THE TWINS: Began their first homestand after the All-Star Break with a three-game series victory over the Tigers this week, taking games one and three...they will continue the homestand tonight with the first of four against the Blue Jays through Sunday...the Twins are 29-23 at home and 26-26 on the road...the Twins are 8-6 in their last 14 games at Target Field.

TWINS WIN TRADE DEADLINE FOR SECOND STRAIGHT DAY: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-1, winning the series, marking their 16th series victory this season (16-12-5)...Joe Ryan (8-4) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high-tying nine strikeouts... Michael Fulmer and Jorge López each made their Twins debuts as Fulmer earned his 19th hold with a scoreless sixth inning and López earned his 20th save with a scoreless ninth on seven pitches...the offense recorded seven hits as Sandy León made his Twins debut by going 2-for-3 with a double and two RBI.

GARLICK ON THE SHELF: The Twins announced today that they have placed outfielder Kyle Garlick on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to August 2) with a right ribcage contusion and reinstated outfielder Gilberto Celestino from the Paternity List...Garlick, who suffered the injury colliding with the leftfield wall on July 29 at San Diego, has played in 51 games for the Twins this season, hitting .257 (27-for-105) with three doubles, eight home runs, 18 runs scored, 17 RBI, a .319 on-base percentage and an .833 OPS...Celestino, who was placed on the Paternity List on Monday to attend the birth of his son, has played in 69 games for the Twins this season, hitting .270 (44-for-163) with seven doubles, one triple, 17 runs scored, nine RBI, 12 walks and a .328 on-base percentage...additionally, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran to Triple-A St. Paul and activated right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle, who was acquired in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds on Tuesday.

TWINS AND TORONTO: The Twins are playing the fourth of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they are hosting the Jays for the first time since splitting a four-game series from September 23-26, 2021...the Twins visited Rogers Centre for a three-game series from June 3-5, winning games one and three...over those three games, Twins batters hit .312 (34-for-109) with four doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 6.7 runs-per-game.

☞ The Twins have gone just 31-47 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 13-8 in their last 21, dating back to May of 2018.

☞ Twins hitters have homered 37 times against the Jays since the start of 2019, but just nine of those have come at Target Field.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .318 (28-for-88) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.063 OPS in 23 career games vs. the Jays...he has reached safely in 10 straight against the Jays, dating back to May of 2019.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .303 (37-for-122) with eight doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and an .862 OPS in 31 career games vs. the Jays.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .324 (24-for-74) with six home runs, 19 RBI and a .998 OPS in 18 career regular season games vs. the Jays.

☞ Other notables during that previous three-game series: Kyle Garlick went 3-for-3 with two homers...Luis Arraez went 6-for-9...Gilberto Celestino went 4-for-6...Jose Miranda went 5-for-12 with two homers...Byron Buxton went 3-for-8 with a homer.

LOAD UP THE BUCK TRUCK: Byron Buxton is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with one double, one triple, three home runs, three RBI, nine runs scored, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.071 OPS in his last 10 games...since homering off Los Angeles-NL's Tony Gonsolin at the All-Star Game, Buck has homered three times in six games out of the break (all solo).

☞ Buxton enters today with 26 home runs, fourth-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (43), Kyle Schwarber (33), Yordan Alvarez (30), Austin Riley (29), Pete Alonso (28) and Anthony Rizzo (27).

☞ He has a barrels-per-plate appearance percentage of 9.9, the sixth-best in the AL and 11th-best in baseball...Buck is on pace to hit 40 homers this season.

☞ Buxton has posted a .548 slugging percentage on breaking pitches this season, the ninth-best in baseball (minimum 1,000 pitches seen).

RED HOT JOSE: Since July 1, Jose Miranda is hitting .342 (27-for-79) with two doubles, five home runs, 22 RBI, a .402 on-base percentage, a .557 slugging percentage and a .959 OPS in 23 games...among all AL players since that date, he ranks tied for fourth in RBI, sixth in batting average, seventh in slugging and OPS, and eighth in on-base percentage.

☞ Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.276) and slugging percentage (.467), third in OPS (.788) and fourth in on-base percentage (.321).

STAFF REFLECTION: In their last five games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 2-1, 3.33 ERA (24.1 IP, 9 ER), with six walks, 33 strikeouts, two home runs allowed and a .202 opponents batting average...Sonny Gray is 2-0, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven hits allowed, two walks and 12 strikeouts in his last two starts (at DET and at SD)...Gray is 4-4, 3.20 ERA (70.1 IP, 25 ER) with nine quality starts in 13 career games (9 starts) against the Blue Jays...his last win vs. the Jays came on September 23, 2017 at Rogers Centre.

TARGET FIELD TUNES: After tonight's game, GRAMMY-nominated, Multi-Platinum country superstar Cole Swindell will play the ballpark's first-ever postgame concert, a full 75-minute set...Target Field has hosted 17 concerts and music festivals since opening in 2010, but Swindell is the first in the venue's 13-year history to perform following a Twins game.

CONGRATS JEFFERS FAMILY!: Catcher Ryan Jeffers and his wife, Lexi, had their first child last night, a daughter named Harper Jean... Jeffers is currently on the 10-day Injured List with a right thumb contusion.

