THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-0 so far on their six-game homestand, sweeping the Giants over the weekend, followed by a win in the series opener over the Red Sox last night... tonight, they will play the second of three against Boston... after tomorrow night's season series finale, the Twins will travel to Chicago to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, followed by three against the White Sox on the South Side over the weekend... they will continue the trip with four games next week in New York against the Yankees from September 5-8... the Twins have gone 39-28 at home and 27-33 on the road.

DAYS WITH "ZERO CARES" —> 4: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2, extending their winning streak to four games while earning their 16th come-from-behind victory this season... Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on nine hits in 4.2 innings pitched... Caleb Thielbar (1.1 IP), Jhoan Duran (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jorge López (1.0 IP) combined to pitch 4.1 one-hit innings of relief, with no walks and six strikeouts... the Twins trailed 2-1 in the fifth inning until Gio Urshela hit a two-out bases clearing double, giving the Twins a 4-2 lead... it marked Urshela's 100th career double and 21st of the season - good for second on the team (Arraez - 23).
 ☞ Jhoan Duran tossed 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout... his four-seam fastball was recorded at 103.4 MPH, the fastest recorded pitch of his career... was also the fastest pitch thrown by a Twins pitcher in the Statcast era (2015-present)... tied for the third-fastest pitch thrown in the major leagues this season (trails Jordan Hicks - 103.8 and 103.7)... his seventh-inning splinker registered at 100.8 MPH, the first off-speed pitch thrown over 100.0 MPH in major league history.

MORE ON THE STREAK: The current four-game winning streak is tied with Los Angeles-AL and Arizona for the longest active streak in baseball... the Twins are one of nine teams in baseball with five different winning streaks of four-plus games (LAD - 9, NYY - 8, HOU - 7, SD - 7, MIL - 6, CLE - 5, PHI - 5, SF - 5)... below are some numbers from the streak.
 ☞ Twins batters have hit .277 (36-for-130) with eight doubles, four home runs, 20 walks and an .807 OPS... they have hit .303 (10-for-33) with a 1.008 OPS with RISP.
 ☞ Twins pitchers have posted a 1.70 ERA (37.0 IP, 7 ER) with opponents hitting .212 (28-for-132), 11 walks and no home runs... starters have posted a 2.33 ERA (19.1 IP, 5 ER), while relievers have posted a 1.02 ERA (17.2 IP, 2 ER).
 ☞ Four straight homerless games for Twins pitchers ties a season-long streak, done twice previously, from May 6-10 and August 16-20.
 ☞ Carlos Correa has gone 8-for-15 (.533) with two walks, one double, one home run and four RBI... Jake Cave is 4-for-10 (.500) with one double, one home run and six RBI... Max Kepler is 4-for-10 (.400) with three walks.

PITCHING IN: Twins starters have combined to go 6-7, 3.24 ERA (127.2 IP, 46 ER) with 41 walks, 125 strikeouts and a .223 (105-for-470) opponent batting average in 26 games this month... below are Twins starting pitching comparisons numbers by month:

TWINS-SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the sixth of seven games in 2022... the Twins are 3-2 against the Red Sox this season... next season, the Twins will visit Fenway Park for a three-game series from April 18-20 and host the Red Sox for four games from June 19-22.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .323 (52-for-161) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 25 RBI, 35 runs scored, 29 walks, a .426 on-base percentage, a .559 slugging percentage and a .985 OPS in 43 career regular season games against the Red Sox.
 ☞ Gary Sánchez has 54 RBI in his career against the Red Sox (71 games), his most vs. any opponent (Baltimore - 52, Tampa Bay - 44).
 ☞ Gio Urshela is hitting .313 (52-for-166) with 12 doubles, six home runs, 30 RBI and an .844 OPS in 51 career regular season games vs. the Sox... he has reached base eight times in his last 12 plate appearances vs. the Red Sox (3 games).

UR THE MAN: Gio Urshela is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with three doubles, one home run, six RBI and five walks in his last 13 games, since August 16... he recorded his 100th career double last night, one game after recording his 500th career hit — also a double.

EXP-'LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa is hitting .339 (19-for-56) with 11 walks, seven RBI, a .435 on-base percentage and a .935 OPS in his last 16 games... he has reached safely multiple times in nine of those 16.
 ☞ In 54 home games this season, he is hitting .302 (61-for-202) with an .851 OPS... in his last 36 home games, he is hitting .326 (42-for-129) with a .918 OPS... he has reached safely in 13 of his last 21 plate appearances at Target Field (.556/.619/1.508).
 ☞ He has 16 walks in 26 games this month... his career-high for walks in any month is 19, done in both May and June of last season.

A MONTH OF MINNEAPOLIS: Today marks the 19th of 20 scheduled home games in August, the most for the Twins in a single month since playing a Minnesota-era record 22 at Metropolitan Stadium in June 1977... the Twins have gone 12-6 in 18 home games this month... they enter today first in the AL in home wins this month and tied for third in baseball with New York-NL (12-3), trailing Philadelphia (13-5) and St. Louis (13-2).
 ☞ They are 39-28 at Target Field this season, fourth-most wins in the AL and tied for eighth-most in baseball.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1987, Kirby Puckett set a club record with six hits at Milwaukee, recording two home runs, two doubles and two singles... Puckett tied his own record May 23, 1991 in 11 innings vs. Texas... in 2007, the Twins held a ceremony to break ground on Target Field... Target Field's first game was on April 12, 2010 vs. Boston (5-4 win).

TWINS ON A STICK: The 2022 Minnesota State Fair is taking place in St. Paul through Labor Day... the Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, rain or shine, throughout the fair's duration... fans can have the opportunity to meet T.C. Bear, play wiffle ball home run derby/batting practice, win giveaway items, shop for their favorite Twins clothing and merchandise, and much more.

