THE WORLD CHAMPION, THE BROADCASTER, THE DAZZLE MAN, THE WRENCH, THE CUPERTINO KID, THE TWINS HALL OF FAMER: Dan Gladden has spent nearly 29 seasons with the Twins organization in several capacities, including five as a player from 1987-91 and 22 as a radio Series Championship teams and ranks first on the club's all-time Postseason list in runs scored (17) and stolen bases (7) and is tied for first in games (24), while ranking second in hits (29), doubles (6) and RBI (15)... he scored one of the most iconic runs in Twins history,
