LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his last start for Cincinnati, on July 30 vs. Baltimore, his second-straight victory...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in the Reds' 8-2 win...fiis 27 pitches in the first inning were his second-highest pitch total in the opening frame this season (trailing the 31 pitches he threw in the first inning on May 3 at Milwaukee)...was the first time he won back-to-back games this season and was the fifth time in his career he has won back-to-back starts (longest winning streak is 5-straight games from May 25 to June 16, 2021).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the 6-3 victory on July 25 vs. St. Louis after allowing three runs on two hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...all three runs came off home runs hit by Paul Goldschmidt (2-run home run in the 4th inning and solo home run in the 6th inning)...threw just seven pitches in the first inning with one strikeout, his fewest number of pitches in any full inning this season...was his second start of the season with two home runs allowed (also May 24 vs. Chicago).

BLUE JAY WATCHER: Will be facing the Blue Jays for the first time in his career and the American League East for the second time, after earning the win in his last start on July 30 at Baltimore...has faced the AL just 20 times (19 starts) in his career, as opposed to his 94 appearances (all starts) against the National League...is a career 6-5, 4.39 ERA (98.1 IP, 48 ER) with 44 walks and 113 strikeouts against AL opponents.
After tonight's start against Toronto, Mahle will have faced 26 MLB teams in his career...he has yet to face Boston, Cincinnati, New York-AL and Tampa Bay.

WELCOME BACK TO TARGET FIELD: Mahle will make his fourth career start at Target Field, going 1-0, 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP, 5 ER) with seven walks and 19 strikeouts in his three prior starts (all with Cincinnati)...earned the win in his first visit to Minneapolis on April 29, 2018 (6.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 7 K) as the Reds won, 8-2. Thas gone 2-5, 4.76 ERA (64.1 IP, 34 ER) with 28 walks and 69 strikeouts in 12 starts at his

Has gone 2-5, 4.76 ERA (64.1 IP, 34 ER) with 28 walks and 69 strikeouts in 12 starts at his prior home, Great American Ball Park, this season...this compares to 3-2, 3.83 ERA (40.0 IP, 17 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts on the road. Has posted a career 3.74 ERA (308.1 IP, 128 ER) in 59 starts away from Great American Ball Park, including 22 quality starts...has held opponents to a .243/.309/.373 slash line away from Cincinnati (284-for-1171 with 28 HR) æ

WORKING THE NIGHT SHIFT: Scheduled to start his eighth game under the lights this season; has been consistent both at night and during the day...is 3-3, 4.58 ERA (39.1 IP, 20 ER) with 10 walks and 46 strikeouts at night, compared to 2-4, 4.29 ERA (65.0 IP, 31 ER) with 29 walks and 68 strikeouts does not be the strikeouts at night.

Φ Mahle's most dominant start of the season came at night on June 14 at Arizona...did not factor into the decision after he went 9.0 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the Reds won 5-3 in 12 innings.

LEADING THE WAY: The newest member of the Twins' staff ranks first among the current rotation (Chris Archer, Dylan Bundy, Sonny Gray and Joe Ryan) in games started (19), quality starts (9), innings pitched (104.1), strikeouts (114) and swing and miss percentage (27.9%).

PUTTING IN THE WORK: Mahle has thrown over 100 pitches in 10 of his 19 starts this season, and has gone over 110 pitches on three occasions (June 14 at Arizona - 119, June 21 at Los Angeles-NL - 111 and July 2 vs. Atlanta - 110)...he has also produced 10 starts of at least 6.0 innings pitched and four starts where he has recorded at least one out in the seventh inning-or-later...the rest of the Twins starters this season have a combined six starts with 100-or-more pitches (Joe Ryan - 3 starts, Dylan Bundy - 1 start, Cole Sands - 1 start and Devin Smeltzer - 1 start).

WITH THE REDS: Went 5-7, 4.40 ERA (104.1 IP, 51 ER) with 39 walks, 114 strikeouts and a .248 (91-for-393) opponent batting average in 19 starts with the Reds this season...had an 18-day stint on the 15-day Injured List from July 6-23 with a right shoulder strain...in his last nine starts, he has a 3-2 record, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER) with seven quality starts, 16 walks and a .212 (44-for-208) proponent batting average

 Produced four-consecutive quality starts from May 29-June 14, the longest such streak of his career.
 In his outing on May 29 vs. San Francisco, did not allow a hit until Thairo Estrada, Mahle's final batter, doubled with two outs in the seventh inning...left the game with a 2-0 lead but was the victim of a blown save when the Giants scored six runs in the eighth inning, all with two outs...the Reds lost, 6-4.
 In the 12-inning, 5-3 win on June 14 at Arizona, Mahle became the first pitcher in the major leagues since 1900 to not earn a win after throwing at least 9.0 scoreless innings on the road with zero walks and at least 12 strikeouts (*Elias*)...became the first Reds pitcher to throw at least 9.0 scoreless innings without earning a win since left-handed pitcher Travis Wood (9 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 8 K) did so in an 11-inning, 1-0 loss on July 10, 2010 at Philadelphia.
 Made the first Opening Day start of his career and earned the 6-3 win on April 7 at Atlanta (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/0 ER, 2 BB, 7 K) at Atlanta.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY (2022 SEASON: 6-5, 5.04 ERA // CAREER: 52-62, 4.75 ERA)
