**THE TWINS:** After completing their nine-day, seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-0 at Detroit, 0-2 at Milwaukee and 1-2 at San Diego), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a win and a loss to the Tigers over the last two nights...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against Detroit...starting tomorrow night, Minnesota will welcome the Blue Jays for four games from tomorrow-Sunday...the Twins are 28-23 at home and 26-26 on the road.

**TIGERS EVEN UP SERIES AT TARGET FIELD:** The Twins lost to the Tigers last night by a score of 5-3...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on two hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and a season-high eight strikeouts...the Twins used a total of six pitchers in relief of Archer...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Jake Cave who returned to the Twins and made his season debut, reaching three times on a single, a double and a walk...Mark Contreras recorded his first major league home run, a 407-foot shot off Matt Manning in the third inning.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Twins have selected the contract of catcher Sandy León from Triple-A St. Paul and returned left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...León, 33, was acquired via trade with the Cleveland Guardians yesterday in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Ian Hamilton...León has split the 2022 season between Triple-A Louisville (LIV) and Columbus (CLE), combining to hit .226 (19-for-84) with three doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI...he appeared in eight games with the Guardians earlier this season...the Maracaibo, Venezuela native has played in 510 career major league games over 11 seasons with Washington, Boston, Cleveland and Miami...Thielbar, who has missed the last nine games with a left hamstring strain, has made a team-leading 40 relief appearances for the Twins this season, going 2-0 with one save, a 4.84 ERA (35.1 IP, 19 ER), 15 walks and 47 strikeouts...he made one rehab appearance for the Saints, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout on July 31 vs. Iowa...to make room on the 26-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins have optioned catcher Caleb Hamilton to Triple-A St. Paul and designated right-handed pitcher Joe Smith for release or assignment.

**TIGER KINGS:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the 16th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 9-6 against Detroit this season, going 6-2 at Target Field and 3-4 at Comerica Park.

- ☞ The Twins have won 26 of their last 41 over the Tigers and 31 of their last 49.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco is a career .297 (113-for-381) hitter with 21 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 55 RBI, 30 walks, 52 runs scored and a .816 OPS in 98 games against the Tigers.
- ☞ Gio Urshela is a career .325 (40-for-123) hitter with an .846 OPS in 39 games against the Tigers...he is hitting .385 (20-for-52) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, eight runs scored and a .979 OPS in 14 games vs. the Tigers this season.
- ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .345 (10-for-29) in nine games vs. the Tigers this season.
- ☞ Twins pitchers have struck out 27 Tigers this series and 134 this season, their most of any opponent in 2022 (next, Chicago-AL - 87).
- ☞ Twins batters have posted a 2.91 ERA (133.0 IP, 43 ER) against Detroit this season with Tiger batters hitting .213 (105-for-493).

**MIRANDA WATCH:** Since July 1, Jose Miranda is hitting .342 (26-for-76) with two doubles, five home runs, 22 RBI, a .398 on-base percentage, a .566 slugging percentage and a .963 OPS in 22 games...among all AL players since that date, he ranks tied for third in RBI, fifth in batting average, seventh in slugging, eighth in OPS and 10th in on-base percentage.

- ☞ Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.275) and slugging percentage (.468), third in OPS (.786) and fourth in on-base percentage (.318).

**CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE:** The Twins have gone 26-20 against the AL Central this season...26 wins marks the fourth-most inter-divisional wins in the AL (New York 32-16 vs. the East, Houston 35-20 vs. the West and Seattle 28-22 vs. the West)...after today's game, they will play just three games against the division this month, a three-game series against the Royals at Target Field from August 15-17...they are 6-4 against Kansas City, 6-4 against Chicago-AL, 9-6 against Detroit and 5-6 against Cleveland.

**SERIES FINALE:** The Twins are 15-12-5 in series play this season, going 8-5-3 at home and 7-7-2 on the road...they began the season going 11-5-4 in series play, but have gone 4-7-1 since...Minnesota's last series victory came in a two-game sweep of the Tigers at Comerica Park from July 23-24.

**DAY MEN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MEN:** The Twins have played 48 day games this season, tied for fourth-most in baseball with Chicago-AL, and trailing Detroit (53), Cleveland (51) and Oakland (50)...they have gone 27-21 in day games, tied with Cleveland (27-24) for the second-most day wins in baseball, trailing Houston (28-12).

- ☞ Since the start of last season, the Twins have played 117 day games, trailing Detroit (122) and Oakland (120) for the most in baseball in that span.
- ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .337 (29-for-86) in day games this season, the fourth-best average in the American League, while Luis Arraez ranks fifth at .329 (57-for-173).

**NEW 'PEN PALS:** The Twins added two bullpen arms prior to yesterday's trade deadline in Jorge López (Baltimore) and Michael Fulmer (Detroit)...López last appeared for the Orioles on Saturday at Cincinnati and got warm last night had the Twins taken a late lead...Fulmer, who changed clubhouses mid-day, last appeared on Monday night against the Twins.