- ☞ Making his 23rd start of the season, matching Dylan Bundy for the team lead and his most since also making 23 for Pittsburgh in 2019...is his 238th career start and 241st career appearance.
- ☞ Will make his 22nd career start and appearance against Boston, but first since May 23, 2018 (with Tampa Bay)...is 2-12, 5.27 ERA (111.0 IP, 65 ER) lifetime against the Red Sox.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Handed his fourth-straight loss (and the Twins' eighth-consecutive defeat in his starts) in a 6-3 setback to the Houston Astros on August 25 at Minute Maid Park...allowed five runs on a season-high eight hits (1 home run) in 4.0 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...big blow was Trey Mancini's two-out, three-run homer to cap a four-run first inning.

- ☞ Threw 88 pitches, his second most this season (behind only the 90 he threw on June 30 at Cleveland).

TWO STARTS AGO: Matched his season high (5th time) with 5.0 innings pitched on August 20 vs. Texas, allowing just one run on three hits, with one walk and five strikeouts, but did not factor into the decision as the Rangers won, 4-3, in 10 innings...departed with the game tied 1-1; marked the seventh time this season he recorded the final out of an inning and ended his outing with the Twins either tied or ahead, only for Minnesota to lose...lone Rangers run off Archer came via a two-out, RBI-double in the first inning by Adolis Garcia.

- ☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his five 5.0-inning starts and one-or-fewer in four of those efforts.

EIGHT IS ENOUGH: The Twins have dropped eight-straight Archer starts, his career worst stretch of consecutive team losses when he takes the hill (surpassing the 7-straight Pittsburgh defeats between July 12 through August 14, 2019 and the 7 Tampa Bay losses from June 11 through July 15, 2016).

- ☞ Minnesota's last win in an Archer start came in his last personal victory, June 25 vs. Colorado at Target Field...since then, he is 0-4, 6.35 ERA (34.0 IP, 24 ER).
- ☞ The Twins went 7-7 in Archer's first 14 starts, while he was 2-3, 3.14 ERA (57.1 IP, 20 ER).

DIRTY WATER: Archer is set to make his 22nd career start and appearance against Boston, matching his 22 outings (21 starts) vs. Baltimore for his second-most games against any opponent (26 starts and appearances against Toronto)...however, is 2-12, 5.27 ERA (111.0 IP, 65 ER) lifetime against the Red Sox (all while with Tampa Bay); the losses are his most vs. any team, while the ERA is highest against any opponent he has faced at least 10 times.

- ☞ Ironically given his future struggles, Archer's first major league victory came against Boston in his first-ever start against the Red Sox, a 13-3 Rays win on September 9, 2012 at Tropicana Field (5.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/ER, 4 BB, 6 K).
- ☞ His second (and most recent) win vs. the Red Sox came on April 14, 2017 at Fenway Park (5.2 IP, 6 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 5 K).
- ☞ Has not faced Boston since May 23, 2018 at Tropicana Field; did not factor in the decision as the Rays lost, 4-1 (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 3 BB, 6 K).

EVEN / ODD: Archer's 2022 season has mostly rotated between solid and poor months...even with the rough outing in Houston, he is a combined 2-3, 3.20 ERA (64.2 IP, 23 ER) with a .198 opponent batting average (46-for-232) in 15 "even" month starts (April, June and August) this season...by contrast, he is 0-4, 7.09 ERA (26.2 IP, 21 ER) with a .252 batting average against (30-for-119) in seven "odd" month outings (May and July).

ARCHER ON TARGET: Is 2-1, 3.10 ERA (29.0 IP, 10 ER) with 10 walks, 29 strikeouts and a .168 opponent batting average (17-for-101) in his last six starts at Target Field.

- ☞ In 11 home starts overall this season, he is 2-3, 3.83 ERA (47.0 IP, 20 ER) with a .211/.286/.331 opponent slash line (37-for-175 with 15 2B and 2 HR)...in 11 road starts, he is 0-4, 4.87 ERA (44.1 IP, 24 ER) with a .235/.340/.434 opponent slash line (39-for-166 with 9 2B and 8 HR).
- ☞ In 17 career starts at Target Field (11 with Minnesota, 5 with Tampa Bay and 1 with Pittsburgh), Archer is 6-3, 3.17 ERA (82.1 IP, 29 ER).

CREATURE OF THE NIGHT: Archer has fared better under the lights this season, going 2-2, 3.38 ERA (50.2 IP, 19 ER) with a .218 opponent batting average (41-for-188) in 12 night starts...by contrast, has scuffled to an 0-5 mark with a 5.53 ERA (40.2 IP, 25 ER) and a .229 opponent batting average (35-for-153) in 10 day starts.

TROUBLE GETTING OFF THE FIELD: 41.7 percent of the runs Archer has allowed this season (20-of-48) have come after he recorded the first two outs of an inning; 12 of those have come after there were two out and nobody on.

- ☞ Opposing batters have a .264 average (32-for-121) and a .774 OPS (10 2B, 2 HR and 21 BB) off Archer with two outs...collectively, MLB players are hitting .237 with a .704 OPS with two outs.

MAKING A RUN AT SOME CAREER BESTS: Archer's .223 opponent batting average (76-for-341) and 89.0 mph average exit velocity would both be career-best marks over a full season, while his opponent batting average on balls in play (.258) and hits allowed per 9.0 innings (7.49) would both rank second (behind only his 2013 rookie season).

THE ARSENAL: Archer has relied on four pitches during his inaugural Twins season, per Baseball Savant...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:
