DAYS WITH "ZERO CARES" $\rightarrow 4$ : The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a behind victory this season...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not tactor into the decision allowing two runs on nine hits in 4.2 innings pitched....Caleb Thielbar (1.1 1P), Jhoan Duran (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jorge Lopez (1.0 PP) com bine... to po pitch 4.1 one-hit innings of relief,
with no walks and six strikeouts...the Twins trailed 2-1 in the fifth inning until Gio Urshela with no waks and six strikeouts. the wins trailed 2- in the tirth inning until Gio. Orshela career double and 21 st of the season - good for second on the teanm (Arraez - 23 ). recorded at 1034 MPH. the fastest recordad pitch of his career.....Was also the fasteast pitct
