- Pitched in a career-low eight games while registering then-career highs in ERA (4.25), opponent batting average (.288) and WHIP (1.72) in 2017 with Toronto.. made two rehab starts in the minors, one with High-A Dunedin (3.2 IP) and one with Triple-A Buffalo (4.1 IP); dealt with blister, split nail and finger laceration issues... returned to the rotation on July 7 vs. HOU.
Was an All-Star for Toronto in 2016; selected by American League All-Star Manager, Ned Yost, to replace Craig Kimbrel on the 2016 AL All-Star roster.
Tossed at least 6.0 innings and allowed exactly one earned run in each of his first three starts in 2016...won seven consecutive decisions from April 29-June 29.