- ☞ López, who was named to the 2022 American League All-Star team, has gone 4-6 with a 1.68 ERA (48.1 IP, 9 ER), 19 saves (23 opportunities), 17 walks, 54 strikeouts, a 0.97 WHIP, a .174 opponent batting average, a .529 opponent OPS and just three home runs allowed...the 29-year-old ranks tied for sixth in the AL in saves and second (minimum 45.0 IP) in opponent batting average, third in ERA, fourth in opponent OPS, ninth in WHIP and 15th in strikeouts-per-9.0 IP (10.06).
- ☞ Fulmer, 29, has gone 3-4 with a 3.20 ERA (39.1 IP, 14 ER), two saves, 18 holds, 20 walks, 39 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP, a .203 opponent batting average, a .580 opponent OPS and just one home run allowed in 41 games...he has held right-handed batters to a .140 (12-for-86) batting average and left-handed batters to a .298 (17-for-57) batting average...his 18 holds are tied for second-most in the American League and tied for fourth-most in baseball...he was named 2016 AL Rookie of the Year and a 2017 AL All-Star.

- Making his 17th start and appearance of 2022...also his 22nd career start and appearance. Facing Detroit for the third time this season, going 2-0, 0.71 ERA (12.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks, 16 strikeouts and a .116 (5-for-43) opponent batting average in his two prior starts. Acquired by the Twins from Tampa Bay on July 22, 2021, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan took the loss in his last start on July 29 at San Diego, as the Twins fell 10-1... allowed a career-high 10 runs on a career-high-tying eight hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...

- Ryan's five home runs allowed matched a single-game Twins/Senators record for the fourth time, previously done by Firpo Marberry (Game 1, May 30, 1932 at Philadelphia). Bert Blyleven (September 13, 1986 vs. Texas) and Carlos Silva (August 22, 2006 at Baltimore)...also became the only pitcher in Twins/Senators history to yield at least five home runs and strike out at least seven batters in an outing... Ryan became the first Twins pitcher to permit at least 10 runs since Rick Reed (11 R/10 ER) on April 21, 2003 vs. New York-AL...

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan earned the win on July 23 at Detroit, yielding one run on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings, as the Twins beat the Tigers 8-4...

LEADING THE WAY: Enters today among rookie pitching leaders in a few categories (min. 45.0 IP). Category table with columns: Category, Ryan's #, AL/MLB Ranks.

EARNING HIS STRIPES: Facing Detroit for the third time this season and fourth time in his career today...is 2-0, 0.71 ERA (12.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks, 16 strikeouts and a .116 (5-for-43) opponent batting average in his two prior starts against the Tigers...dominated Detroit earlier this season on April 27 at Target Field, allowing just one hit and one walk, with a season-high nine strikeouts over 7.0 shutout innings in a 5-0 Twins win...

CENTRIFUGAL FORCE: Making his eighth start and appearance against the American League Central division this afternoon...is 5-0, 1.79 ERA (40.1 IP, 8 ER) with eight walks, 42 strikeouts and a .193 (28-for-145) opponent batting average in his seven prior starts. Owns the lowest opponent batting average (min. 30.0 IP), second lowest opponent OPS (.578, behind Devin Smeltzer - .511) and fourth lowest ERA against the AL Central this season...

A SUNNY DISPOSITION: Is making his eighth daytime start this afternoon...has gone 4-1, 2.48 ERA (36.1 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks and 28 strikeouts in his seven prior starts...has performed better under the sun than under the lights this season...

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his ninth start at Target Field this season and first since July 13, his last outing prior to the All-Star Break...has gone 3-2, 3.05 ERA (44.1 IP, 15 ER) with 15 walks and 39 strikeouts at home...this compares to 3-2, 4.57 ERA (41.1 IP, 21 ER) with 10 walks and 41 strikeouts in eight starts on the road...

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball...he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 57.6% of the time through his first 16 starts of 2022... here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant. PITCH (AVG. MPH) PCT. (# OF PITCHES, VS. RHB/LHB) RESULTS table.

PATH TO VICTORY: Leads Twins pitchers and all major league rookies with seven wins this season (Twins are 10-6 in his starts)...owns the most single-season victories by a Twins rookie pitcher since Trevor May tied 8-9 in 48 games (16 starts) in 2015... the single-season record for most wins by a Twins rookie pitcher is 16, done by Jim Hughes in 1975. Should Ryan earn the win today, it would be his 10th career victory in his 22nd career start/appearance...would become the eighth pitcher in Twins/Senators history to earn at least 10 wins within his first 22 career games...

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2022 SEASON: 6-3, 3.41 ERA // CAREER: 88-75, 3.60 ERA)

Right-hander Sonny Gray is scheduled to start tomorrow night's series opener against the Toronto Blue Jays at Target Field...earned the win in his last start on July 30 at San Diego, leading the Twins to a 7-4 triumph after permitting just five hits and one run on a Jurickson Profar solo homer, with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...

CAREER NOTES

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020. Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K). Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts. Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA. In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season. In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts). Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August. Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts... earned the win in his professional debut on June 22 vs. Vermont, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 3 K). Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus. Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams, including first team All-America honors by the Division II Conference Commissioners Association...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 80 batters so far, which will lead to 4,000 new trees planted.

MONEY MOVES: Ryan drew attention when chasing after a foul ball and calling off catcher Ryan Jeffers earlier this season...upon catching the ball, Ryan signaled "5-0-0" to the dugout...Ryan told reporters that each foul ball caught is good for \$100 from each fellow starter.
