THE TWINS: Completed their three-game roadtrip in Houston by getting swept in three night games...tonight, they will begin a six-game homestand with three against the San Francisco Giants this weekend, followed by three against the Boston Red Sox next Monday-Wednesday... the Twins have gone 35-28 at home and 27-33 on the road.

The Twins enter tonight with a season-long six-game losing streak, their longest since dropping six-straight from August 25-31, 2020...their last streak longer was an eight-game losing streak from April 20-27, 2018.

**HOUSTON, BAD TRIP:** The Twins lost to the Astros last night at Minute Maid Park by a score of 6-3, suffering the three-game sweep, their fifth sweep of the season...Chris Archer (2-7) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two coming from Gio Urshela... Jorge Polanco hit his 16th home run, a solo shot in the first inning...It was the 399th RBI and 98th home run of his career.

GARLICK OFF THE SHELF: The Twins have returned outfielder Kyle Garlick from rehab and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Garlick missed the Twins' last 21 games with a right ribcage contusion and played in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 1-for-7 with one walk...he has hit .257 (27-for-105) with three doubles, eight home runs, 18 runs scored, 17 RBI, a .319 on-base percentage and an .833 OPS in 51 games for the Twins this season...to make room for Garlick on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated infielder Tim Beckham for release or assignment...Beckham played in 12 games for the Twins since joining the team on July 30, going 2-for-25 with one RBI and one run scored.

WE WERE GIANTS: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 16th, 17th and 18th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 6-9 all-time against San Francisco, going 5-7 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...these two teams last played from June 9-11, 2017 in San Francisco as the Twins won the three-game series, taking the first two and losing the third.

母 Gio Urshela is hitting .526 (10-for-19) with three doubles and a 1.234 OPS in five career games against the Giants...his five games came in 2017 with Cleveland (2 G) and 2019 with New York-AL (3 G).

FIRST LOOK: This series marks just the second time that the Giants have visited Minnesota, as the Twins went 1-2 against them at the Metrodome from June 14-16, 2005...San Francisco is the last team in baseball to visit Target Field since it opened in 2010...the Twins are 18-10 all-time against a team playing in their first game at Target Field...below are all previous 28 teams' date/result in their first game at Target Field:

THE OTHER GUYS: The Twins are 5-12 against the National League this season, going 0-4 vs. the Dodgers, 1-2 vs. the D-Backs, 2-1 vs. the Rockies, 1-3 vs. the Brewers and 1-2 vs. the Padres...the Twins will conclude the National League portion of their schedule with this series. they have lost three-straight games to NL opponents, losing the third game in San Diego on July 31, followed by a two-game sweep at Dodger Stadium from August 9-10...it marks their longest losing streak to the NL since dropping six-straight from June 29-July 3, 2019 at Chicago-NL (3) and at Milwaukee (3)...this season marks their first losing season in IL play since going 8-12 in 2019.

◆ Jose Miranda is hitting .405 (17-for-42) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.098 OPS in 12 games against NL opponents this season...he has the fourth-best batting average and OPS in IL play in all of baseball this season.

**LEFT TURNS:** The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 10th time in their last 16 games overall, going 4-5 in those previous nine. 

<sup>◆</sup> The Twins have gone 21-18 this season when facing a left-handed starter...they have an OPS of .704 vs. lefties this season, compared to a .736 OPS against righties.

<sup>◆</sup> Carlos Correa is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one triple, one home run, three RBI, five walks, a .414 on-base percentage, a .545 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS in his last 11 games against lefties.

IF YOU'RE NOT FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: In their last 15 games, the Twins have scored at least one run in the first two innings in nine games... the Twins' winning percentage in games in, which they've scored the first run this season (.739, 51-18) is 531 points higher than their mark in games in which their opponent scored first (.208, 11-42)... that's the largest such differential for any major league team this season.

The Twins have scored 79 first-inning runs this season, fifth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (91), St. Louis (87), New York-AL (82) and Houston (80)...additionally, the Twins have hit 24 first-inning home runs this season, tied for third-most in baseball with Atlanta, trailing Houston (31) and New York-AL (30).

