**THE TWINS:** Have gone 4-1 through five games on their seven-game, eight-day homestand, sweeping the Royals in three games this week, followed by a split of the first two games against the Rangers the last two nights...today, the Twins will play the third of four against Texas, then conclude the series tomorrow evening...after tomorrow night's game, they will travel to Houston for a short three-game series/roadtrip from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 35-26 at home and 27-30 on the road.

RANGERS SPOIL THE GARDY PARTY: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night at Target Field by a score of 4-3 in 10 innings, losing on the night of former manager Ron Gardenhire's Twins Hall of Fame induction...the Twins closed a 2-1 deficit and tied the game in the bottom of the eighth but the Rangers scored two in the 10th to seal the victory...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, left 10 men on base and went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

HOF SUNDAY: Today Dan Gladden and César Tovar will become the 36th and 37th members of the Twins Hall of Fame today during a special pregame ceremony...last night former manager and coach Ron Gardenhire became the 35th member of the group.

The Twins are 16-8 all-time on Twins HOF induction days.

THE WORLD CHAMPION, THE BROADCASTER, THE DAZZLE MAN, THE WRENCH, THE CUPERTINO KID, THE TWINS HALL OF FAMER: Dan Gladden has spent nearly 29 seasons with the Twins organization in several capacities, including five as a player from 1987-91 and 22 as a radio broadcaster since 2000...the fiery leadoff hitter was a key member of the 1987 and 1991 World Series Championship teams and ranks first on the club's all-time Postseason list in runs scored (17) and stolen bases (7) and is tied for first in games (24), while ranking second in hits (29), doubles (6) and RBI (15)...he scored one of the most iconic runs in Twins history, the championship-winning tally in the bottom of the 10th inning in Game 7 of the 1991 World Series...the San Jose, California native hit .268 (661-for-2.470) with 117 doubles, 26 triples, 38 home runs, 238 RBI, 358 runs scored and 116 stolen bases in 644 career games with Minnesota...after his playing career, he joined the Twins radio broadcast team in 2000 and 2022 is his 20th season as a full-time analyst...he is the fifth-longest-tenured radio or television broadcaster in club history, behind Herb Carneal (46 seasons from 1961-2006). Dick Bremer (39 seasons from 1983-2022), Bert Blyleven (26 seasons from 1995-2020) and John Gordon (25 seasons from 1987-2011).

TOVAR — TWINS IMMORTALITY: César Tovar played eight seasons with the Twins from 1965-1972, hitting .281 (1164-for-4142) with 193 doubles, 45 triples, 38 home runs, 319 RBI, 646 runs scored and 186 stolen bases in 1,090 games...the utilityman, who passed away in 1994, is third on Minnesota's all-time list in stolen bases, seventh in triples, 11th in hits and at-bats, tied for 11th in runs scored, 13th in doubles and 15th in games played...a native of Caracas, Venezuela, Tovar led the American League in doubles (36) and triples (13) in 1970 and hits in 1971 (204)...he also finished seventh in the AL Most Valuable Player voting in 1967, after hitting .267 (173-for-649) with 32 doubles, seven triples, six home runs, 47 RBI and 98 runs scored in an MLB-leading 164 games...on September 22, 1968, he became the second player in AL/NL history to play all nine positions in the same game, doing so in the Twins' 2-1 victory over Oakland...Tovar played in six Postseason games with Minnesota from 1969-70, going 6-for-26 with one triple, one RBI, two runs scored, one walk and one stolen base.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the sixth of seven scheduled meetings in 2022...Twins are 2-3 against Texas this season, going 1-2 from July Saves/Opps 2/2
8-10 at Globe Life Field, followed by splitting the first two games this series.

Since the start of last season, all 12 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while seven games have been decided by one run...the Twins are 12-7 vs. the Rangers in their last 19 games (since 2019).

DO YOU EVEN KNOW DAZZLE?: Twins radio stallion and club Hall of Famer Dan Gladden once went 4-for-5 with three doubles, two RBI and a stolen base against the Rangers, this coming on May 31, 1988 at the Metrodome...he sits atop the leaderboard with Gary Gaetti (June 10, 1986) for Twins that doubled three times in one game against the Rangers.

**THE ROOKIE JUST RAKES:** Jose Miranda has driven in a run in five-straight games...in 38 games since June 30, he has 36 RBI, tied for third-most in baseball since that date...on the season, he has 53 RBI in 81 games...the 53 RBI through his first 81 games are tied with Max Kepler (53 from 2015-16) for sixth most in Twins/Senators history (since 1901), behind Iry Noren (61 in 1950), Bing Miller (60 in 1921), Joe Kuhel (60 from 1930-31), Kent Hrbek (55 from 1981-82) and Jake Powell (54 from 1930-35).

**STARTER STUFF:** Twins starters have combined to go 5-2, 3.04 ERA (83.0 IP, 28 ER) with 25 walks, 90 strikeouts and a .207 (63-for-304) opponent batting average in 17 games this month...the entire Twins pitching staff has allowed just 16 total runs in their last eight games (2.0 runs-per-game)...during the eight-game stretch, they have combined for 74 strikeouts and three homers in 73.0 innings.

**MAKING A TARGET RUN:** Today marks the 13th of 20 scheduled home games in August...the Twins have gone 8-3 in 11 home games this month...they enter today with the third-most home wins in baseball this month, trailing St. Louis (11-1) and New York-NL (9-2).

