Right-handed pitcher Aaron Sanchez is scheduled to start tomorrow's series finale against San Francisco...had his contract selected from Triple-A St. Paul before his last start on August 23 at Houston; took the loss after allowing two runs on six hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings...will be his third start for the Twins this season after signing as a minor league free agent on August 1...previously made seven starts for Washington earlier this year and is 3-4, 7.36 ERA (40.1 IP, 33 ER) in nine starts overall...will face San Francisco for the the second time this season after starting at Oracle Park on April 29 with the Nationals (W, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 4 K)...is a career 2-1, 4.41 ERA (16.1 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 10 strikeouts in his three prior starts.
