the Royals in three games last week, followed by going 1-3 against the Rangers over the last four days...tonight, they will begin a three-game series/roadtrip with the first of three in Houston...the Twins have gone 35-28 at home and 27-30 on the road.

OFFENSE GOES OUT IN SERIES LOSS TO TEXAS: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, losing the four-game series three games to one...Sonny Gray (7-4) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Carlos Correa and Nick Gordon...Gordon drove in the Twins' only run with a fourth-inning double...Minnesota went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position, finishing the series 2-for-26 with RISP.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List with a low grade right hip strain, selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Aaron Sanchez from Triple-A St. Paul, recalled catcher Caleb Hamilton and optioned left-handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer...Buxton has hit .224 (76-for-340) with 13 doubles, three triples, 28 home runs, 51 RBI, 61 runs scored, a .306 on-base percentage, a .526 slugging percentage and an .833 OPS in 92 games for the Twins this season...the 2022 American League All-Star entered today tied for third in the AL in home runs...Sanchez, 30, has made 10 starts for the Saints this season, going 3-2, 3.80 ERA (47.1 IP, 20 ER), 15 walks and 33 strikeouts...Hamilton, 27, has played in 62 games for the Saints this season, hitting .233 (48-for-206) with 10 doubles, 11 home runs, 43 RBI and an .809 OPS...Smeltzer, who was recalled on Saturday, appeared in one game in relief, allowing one run on five hits in 3.0 innings pitched against the Texas Rangers on Saturday night...additionally, the Twins have transferred outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff (right wrist surgery) to the 60-day Injured List.

■ Sanchez pitched for Houston in 2019, going 2-0, 4.82 ERA (18.2 IP, 10 ER), with nine walks and 16 strikeouts in four starts...he began that season with Toronto was traded to Houston at the deadline along with right-handed pitcher Joe Biagini and outfielder Cal Stevenson, in exchange for outfielder Derek Fisher.

SEEING STARS: The Twins and Astros are playing each other today for the fourth of six times in 2022...these two teams played a three-game series from May 10-12 at Target Field as the Twins were swept...the middle game of the series was suspended in the top of the fourth inning due to heavy rain, lighting, hail and tornadoes in the area and resumed the next day... the Twins are 35-39 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 24-30 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

© Jorge Polanco is hitting ,324 (35-for-108) with six doubles, two triples, six home runs, 19 RBI and a .961 OPS in 28 career regular season games vs. Houston.

© Gio Urshela has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games against the Astros, hitting .324 (12-for-37) with a .390 on-base percentage and an .823 OPS in that span.

© Luis Arraez has hit safely in all five career games against the Astros, hitting .583 (7-for-12) with two walks, a .643 on-base percentage and a 1.310 OPS in those games.

WELCOME BACK: Carlos Correa is returning to Houston after playing seven seasons here from 2015-21, hitting .277 (781-for-2824) with 162 doubles, eight triples, 133 home runs, 489 RBI, 438 runs scored, a .356 on-base percentage, a .481 slugging percentage and an .837 OPS in 752 regular season games...he was the 2015 AL Rookie of the Year, was an AL All-Star in 2017 and '21, won the Gold Glove and Platinum Glove Award in 2021 and helped guide the Astros to a World Series title in 2017.

◆ In Minute Maid Park regular season history, Correa ranks seventh in RBI (233) and runs scored (203), eighth in home runs (64), ninth in doubles (75), and 10th in hits (373) and games (371).

◆ In Astros Postseason history, Correa ranks first in doubles (16) and RBI (59), tied for first in games (79), second in hits (82), and fourth in runs (37) and walks (30).

LUEY LOVES TO HIT: Since August 6, Luis Arraez is hitting .364 (20-for-55) with six doubles, six RBI, four walks, two strikeouts a .407 on-base percentage and a .934 OPS in 13 games...he enters today leading the AL in batting average at .327, 18 points ahead of Andrés Giménez (.309)...among all players in baseball, he ranks second, trailing Paul Goldschmidt (.337) by 10 points.

SAINT NICK: Nick Gordon is hitting .355 (22-for-62) with nine doubles, 11 RBI, five walks, a .391 on-base percentage and a .940 OPS in his last 20 games...Gordon ranks sixth on the club in OPS (.744) among players with a minimum of 275 plate appearances...Gordon is making his 30th start in centerfield tonight, third-most on the team, trailing Byron Buxton (52) and Gilberto Celestino (34).

CORREA, TEXAS TIES: Correa Family Foundation (CFF) will honor Mayah Nicole Zamora at Minute Maid Park as the foundation's August Hero of the Month...Mayah is a survivor of the school shooting at Robb Elementary in Uvalde, Texas...Mayah, who will be joined by her mother, father, two brothers, and a few extended family members, will throw the first pitch at tonight's game...Mayah will also attend batting practice and receive memorabilia as a commemoration of her being named the foundation's Hero of the Month...Mayah lost many of her closest friends, two teachers, and was severely and critically wounded in the shooting...her physicians have said it is a miracle she survived her injuries, which included gunshot wounds to her hands, arms, chest and back, and required more than 20 surgeries...during her hospital stay, which lasted for 66 days, Mayah discovered that the shooting suspect lived just blocks away from her home...since she was discharged from the hospital, that knowledge has been too much to bear, and she has been unable to return to her childhood home...after learning about this setback, the Correa Family Foundation, along with Puerto Rican singer Bad Bunny and his Good Bunny Foundation, and TokenSociety.io co-founders James and Korrine Whipkey, Scott H. Weissman, and Allen P. Lu, provided a grant to her family for alternative lodging...thanks to the generosity of numerous donors, CFF has secured the funding to build Mayah and her family a new home in a location where she feels comfortable.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2009, Michael Cuddyer hit two home runs in the same inning, becoming the first member of the Twins and the 53rd major league player to do so as the Twins defeated Kansas City, 10-3...Carl Pohlad was born on this day in 1915; the late owner passed away on January 5, 2009.

WELCOME BACK TO THE BIG LEAGUES: Sanchez's contract was selected from Triple-A St. Paul today and he is making his second start/appearance with the Twins this season (for more into on his prior start, see the note below)...signed a minor league contract with Minnesota on June 6 after beginning the year with the Washington Nationals...is back pitching for an American League team for the first time since 2019 with Toronto and Houston.

LAST TIME OUT, IN THE MAJORS: Sanchez made a spot start for the Twins on August 1 vs. Detroit at Target Field...did not factor into the decision of an eventual 5-3, extra-inning victory after yielding two runs on four hits, with two walks and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...marked his most strikeouts at the major league level since recording 10 on July 28, 2019 vs. Tampa Bay (with Toronto).

The With his eight K's that night, became the fifth player in Twins/Senators history with at least eight strikeouts in his first career outing with the franchise, joining Eric Erickson (12 K on June 28, 1919), Rene Monteagudo (9 K on September 6, 1938), Boof Bonser (8 K on May 21, 2006) and Ervin Santana (8 K on July 5, 2015).

The Twins won, 5-3, on Gio Urshela's walk-off, two-run home run in the bottom of the 10th inning.

2022 ST. PAUL SUMMARY: Signed a minor league contract with the Twins on June 6 and was assigned to Triple-A St. Paul...made his Saints debut in a start on June 8 vs. Rochester — his old team; did not factor into the decision of a 12-2 St. Paul win at CHS Field, allowing two runs on three hits (2 home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work.

The Has gone 3-2, 3.80 ERA (47.1 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks, 33 strikeouts and a 1.23 WHIP in 10 starts for the Saints this season.

Posted a 1-0 record and 5.87 ERA (15.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 13 strikeouts in four starts for the Saints in June.

Improved significantly in July, going 2-1 with a 3.18 ERA (22.2 IP, 8 ER), one walk, 13 strikeouts, a 0.93 WHIP and a .238 (20-for-84) opponent batting average in four starts in July.

Started twice for St. Paul after his August 1 outing for Minnesota, going 0-1, 1.93 ERA (9.1 IP, 2 ER) with four walks, seven strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP in those two appearances, on August 9 and 14 vs. Columbus.

HOUSTON, FORMER HOME: Sanchez is facing the Astros for the eighth time in his career tonight, making his fifth start; is 3-2, 6.20 ERA (24.2 IP, 17 ER) with 10 walks and 16 strikeouts in his prior outings...this includes 2-2, 7.32 ERA (19.2 IP, 16 ER) with 10 walks and 13 strikeouts in his four starts.

© Last faced Houston in a relief appearance on July 30, 2021 at Oracle Park with San Francisco (2.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 K)...his last start against the Astros occurred on June 14, 2019 at Minute Maid Park with Toronto (L, 3.0 IP, 6 H, 8 R/ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 4 K).

© Sanchez made four starts for Houston in the 2019 regular season, after being acquired from Toronto on July 31 with right-handed pitcher Joe Biagini and outfielder Cal Stevenson, in exchange for outfielder Derek Fisher...went 2-0, 4.82 ERA (18.2 IP, 10 ER) with nine walks and 16 strikeouts in those four outings.

WHAT'S IN A NAME: Gary Sánchez caught Aaron Sanchez in his last start for the Twins on August 1 and is slated to catch him again...the duo of Sanchezes comprise the second same-last-name battery in Twins history (1961-present), alongside right-handed pitcher Travis Miller and catcher Damian Miller, who paired up on five different occasions in August-September of 1997.

ARSENAL: Sanchez displayed a four-pitch mix in his eight major league outings this season, relying primarily on his sinker, the pitch he's used most throughout his career, he's thrown it 43.4 percent
