THE TWINS: After completing their three-game roadtrip in Houston by getting swept in three night games, the Twins began their six-game homestand with a win over the Giants last night...tonight, they will play the second of three against San Francisco and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, they will welcome the Boston Red Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 36-28 at home and 27-33 on the road.

SO, I GUESS THAT'S WHAT "ZERO CARES" LOOKS LIKE: The Twins shut out the Giants last night at Target Field by a score of 9-0, snapping their season-long six-game losing streak...it marked their 13th shutout win of the season and matched their largest margin of victory in a shutout win this season (also, 9-0 win on August 16 vs. Kansas City)...it was their first shutout of an NL opponent since a 6-0 win over Colorado on June 25...Joe Ryan (10-6) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, three walks and eight strikeouts...he became the 14th rookie in Twins history to reach double-digit wins in a season and first since Scott Diamond (12-9 in 2012)...the offense recorded nine hits as Kyle Garlick (9), Carlos Correa (15) and Gary Sanchez (12) each homered.

TWINS AND GIANTS: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 16th, 17th and 18th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 7-9 all-time against San Francisco, going 1-0 at Target Field, 5-7 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome.

✦ Gio Urshela is hitting .435 (10-for-23) with three doubles and a 1.024 OPS in six career games against the Giants.
✦ Rocco Baldelli, Gabe Kapler and Evan Longoria were teammates for the Tampa Bay Rays in 2010...Baldelli and Longoria were teammates in 2008 as well in Longoria's rookie season and Baldelli's fifth season.
✦ The Twins will host the Giants again next season for three games from May 22-24.

THE OTHER GUYS: The Twins are 6-12 against the National League this season, going 0-4 vs. the Dodgers, 1-2 vs. the D-Backs, 2-1 vs. the Rockies, 1-3 vs. the Brewers, 1-2 vs. the Padres and 1-0 vs. the Giants.

✦ Jose Miranda is hitting .400 (18-for-45) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.061 OPS in 13 games against NL opponents this season...his average is the fourth-best in baseball this season and his OPS is fifth.
✦ Carlos Correa is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with four walks, a .464 on-base percentage and a 1.073 OPS in seven home games in IL games this season.

KINGS OF THE HILL: Twins pitchers have posted a 3.45 ERA (206.0 IP, 79 ER) with 59 walks, 215 strikeouts and a .243 (186-for-765) opponent batting average in 23 games this month...in August, starters have gone 6-7, 3.23 ERA (114.1 IP, 41 ER) with 35 walks, 116 strikeouts and a .208 (79-for-379) opponent batting average, while relievers have posted 3.73 ERA (91.2 IP, 38 ER) with 24 walks and 99 strikeouts...below are the Twins AL ranks in a few pitching categories this month:

MAKING THE FIRST MOVE: In their last 16 games, the Twins have scored at least one run in the first two innings in 10 games...the Twins' winning percentage in games in which they've scored the first run this season (.743, 52-18) is 535 points higher than their mark in games in which their opponent scored first (.208, 11-42)...that's the largest such differential for any major league team this season.

✦ The Twins have scored 81 first-inning runs this season, fourth-most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (91), St. Louis (87) and New York-AL (82).

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Tonight marks the 16th of 20 scheduled home games in August, the most for the Twins in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977...the Twins have gone 9-6 in 15 home games this month...they enter today tied with Houston and Kansas City for the second-most home wins in the AL this month, trailing Tampa Bay (10-3)...the Twins will complete the month with three against the Red Sox this upcoming week.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Twins scored nine runs last night, equaling their total from their previous five games (0, 1, 2, 3, 3)...nine runs marked their most since August 16 vs. Kansas City.

✦ Despite hitting .176 (39-for-222) with a .521 OPS in their previous seven games prior to last night, the Twins still rank fourth in the AL in slugging percentage (.410), on-base percentage (.318) and OPS (.728), and fifth in batting average (.248).

C4: Carlos Correa is hitting .295 (13-for-44) with 10 walks, a .411 on-base percentage and an .888 OPS in his last 12 games...he has reached safely multiple times in seven of those 13.
✦ In his last 33 home games, he is hitting .308 (36-for-117) with an .898 OPS...in 51 career games at Target Field, he is hitting .289/.366/.468.

TOUCH 'EM ALL: Today the Minnesota Twins named KARP-FM in Dassel and KGLB-AM of Glencoe the 2022 John Gordon Radio Affiliate of the Year...as part of their recognition, the Twins Community Fund will donate a \$5,000 grant to help support the station's volunteer initiatives in baseball and softball organizations throughout several communities that their efforts impact...KARP has been an affiliate for 22 years...KGLB came on the air in 2009 and has been a Twins Affiliate for all but six months of their existence...this is the 11th year of the Twins organization awarding the Affiliate of the Year award and impacting communities across the Treasure Island Baseball Network.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, Byron Buxton hit three home runs at Rogers Centre against the Toronto Blue Jays...he began the day by going 0-for-2 but homered in the fourth inning, seventh inning and ninth inning as the Twins won 7-2.

TWINS ON A STICK: The 2022 Minnesota State Fair is taking place in St. Paul through Labor Day...the Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, rain or shine, throughout the fair's duration...fans can have the opportunity to meet T.C. Bear, play wiffle ball home run derby/batting practice, win giveaway items, shop for their favorite Twins clothing and merchandise and much more.

✦ Ryan Jeffers and Royce Lewis visited the Great Minnesota Get Together earlier today and met fans/took photos/signed autographs, played wiffle ball and ate corn/cheese curds/fries/cookies.