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Today marks the 15th of 20 scheduled home games in August, the most for the Twins in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977...the Twins have gone 8-6 in 14 home games this month... they enter today tied with Baltimore for the fourth-most home wins in the AL this month, trailing Tampa Bay (10-3), Houston (9-3) and Kansas City (9-5).

4 Jorge Polanco is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with two doubles, three RBI, two walks, a .393 on-base percentage and an .810 OPS in his last seven home games.

**THIS IS OFFENSIVE**: The Twins won four-straight games from August 15-19, but have lost a season-long six straight since August 20... during their current six-game losing streak, they are hitting .176 (34-for-193) with 54 strikeouts, one home run, a .171 (6-for-35) RISP average and 12 runs scored (2.0 runs-per-game).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1962, Jack Kralick threw the first no-hitter in Twins history, as he beat the Kansas City A's by a score of 1-0 on Lenny Green's sacrifice fly, scoring Bill Fischer...George Alusik with one out in the ninth inning broke up the potential perfect game, drawing a walk.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan was handed his sixth loss of the season in his last start on August 21 vs. Texas at Target Field, as the Twins were shut out, 7-0...allowed just two runs on two hits (I home run), with three walks and six strikeouts in 6.1 innings of work...was his seventh quality start of the season, currently tied with Sonny Gray for tops on the livinis; also marked his first career loss in a quality start... additionally, was his 14th start this season (out of 20 total starts) with two-or-fewer runs allowed.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan earned his ninth win of the season on August 15 vs. Kansas City, as the Twins took the first game of the prior homestand, 4-2...allowed two runs on six hits (1 home run), with two walks and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work.

100K GOLD: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold in his last start on August 21 and currently has 105 strikeouts on the season...he is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...in addition to Ryan and May, the others are: Bert Blyleven (135 K in 1970). Jim Hughes (130 K in 1975), Roger Erickson (121 K in 1978), Kevin Tapani (101 K in 1990), Eric Milton (107 K in 1998), Joe Mays (115 K in 1999), Mark Redman (117 K in 2000) and Francisco Liriano (Twins rookie record 144 K in 2006).

SOMETIMES YOU LOSE, SOMETIMES YOU WIN: Ryan enters today with nine wins this season, so among MLB rookies and the highest single-season total by a lwins rookie since southpaw Scott Diamond went 12-9 in 2012...if Ryan earns the win tonight, he would become just the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below).

SENIOR CIRCUIT STRUGGLES: Ryan is facing the Giants for the first time in his career tonight...also making his fifth Interleague start of the season and is 1-2, 8.55 ERA (20.0 IP, 19 ER) with six walks and 15 strikeouts in his four prior starts...10 of the 19 earned runs he's allowed to the National League this season came on July 29 at San Diego (4.2 IP, 10 ER)...tonight also marks his seventh career Interleague start and appearance, after making his major league debut on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL at Target Field; is 2-3, 7.20 ERA (30.0 IP, 24 ER) with eight walks and 31 strikeouts in his six prior starts.

Ryan was born in San Francisco and raised just north of the city in Marin County, California... he grew up a diehard Giants fan, idolizing Matt Cain, Tim Lincecum, Madison Bumgarner, Ryan Vogelsong, etc. ...was selected by the Giants in the 39th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Sir Francis Drake High School but opted to play college baseball instead.

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his 12th start at Target Field this season; has gone 5-3, 2.95 ERA (61.0 IP, 20 ER) with 20 walks and 60 strikeouts at home...this compares to 4-3, 5.05 ERA (46.1 IP, 26 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts in nine starts on the road...his road numbers are skewed by the 10 earned runs he permitted on July 29 at San Diego; prior to that start, had posted a 2.70 ERA on the road.

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the 12th time this season...has a 4-4 record, 4.98 ERA (59.2 IP, 33 ER) with 18 walks and 62 strikeouts in his 11 prior night starts, compared to 5-2, 2.45 ERA (47.2 IP, 13 ER) with 13 walks and 43 strikeouts in nine day games...is also 2-1, 3.07 ERA (29.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks, 32 strikeouts and a .187 (20-for-107) opponent batting average in four home night starts this season.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball—he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 59.5% of the time through his first 20 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.
