THE TWINS: After completing their three-game roadtrip in Houston by getting swept in three night games, the Twins began their six-game homestand by winning consecutive games over San Francisco the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale against the Giants before welcoming the Boston Red Sox for three games from tomorrow-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 37-28 at home and 27-33 on the road.

TWINS WALK-OFF WITH A GILBERTO CELEBRATION, "ZERO CARES" MODE CONTINUES: The Twins beat the Giants last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings, making them 5-8 in extras this season...the offense was shut out for the first eight innings until scoring two in the ninth and one in the 10th on a walk-off, bases loaded walk from Gilberto Celestino...it marked the club's fifth win this season when trailing after eight innings (5-50)...Sonny Gray was the starter, allowing one run on one hit with four walks in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen allowed just one run over 5.0 innings of relief...Carlos Correa had four of the Twins nine hits, his four hits tying a career-high.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: Last night's walk-off walk from Gilberto Celestino was the 12th walk-off base on balls in club history (since 1961) and first since Joe Mauer on July 29, 2016, against Tommy Kahle and the White Sox...Bally Sports North analyst Roy Smalley had the fifth walk-off walk in club history on August 1, 1976 vs. Oakland in Game 1 of a doubleheader, off Stan Bahnsen.
 ☞ The Twins now have nine walk-off victories this season, tied with Baltimore for second-most in baseball, trailing New York-AL (12)...nine walk-off plate appearances matches their 2021 total...their most in a season came in 1987, when they had 16.

BUST OUT THE BROOMS: The Twins are seeking their seventh sweep of the season today...their six sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games), May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games), May 20-22 at Kansas City (3 games), July 23-24 at Detroit (2 games) and August 15-17 vs. Kansas City (3 games).
 ☞ The Twins last sweep of an NL opponent was in two games of Pittsburgh from August 2-3, 2020...their last three-game sweep of an NL opponent was of Arizona from August 18-20, 2017.

TWINS AND GIANTS: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 16th, 17th and 18th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 8-9 all-time against San Francisco, going 2-0 at Target Field, 5-7 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome.
 ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .407 (11-for-27) with three doubles and a .967 OPS in seven career games against the Giants.
 ☞ Rocco Baldelli, Gabe Kapler and Evan Longoria were teammates for the Tampa Bay Rays in 2010...Baldelli and Longoria were teammates in 2008 as well in Longoria's rookie season and Baldelli's fifth season.
 ☞ The Twins will host the Giants again next season for three games from May 22-24.

THE NL GUYS: The Twins are 7-12 against the National League this season, going 0-4 vs. the Dodgers, 1-2 vs. the D-Backs, 2-1 vs. the Rockies, 1-3 vs. the Brewers, 1-2 vs. the Padres and 2-0 vs. the Giants...the Twins are playing their final NL game of the season today...this season marks their first losing season in NL play since going 8-12 in 2019.
 ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .360 (18-for-50) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI and a .957 OPS in 14 games against NL opponents this season...his average is tied for seventh-best in NL games among all players in baseball this season.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with four walks, a .515 on-base percentage and a 1.158 OPS in eight home games in NL Play this season.

CALL TO ARMS: Twins pitchers have posted a 3.38 ERA (216.0 IP, 81 ER) with 63 walks, 227 strikeouts and a .239 (190-for-796) opponent batting average in 24 games this month...in August, starters have gone 6-7, 3.17 ERA (119.1 IP, 42 ER) with 39 walks, 120 strikeouts and a .209 (90-for-431) opponent batting average, while relievers have posted 3.63 ERA (96.2 IP, 39 ER) with 24 walks and 107 strikeouts...below are the Twins AL ranks in a few pitching categories this month:

AUGUST IN MINNEAPOLIS: Today marks the 17th of 20 scheduled home games in August, the most for the Twins in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977...the Twins have gone 10-6 in 16 home games this month...they enter today tied with Tampa Bay for the most home wins in the AL this month...the Twins will complete their August schedule with three against the Red Sox this upcoming week.

EXP-1LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with 10 walks, a .443 on-base percentage and a .953 OPS in his last 14 games...he has reached safely multiple times in eight of those 14.
 ☞ In 52 home games this season, he is hitting .303 (59-for-195) with an .852 OPS...in his last 34 home games, he is hitting .328 (40-for-122) with a .925 OPS...he has reached safely in 10 of his last 13 plate appearances at Target Field (.727/.769/1.182).

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids catcher Patrick Winkel and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Winkel, 22, played in five games for the Kernels, hitting .389 (7-for-18) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, two walks, a .450 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.228 OPS...the New Haven, Connecticut native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Connecticut.
 ☞ Varland, 24, made one start for the Saints on Thursday at Iowa, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts...this marks the St. Paul native's third time receiving this honor in 2022 (also June 12 and July 3).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1981, Tim Laudner became the second Twins player in four days to homer in his first major league game, off Dave Rozema, a 6-0 win over the Tigers...Kent Hrbek did it earlier in the week at Yankee Stadium.

TWINS ON A STICK: The 2022 Minnesota State Fair is taking place in St. Paul through Labor Day...the Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, rain or shine, throughout the fair's duration...fans can have the opportunity to meet T.C. Bear, play wiffle ball home run derby/batting practice, win giveaway items, shop for their favorite Twins clothing and merchandise, and much more.

- ☞ Signed a minor league contract with Minnesota on June 6 and went 3-2, 3.80 ERA (47.1 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks and 33 strikeouts in 10 starts for Triple-A St. Paul.
- ☞ Began the season with the Washington Nationals after signing on March 16...went 3-3, 8.33 ERA (31.1 IP, 29 ER) with eight walks and 16 strikeouts before being designated for release or assignment on May 29 and becoming a free agent on May 31.
- ☞ The Twins are his fifth organization (Toronto 2010-19, Houston 2019-20, San Francisco 2021, Washington 2022).

LAST TIME OUT: Sanchez took the 4-2 loss in his last start on August 23 at Houston, allowing two runs on six hits, with one walk, one hit batter and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work (plus two batters in the fifth)...permitted single tallies in the second and fourth innings, on an RBI single by Mauricio Dubon and an RBI double by Trey Mancini, respectively...plunked Jose Altuve to lead off the fifth inning and the resulting interaction caused the benches to clear; when the fracas subsided, Sanchez walked Yuli Gurriel and pitching coach Pete Maki came out to talk to him...the umpires ruled that manager Rocco Baldelli's conversation with Sanchez in the aftermath of the benches-clearing incident constituted a mound visit, meaning Sanchez had to depart the game upon Maki's mound visit; Baldelli was ejected and Sanchez was removed from the game as a result of the call.

TWO STARTS AGO IN THE MAJORS: Sanchez made a spot start for the Twins on August 1 vs. Detroit at Target Field...did not factor into the decision of an eventual 5-3, extra-inning victory after yielding two runs on four hits, with two walks and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...marked his most strikeouts at the major league level since recording 10 on July 28, 2019 vs. Tampa Bay (with Toronto).
 ☞ With his eight K's that night, became the fifth player in Twins/Senators history with at least eight strikeouts in his first career outing with the franchise, joining Eric Erickson (12 K on June 28, 1919), Rene Monteaugudo (9 K on September 6, 1938), Boof Bonser (8 K on May 21, 2006) and Ervin Santana (8 K on July 5, 2015).
 ☞ The Twins won, 5-3, on Gio Urshela's walk-off, two-run home run in the bottom of the 10th inning.

FORMERLY A GIANT: Sanchez is facing San Francisco for the third time this season this afternoon, going 1-1, 6.75 ERA (9.1 IP, 7 ER) with one walk and five strikeouts; both of his prior starts came as a member of the Washington Nationals, on April 23 at Nationals Park and April 29 at Oracle Park...is 2-1, 4.41 ERA (16.1 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 10 strikeouts in three career starts against the Giants.
 ☞ Sanchez spent part of the 2021 season with San Francisco, going 1-1, 3.06 ERA (35.1 IP, 12 ER) with 15 walks and 26 strikeouts in nine games (7 starts) prior to his release in August of that year.
 ☞ Sanchez is making his first Interleague start and appearance of the season today; is 4-3, 4.06 ERA (62.0 IP, 28 ER) with 24 walks and 42 strikeouts in 14 career Interleague games, including 4-2, 4.23 ERA (55.1 IP, 26 ER) with 23 walks and 37 strikeouts in his nine Interleague starts...these numbers include a 4-3 record, 4.05 ERA (60.0 IP, 27 ER) with 24 walks and 41 strikeouts when pitching for an American League team against the National League; owns one career Interleague relief appearance when pitching for the NL against the AL, on July 30, 2021 vs. Houston with San Francisco (2.0 IP, 3 H, 1 ER/ER, 1 K).

ARSENAL: Sanchez displayed a four-pitch mix in his nine major league outings this season, relying primarily on his sinker, the pitch he's used most throughout his career...he's thrown it 41.4 percent of the time in 2022 and has used it as much as 77.2 percent of the time in 2014...however, his curveball has been his primary strikeout pitch this season, utilizing it to complete 12 of his 28 strikeouts this season.

2022 ST. PAUL SUMMARY: Signed a minor league contract with the Twins on June 6 and was assigned to Triple-A St. Paul...made his Saints debut in a start on June 8 vs. Rochester - his old team; did not factor into the decision of a 12-2 St. Paul win at CHS Field, allowing two runs on three hits (2 home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work.
 ☞ Has gone 3-2, 3.80 ERA (47.1 IP, 20 ER) with 15 walks, 33 strikeouts and a 1.23 WHIP in 10 starts for the Saints this season.
 ☞ Posted a 1-0 record and 5.87 ERA (15.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 13 strikeouts in four starts for the Saints in June.
 ☞ Improved significantly in July, going 2-1 with a 3.18 ERA (22.2 IP, 8 ER), one walk, 13 strikeouts, a 0.93 WHIP and a .238 (20-for-84) opponent batting average in four starts in July.
 ☞ Started twice for St. Paul after his August 1 outing for Minnesota, going 0-1, 1.93 ERA (9.1 IP, 2 ER) with four walks, seven strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP in those two appearances, on August 9 and 14 vs. Columbus.

2022 NATIONALS SUMMARY: Sanchez signed a minor league contract with the Washington Nationals on March 16 and was a non-roster invitee to spring training...pitched in one Grapefruit League game, working a scoreless inning on March 19 vs. New York-NL (1 H, 1 BB, 1 K)...began the season with Triple-A Rochester and went 1-0, 3.60 ERA (15.0 IP, 6 ER) with two walks, two strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in three starts for the Red Wings before having his contract selected by Washington on April 23.
 ☞ Made his Nats debut on April 23 vs. San Francisco...took the 5-2 loss after allowing four runs on six hits, with one walk and one strikeout in 4.1 innings.