BRING 'EM OUT: The Twins have drawn 1,121,932 in attendance this season through 103 dates, for an average of 21,999...they have one sellout this season, coming on July 13 vs. Milwaukee, drawing 38,802.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, Jerry Bell was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame, becoming the 33rd member...Bell was named the third president in Twins history in January 1987...later this month, Ron Gardenhire, Dan Gladden and César Tovar will become the 35th, 36th and 37th members of the Twins HOF on August 20 and 21.

- ☞ Will be his first outing against Toronto since a relief appearance on August 19, 2018 with New York-AL and first start since July 6, 2018 (L, 2.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K)...is a career 4-4, 3.20 ERA (70.1 IP, 25 ER) with 36 walks and 62 strikeouts in 13 career games (12 starts) against the Blue Jays.
- ☞ Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with right-handed minor league pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on July 30 at San Diego as the Twins defeated the Padres, 7-4...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed one run, a solo home run to Manny Machado in the bottom of the third inning, with one walk and five strikeouts...was the 15th start of his career in which he has allowed just one run on a home run...paired with his start on July 24 at Detroit, recorded back-to-back wins for the second time this season (also three-straight wins from May 18-29).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win in his first start of the second half, as the Twins defeated the Tigers 9-1 on July 24 at Comerica Park...allowed just one run on two hits and one walk, while striking out seven batters in 6.0 innings of work...Twins scored six runs in the final three innings to secure the victory...marked Gray's longest outing (6.0 IP) since June 27 at Cleveland (W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K)...also was the fewest hits allowed since May 29 vs. Kansas City (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K)...marked his fifth quality start of the season, third most by a Twins starter (Joe Ryan and Devin Smeltzer have 6 QS each).

HIGHS AND LOWS OF JULY: Struggled in his first three starts of July, going 0-2, 9.45 ERA (13.1 IP, 14 ER) with six walks and eight strikeouts...turned his month around in his last two starts, with a 2-0 record, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 12 strikeouts.

- ☞ Had a 5.92 ERA (24.1 IP, 16 ER) through five July starts this season...in contrast, has a career 3.46 ERA (247.1 IP, 95 ER) in the month of July, the second-lowest monthly ERA (min. 3 starts) in his career, trailing his 2.78 career ERA in August.
- ☞ With his starts on July 8 at Texas (5 ER) and July 14 vs. Chicago-AL (6 ER), Gray allowed five-or-more earned runs in back-to-back starts for the seventh time in his career, and the first time since July 18-25, 2021 with Cincinnati...marked the first time he lost back-to-back starts since September 12 (at St. Louis) and September 18, 2021 (vs. Los Angeles-NL).

AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS: Scheduled to face Toronto for the first time since a relief appearance on August 19, 2018 with New York-AL (2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 K) and will make his first start against the Blue Jays since July 6, 2018 (L, 2.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K)...is a career 4-4, 3.20 ERA (70.1 IP, 25 ER) with 36 walks and 62 strikeouts in 13 career games (12 starts) against Toronto.

- ☞ **Gray made his first career major league start (with Oakland) on August 10, 2013 at Toronto and recorded a quality start in the 5-4 loss...**tossed 6.0 innings and allowed four runs (2 earned) on four hits, with three walks and five strikeouts...his two earned runs came off a José Bautista two-run home run in the bottom of the first inning.
- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10 of his 12 starts against Toronto and two-or-fewer earned runs in eight of those efforts.

BACK ON TARGET: Will make his ninth start of the season at Target Field tonight, going 2-1, 3.96 ERA (38.2 IP, 17 ER) with 13 walks and 45 strikeouts in his eight prior efforts...this compares to 4-2, 2.80 ERA (35.1 IP, 11 ER) with six walks and 24 strikeouts in seven starts on the road.

- ☞ Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in his first seven home starts this season before allowing six runs in his most recent start against Chicago-AL on July 14 (L, 3.2 IP, 9 H, 6 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K)...was 2-0, 2.83 ERA (35.0 IP, 11 ER) in those first seven starts.
- ☞ One of his most dominant performances this season came at home on May 24 vs. Detroit...struck out a season-high 10 batters while allowing four hits and walking one in 7.0 scoreless innings.

KEEP IT IN THE PARK: Has allowed just seven home runs through his first 15 starts of the season (74.0 IP)...has allowed the third-fewest home runs by an American League starter this season (min. 15 GS), trailing Patrick Sandoval (4 HR in 17 GS/89.2 IP) and Kevin Gausman (6 HR in 20 GS/111.2 IP)...seven home runs allowed are his third-fewest home runs in his first 15 starts of the season in his career (allowed 4 HR through 15 starts in 2015 and allowed 6 HR through 15 starts in 2014).

RISPY BUSINESS: Gray has held opponents to a .220 (11-for-50) batting average with runners in scoring position this season, the second best of his career...trails the .160 (19-for-119) opponent batting average with RISP he posted in 2019.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...35 of his 69 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .202 (22-for-109) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.

- ☞ His fastball spin ranks in the 95th percentile among all major league pitchers this season and his curve spin is in the 88th percentile.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP TYLER MAHLE [2022 SEASON: 5-7, 4.40 ERA // CAREER: 31-38, 4.35 ERA]

Right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle is scheduled to make his Twins debut tomorrow night against Toronto after being acquired from the Cincinnati Reds on Tuesday, August 2, in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajar...earned the win in his last start for the Reds on July 30 vs. Baltimore, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts...is 3-2, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER), 16 walks and 64 strikeouts in his last nine starts, including seven quality starts...will face Toronto for the first time in his career and will be his second career start against the American League East after earning the win on July 30 at Baltimore.
