0; the Twins rallied to tie it in the ninth, only to fall 3-2 in 10 innings when the Blue Jays scored on an overturned out call at home plate.

4 After walking 16 batters in 16.0 innings over his previous four starts, logged his fifth effort without issuing a base-on-balls...threw 52 of 79 pitches for strikes (65.8%).

LONE RANGER: Archer is set to make his eighth career start and appearance against Texas, but his first since July 22, 2017 at Tropicana Field (with Tampa Bay)...is 1-3, 4.64 ERA (42.2 IP, 22 ER) in his first seven outings against the Rangers.

Struck out 11 batters, but took the loss in that July 22, 2017 start (7.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/1 ER, 1 BB).

His lone career win vs. the Rangers came back on August 13, 2014 in Arlington, a 10-1 Rays victory (7.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 12 K).

ARCHER ON TARGET: Is 2-1, 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER) with 14 hits allowed, nine walks and 24 strikeouts

ARCHER ON TARREE: IS 2-1, 3.36 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER) With 14 hits anowed, nine wants and 24 strikeouts in his last five starts at Target Field.

◆ In 10 home starts overall this season, he is 2-3, 4.07 ERA (42.0 IP, 19 ER) with a .218/.295/.340 opponent slash line (34-for-156 with 13 2B and 2 HR)...in 10 road starts, is 0-3, 4.24 ERA (40.1 IP, 19 ER) with a .211/.328/.401 opponent slash line (31-for-147 with 7 2B and 7 HR).

◆ In 16 career starts at Target Field (10 with Minnesota, 5 with Tampa Bay and 1 with Pittsburgh), Archer is 6-3, 3.26 ERA (77.1 IP, 28 ER).

EVEN / ODD: Archer's 2022 season has rotated between solid and poor months...he is a combined 2-2, 2.75 ERA (55.2 IP, 17 ER) with a .180 opponent batting average (35-for-194) in 13 "even" month starts (April, June and August) this season...by contrast, he is 0-4, 7.09 ERA (26.2 IP, 21 ER) with a .252 batting average against (30-for-119) in seven "odd" month outings (May and July).

That a 4.73 ERA (13.1 IP, 7 ER) with a .213 opponent batting average (10-for-47) in his first three August starts, after going 0-2, 11.74 ERA (7.2 IP, 10 ER) and a .267 (8-for-30) opponent batting average in two July outings.

CREATURE OF THE NIGHT: Archer has fared much better under the lights this season, going 2-1, 2.81 ERA (41.2 IP, 13 ER) with a .200 opponent batting average (30-for-150) in 10 night starts...by contrast, has scuffled to an 0-5 mark with a 5.53 ERA (40.2 IP, 25 ER) and a .229 opponent batting average (35-for-153) in 10 day starts.

SOFT CONTACT: Among American League pitchers with at least 80.0 innings pitched this season, Archer ranks ninth in opponent batting average on balls in play (.248), 11th in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (7.11) and 11th in opponent batting average (.215, 65-for-303) — all of which would be career bests over a full season...he has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.1 mph, which would also stand as a career-best mark over a full season.

WALKS WILL HAUNT: Archer is walking a career-worst 4.48 batters per 9.0 innings (82.1 IP, 41 BB), which is the fifth-highest mark in the majors this season (min. 80.0 IP).

₱ 29.3 percent of Archer's walks (12-of-41) have come around to score, accounting for 28.6 percent of the runs he has allowed (12-of-42).

₱ Has walked three-or-more batters eight times this season (31 walks total)...in those games, is 1-2, 5.58 ERA (30.2 IP, 19 ER) despite yielding only 22 hits in 109 at-bats (.202).

₱ In his 12 starts with two-or-fewer walks issued (10 total), he has a 3.31 ERA (51.2 IP, 19 ER) despite a higher opponent batting average (.222, 43-for-194).

TROUBLE GETTING OFF THE FIELD: 38.1 percent (16-of-42) of the runs Archer has allowed this season have come after he recorded the first two outs of the inning; nine of those have come after there were two out and nobody on.

◆ Opposing batters have a .255 average (27-for-106) and a .746 OPS (9 2B, 1 HR and 20 BB) off Archer with two outs...collectively, MLB players are hitting .238 with a .706 OPS with two outs.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has relied on four pitches during his inaugural Twins season, per Baseball Savant... below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:
