THE TWINS: The Twins began their six-game homestand with a three-game sweep of the Giants over the weekend...tonight, they will begin a three-game series against the Boston Red Sox through Wednesday...after this series, the Twins will begin September with an off-day in Chicago on Thursday, followed by seven road games, three at Chicago-AL from September 2-4 and four at New York-AL from September 5-8...the Twins have gone 38-28 at home and 27-33 on the road.

TWINS PULL OFF A GIANT SWEEP: The Twins beat the Giants yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 8-3...Aaron Sanchez was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 3.2 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...Devin Smeltzer (5-2) earned the win with 2.2 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded 11 hits, highlighted by Jake Cave, who went 2-for-4 with a double, a home run (2) and tied a career-high with four RBI...Max Kepler went 2-for-4 and recorded his 400th career RBI, the 22nd player in Twins history (1961-present) to reach 400 RBI.

WE WERE GIANTS: The Twins three-game sweep of the Giants marked their seventh this season...their previous six sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games), May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games), May 20-22 at Kansas City (3 games), July 23-24 at Detroit (2 games) and August 15-17 vs. Kansas City (3 games).

It marked their first three-game sweep of an National League opponent since August 18-20, 2017 vs. Arizona.

The Twins outscored the Giants in the series 20-5 and outhit them 29-18.

Twins batters hit .287 (29-for-101) with seven doubles, four home runs, 14 walks and an .857 OPS...they hit .360 (9-for-25) and a 1.165 OPS with runners in scoring position.

Twins pitchers posted a 1.61 ERA (28.0 IP, 5 ER) with Giant batters hitting .189 (18-for-95) and no home runs...starters posted a 1.84 ERA (14.2 IP, 3 ER), while relievers posted a 1.35 ERA (13.1 IP, 2 ER).

Carlos Correa went 8-for-12 (.667) with one home run and four RBI...Jake Cave went 4-for-7 (.571) with one home run and five RBI...Max Kepler went 4-for-6 (.667) with three walks.

TWINS-SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fifth of seven games in 2022...these two teams met for a four-game series in Boston from April 13-15...the Twins won the bookend games of that series, including an 8-3 win on Patriot's Day...the Twins are hosting the Sox for the first time at Target Field since a four-game series from April 13-15, 2021, as the Twins went 1-3.

Carlos Correa is hitting .329 (52-for-158) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 25 RBI, 34 runs scored, 28 walks, a .429 on-base percentage, a .570 slugging percentage and a .999 OPS in 42 career regular season games against the Red Sox.

Gary Sánchez has 54 RBI in his career against the Red Sox (71 games), his most vs. any opponent (Baltimore - 52, Tampa Bay - 44).

Sandy León played five seasons with Boston, from 2015-19, hitting .223 (240-for-1074) with 48 doubles, 24 home runs and 118 RBI in 358 games...during his five seasons, he had a 3.74 catcher ERA, the third-best among AL catchers (minimum 300 games started).

Gio Urshela is hitting .311 (51-for-164) with 11 doubles, six home runs, 27 RBI and an .829 OPS in 50 career regular season games vs. the Sox...he has five hits in his last eight at-bats against the Sox (2 games).

HOME OF DYLAN: Dylan Bundy is 4-1, 2.68 ERA (40.1 IP, 12 ER) in eight home starts this season compared to 3-5, 5.66 ERA (68.1 IP, 43 ER) in 14 road starts...prior to joining Minnesota this season, he had a 0-3, 10.13 ERA (13.1 IP, 15 ER) in three starts at Target Field.

ARMS OF AUGUST: Twins pitchers have posted a 3.36 ERA (225.0 IP, 84 ER) with 66 walks, 234 strikeouts and a .240 (200-for-832) opponent batting average in 25 games this month...in August, starters have gone 6-7, 3.22 ERA (123.0 IP, 44 ER) with 40 walks, 122 strikeouts and a .215 (96-for-447) opponent batting average, while relievers have posted 3.53 ERA (102.0 IP, 40 ER) with 26 walks and 112 strikeouts.

UR THE MAN: Gio Urshela is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI and three walks in his last 12 games, since August 16...he recorded his 20th double yesterday afternoon (career-high is 34, done in 2019 with New York-AL)...he needs one double to reach 100 for his career.

He recorded his 500th career hit yesterday afternoon, a ground-rule double off Alex Young in the fifth inning...Rocco Baldelli presented Gio with a game-ball postgame and he got to bang the clubhouse gong.

EXP.-LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa is hitting .358 (19-for-53) with 10 walks, seven RBI, a .446 on-base percentage and a .974 OPS in his last 15 games...he has reached safely multiple times in nine of those 15.

In 53 home games this season, he is hitting .307 (61-for-199) with an .860 OPS...in his last 35 home games, he is hitting .333 (42-for-126) with a .935 OPS...he has reached safely in 12 of his last 17 plate appearances at Target Field (.667/.706/1.067).

He has 14 walks in 20 games this month...his career-high for walks in any month is 19, done in both May and June of last season.

In his last three games, Correa has raised his batting average from .264 to .276...last season, he batted .279 (he has batted exactly .279 in a season three times in his career (2015, 2019 and 2021)).

AUGUST IN MINNEAPOLIS: Today marks the 18th of 20 scheduled home games in August, the most for the Twins in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977...the Twins have gone 11-6 in 17 home games this month...they enter today first in the AL in home wins this month and fourth in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (13-5), St. Louis (13-2) and New York-NL (11-6).

They are 38-28 at Target Field this season, fourth-most wins in the AL and ninth-most in baseball.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1963, the Twins set a club record with eight home runs in a game vs. Washington, only to be out-done by the 2019 Bomb Squad who did it twice that season: April 20 (Game 2) at Baltimore and May 23 at Los Angeles-AL...in 1996, the Twins traded third baseman Dave Hollins to Seattle for a player to be named later (David Ortiz).

TWINS ON A STICK: The 2022 Minnesota State Fair is taking place in St. Paul through Labor Day...the Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, rain or shine, throughout the fair's duration...fans can have the opportunity to meet T.C. Bear, play wiffle ball home run derby/batting practice, win giveaway items, shop for their favorite Twins clothing and merchandise, and much more.

Carlos Correa visited the fair last night with his family.

- Making his team-leading 23rd start of the season...also his 156th career start and 184th appearance. Facing Boston for the second time this season after earning the win on April 18 at Fenway Park (5.1 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 6 K)...career 4-9, 5.36 ERA (94.0 IP, 56 ER) in 21 games (16 starts) vs. the Red Sox. Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Bundy took his sixth loss of the season in his last start on August 24 at Houston, as the Twins fell 5-3...allowed two runs on three hits, with one walk and no strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...gave up a home run to Jose Altuve on his first pitch of the game, but limited to the Astros to one more run over the remainder of his outing (a sacrifice fly by Yuli Gurriel in the bottom of the third)...did not record a strikeout in a start for the third time in his career (also May 8, 2018 vs. Kansas City, with Baltimore; and June 28, 2021 at New York-AL, with Los Angeles-AL).

- Bundy is 1-1, 2.33 ERA (19.1 IP, 5 ER) with four walks, nine strikeouts and a .176 (12-for-68) opponent average in his four August starts...his .176 opponent batting average ranks ninth in the American League this month (min. 15.0 IP). Going back even further, Bundy is 4-3, 3.59 ERA (62.2 IP, 25 ER) in his last 12 starts (since June 18).

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy earned his seventh win of the season on August 19 against the Texas Rangers at Target Field, a 2-1 Twins victory...allowed one run on two hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in 5.1 innings of work...marked his first win since July 16 vs. Chicago-AL.

STAYING IN THE ZONE: Bundy threw 51 of his 71 pitches for strikes in his last home start on August 19, good for a 71.1 strike percentage...has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in 12 of his 22 starts this season.

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 23 batters in 108.2 innings, including five starts with no walks allowed and 11 starts with one walk...this equates to a career-low 5.1 walk percentage and a 1.90 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (33.3%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.8%).

- His 5.1 walk percentage ranks ninth in the American League (min. 100.0 IP), while his 1.90 walks-per-9.0 IP is 11th under those same parameters. Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 89th percentile in baseball this season and his chase rate ranks in the 88th percentile.

VS. BOSTON: Bundy is due to start against the Red Sox for the second time this season after earning the 8-3 win on April 18 at Fenway Park, tossing 5.1 innings and allowing one run on five hits, with no walks and six strikeouts...is a career 4-9, 5.36 ERA (94.0 IP, 56 ER) with 36 walks and 72 strikeouts in 21 games (16 starts) against Boston...has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in three of his last four starts against the Red Sox, since June 15, 2019.

- With 21 career appearances and 16 starts against Boston, Bundy has faced the Red Sox more than any other opponent in his career...his 72 strikeouts against Boston are his third most against any single opponent in his career, trailing Toronto (85) and Tampa Bay (73).

BACK ON TARGET: Bundy has pitched well at Target Field so far this season, going 4-1, 2.68 ERA (40.1 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks, 26 strikeouts and a .207 (31-for-150) opponent batting average in his eight home starts (twins are 5-3)...however, just eight of his 22 starts this season have come at home...this compares to his 3-5, 5.66 ERA (68.1 IP, 43 ER), 15 walks, 51 strikeouts and .283 (77-for-272) opponent batting average he's posted in 14 road starts.

- Is 2-0, 3.68 ERA (14.2 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and 11 strikeouts in his last three home starts, since July 16 (Twins are 3-0). Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in six of his eight home starts this season...the two exceptions are June 9 vs. New York-AL (4 ER) and July 16 vs. Chicago-AL (3 ER)...if you remove those two home starts, Bundy has a 1.45 ERA (31.0 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts.

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.3 seconds when there are runners on base, the third-fastest worker for qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Joe Ryan - 21.4 seconds and Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.4 seconds with runners on base.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 22 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...36 of his 77 strikeouts this season (47 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 2-7, 4.34 ERA // CAREER: 63-88, 3.91 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is due to start the middle game of this series tomorrow night at Target Field...took the loss in his last start on August 25 at Houston, allowing five runs on eight hits (1 home run), with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...the Twins have dropped his last eight starts (since June 30), while he is 0-4, 6.35 ERA (34.0 IP, 24 ER)...is due to face the Red Sox for the first time since 2018 with Tampa Bay; took a pair of no-decisions and posted a 3.75 ERA (12.0 IP), 5 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in two starts that season...career 2-12, 5.27 ERA (111.0 IP, 65 ER) with 57 walks and 129 strikeouts in 21 starts against Boston...his 12 losses to the Red Sox are his most against any single opponent in his career.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhart Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews. Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and Baseball America Minor League All-Star. Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April, 2012 (30 consecutive scoreless IP) and named Orioles top prospect by Baseball America following the season. Originally selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.