**EASY COME, EASY GORDON:** In his last 18 games, Nick Gordon has hit .357 (20-for-56) with eight doubles, one home run, 10 RBI, seven runs scored, five walks, a .397 on-base percentage, a .554 slugging percentage and a .950 OPS.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita outfielder Will Holland and right-handed pitcher Daniel Gossett have been named the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

₱ Holland, 24, played in six games for the Wind Surge, hitting .316 (6-for-19) with one double, two home runs, eight RBI, six runs scored, five walks, a .458 on-base percentage, a .684 slugging percentage and a 1.143 OPS...the Atlanta, Georgia native was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Auburn University.

₱ Gossett, 29, made two starts for the Wind Surge, highlighted by a no-hitter on Friday night against Tulsa...in that start, he allowed three walks and struck out 10 on 120 pitches, marking the first no-hitter in Wichita franchise history...the Spartanburg, South Carolina native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent over the offseason.

**AND THAT'S WHY YOU'RE HOF:** Did you know that Dan Gladden is one of three California-born, right-handed-hitting outfielders with at least 1,000 games, 600 runs, 200 doubles, 40 triples, 70 home runs, 400 RBI, 200 stolen bases and 300 walks...the others are Bobby Bonds and Ryan Braun.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan earned his ninth win of the season on August 15 vs. Kansas City, as the Twins took the first game of this current homestand, 4-2...allowed two runs on six hits (1 home run), with two walks and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...marked his 13th start this season (out of 19 total starts) with two-or-fewer runs allowed.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan took his fifth loss of the season on August 9 against Los Angeles-NL at Dodger Stadium, as the Twins fell 10-3...allowed six runs (5 earned) on a career-high nine hits (1 home run), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...also tossed a career-high 110 pitches, his fourth time crossing the century mark this season and in his career (also, 103 on May 15 vs. Cleveland, 101 on June 21 vs. Cleveland and 102 on June 26 vs. Colorado).

LEADING THE WAY: Enters today among rookie pitching leaders in a few categories (min. 50.0 IP).

SOMETIMES YOU LOSE, SOMETIMES YOU WIN: Ryan enters today with nine wins this season, tops among MLB rookies and the highest single-season total by a Twins rookie since southpaw Scott Diamond went 12-9 in 2012...if Ryan earns the win today, he would become just the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below).

\*\*Transparent Rookies with 10-plus wins in a season, Twins history (1961-present): Bert Blyleven (10-9 in 1970), Jim Hughes (16-14 in 1975, the Twins rookie record for wins), Paul Thormodsgard (11-15 in 1977), Roger Erickson (14-13 in 1978), Kevin Tapani (12-8 in 1990), Brad Radke (11-14 in 1995), Mark Redman (12-9 in 2000), Tony Fiore (10-3 in 2002), Jesse Crain (12-5 in 2005), Francisco Liriano (12-3 in 2006), Nick Blackburn (11-11 in 2008), Glen Perkins (12-4 in 2008) and Diamond (12-9 in 2012).

WESTERN EXPLORER: Ryan is making his first career start and appearance against Texas today...also facing the American League West division for the fourth time in his career...is 0-3, 7.11 ERA (12.2 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 10 strikeouts in his three prior outings, all of which occurred earlier this season on April 8 vs. Seattle (L, 4.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 4 K), May 10 vs. Houston (L, 4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R/ER, 5 BB, 3 K) and June 14 at Seattle (L, 4.2 IP, 5 H, 4 R/ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 3 K).

This struggled against both western divisions in his career so far; his 7.11 lifetime ERA in three starts against the AL West is his second highest against a single division, behind only his 11.05 ERA (14.2 IP, 18 ER) in three career starts against the National League West division.

Ryan is 4-5, 4.37 ERA (65.1 IP, 39 ER) in 13 career starts when facing a team for the first time.

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his 11th start at Target Field this season; has gone 5-2, 2.96 ERA (54.2 IP, 18 ER) with 17 walks and 54 strikeouts at home...this compares to 4-3, 5.05 ERA (46.1 IP, 26 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts in nine starts on the road...his road numbers are skewed by the 10 earned runs he permitted on July 29 at San Diego; prior to that start, had posted a 2.70 ERA on the road.

That allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in seven of his 10 home starts this season, including in each of his last four starts since July 1...is 2-0, 1.99 ERA (22.2 IP, 5 ER) with five walks, 25 strikeouts, a 0.79 WHIP and a .163 (13-for-80) opponent batting average in that span (Twin are 4-0 in those starts).

A SUNNY DISPOSITION: Is making his ninth daytime start this afternoon; has gone 5-1, 2.40 ERA (41.1 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts in his eight prior starts...has performed better under the sun than under the lights this season, going 4-4, 4.98 ERA (59.2 IP, 33 ER) with 18 walks and 62 strikeouts in 11 night starts.

Since taking the daytime loss on Opening Day (April 8), has gone 5-0, 2.17 ERA (37.1 IP, 9 ER) with six walks, 33 strikeouts and a 0.94 WHIP in his seven day starts since.

**MAKING THE LORAX PROUD:** In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 99 batters so far, which will lead to 4,950 new trees planted.

**MONEY MOVES:** Ryan drew attention when chasing after a foul ball and calling off catcher Ryan Jeffers earlier this season...upon catching the ball, Ryan signaled "5-0-0" to the dugout...Ryan told reporters that each foul ball caught is good for \$100 from each fellow starter.

### CAREER NOTES

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.

   Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).

   Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.

   Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.

   In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
