- ☞ Makes his Twins debut tonight and his 20th start and appearance overall this season (previous 19 with the Cincinnati Reds)...marks his 115th career appearance (114th start).
- ☞ Making the first start of his career against Toronto and his second career start against the American League East after earning the win vs. Baltimore on July 30 (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 0 BB, 7 K).
- ☞ Acquired from the Cincinnati Reds in a trade on August 2, in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajjar.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his last start for Cincinnati, on July 30 vs. Baltimore, his second-straight victory...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts in the Reds' 8-2 win...his 27 pitches in the first inning were his second-highest pitch total in the opening frame this season (trailing the 31 pitches he threw in the first inning on May 3 at Milwaukee)...was the first time he won back-to-back games this season and was the fifth time in his career he has won back-to-back starts (longest winning streak is 5-straight games from May 25 to June 16, 2021).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the 6-3 victory on July 25 vs. St. Louis after allowing three runs on two hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...all three runs came off home runs hit by Paul Goldschmidt (2-run home run in the 4th inning and solo home run in the 6th inning)...threw just seven pitches in the first inning with one strikeout, his fewest number of pitches in any full inning this season...was his second start of the season with two home runs allowed (also May 24 vs. Chicago).

BLUE JAY WATCHER: Will be facing the Blue Jays for the first time in his career and the American League East for the second time, after earning the win in his last start on July 30 at Baltimore...has faced the AL just 20 times (19 starts) in his career, as opposed to his 94 appearances (all starts) against the National League...is a career 6-5, 4.39 ERA (98.1 IP, 48 ER) with 44 walks and 113 strikeouts against AL opponents.

☞ After tonight's start against Toronto, Mahle will have faced 26 MLB teams in his career...he has yet to face Boston, Cincinnati, New York-AL and Tampa Bay.

WELCOME BACK TO TARGET FIELD: Mahle will make his fourth career start at Target Field, going 1-0, 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP, 5 ER) with seven walks and 19 strikeouts in his three prior starts (all with Cincinnati)...earned the win in his first visit to Minneapolis on April 29, 2018 (6.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 7 K) as the Reds won, 8-2.

☞ Has gone 2-5, 4.76 ERA (64.1 IP, 34 ER) with 28 walks and 69 strikeouts in 12 starts at his prior home, Great American Ball Park, this season...this compares to 3-2, 3.83 ERA (40.0 IP, 17 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts on the road.

☞ Has posted a career 3.74 ERA (308.1 IP, 128 ER) in 59 starts away from Great American Ball Park, including 22 quality starts...has held opponents to a .243/.309/.373 slash line away from Cincinnati (284-for-1171 with 28 HR)

WORKING THE NIGHT SHIFT: Scheduled to start his eighth game under the lights this season; has been consistent both at night and during the day...is 3-3, 4.58 ERA (39.1 IP, 20 ER) with 10 walks and 46 strikeouts at night, compared to 2-4, 4.29 ERA (65.0 IP, 31 ER) with 29 walks and 68 strikeouts during the day.

☞ Mahle's most dominant start of the season came at night on June 14 at Arizona...did not factor into the decision after he went 9.0 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the Reds won 5-3 in 12 innings.

LEADING THE WAY: The newest member of the Twins' staff ranks first among the current rotation (Chris Archer, Dylan Bundy, Sonny Gray and Joe Ryan) in games started (19), quality starts (9), innings pitched (104.1), strikeouts (114) and swing and miss percentage (27.9%).

PUTTING IN THE WORK: Mahle has thrown over 100 pitches in 10 of his 19 starts this season, and has gone over 110 pitches on three occasions (June 14 at Arizona - 119, June 21 at Los Angeles-NL - 111 and July 2 vs. Atlanta - 110)...he has also produced 10 starts of at least 6.0 innings pitched and four starts where he has recorded at least one out in the seventh inning-or-later...the rest of the Twins starters this season have a combined six starts with 100-or-more pitches (Joe Ryan - 3 starts, Dylan Bundy - 1 start, Cole Sands - 1 start and Devin Smeltzer - 1 start).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Mahle's pitch selection in his first 19 starts this season with the Reds, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam and split finger fastball.

WITH THE REDS: Went 5-7, 4.40 ERA (104.1 IP, 51 ER) with 39 walks, 114 strikeouts and a .248 (91-for-393) opponent batting average in 19 starts with the Reds this season...had an 18-day stint on the 15-day Injured List from July 6-23 with a right shoulder strain...in his last nine starts, he has a 3-2 record, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER) with seven quality starts, 16 walks and a .212 (44-for-208) opponent batting average.

☞ Produced four-consecutive quality starts from May 29-June 14, the longest such streak of his career.

☞ In his outing on May 29 vs. San Francisco, did not allow a hit until Thairo Estrada, Mahle's final batter, doubled with two outs in the seventh inning...left the game with a 2-0 lead but was the victim of a blown save when the Giants scored six runs in the eighth inning, all with two outs...the Reds lost, 6-4.

☞ In the 12-inning, 5-3 win on June 14 at Arizona, Mahle became the first pitcher in the major leagues since 1900 to not earn a win after throwing at least 9.0 scoreless innings on the road with zero walks and at least 12 strikeouts (*Elias*)...became the first Reds pitcher to throw at least 9.0 scoreless innings without earning a win since left-handed pitcher Travis Wood (9 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 8 K) did so in an 11-inning, 1-0 loss on July 10, 2010 at Philadelphia.

☞ Made the first Opening Day start of his career and earned the 6-3 win on April 7 at Atlanta (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/0 ER, 2 BB, 7 K) at Atlanta.

CAREER NOTES

- Was named the Reds' 2022 Opening Day starter, making his first Opening Day start and his fifth-consecutive Opening Day roster.
- In 2021, established single-season career highs in wins (13), starts (33), quality starts (12), innings pitched (180.0), strikeouts (201) and batters faced (759)...had 13 wins after entering the season with 13 victories in his career...ranked among the National League pitching leaders in starts (T-1st), wins (T-10th), ERA (16th), strikeouts (9th) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (7th, 10.50).
- His strikeouts-per-9 innings ratio of 10.50 in 2021 was third best in Reds franchise history behind Luis Castillo (10.67 in 2019) and Sonny Gray (10.52 in 2019).
- Opponents hit just .198 (34-for-172) against Mahle in 2020...went 2-2, 3.59 ERA (47.2 IP, 19 ER) with six home runs, 21 walks and 60 strikeouts over the course of the season.
- Made the first relief appearance of his major league career, following 54 consecutive starts, on August 12, 2020 vs. Kansas City (3.1 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 K)...was his first professional relief appearance since 2015, when he made 26 starts and one relief outing.
- Went 2-10, 4.93 ERA (102.1 IP, 56 ER) in 19 starts in 2019 before he went on the 10-day Injured List on July 22 with a left hamstring strain...was reinstated from the IL and optioned to Triple-A Louisville on August 22 before being added to the Reds' roster on September 1...went 1-2, 5.93 ERA (27.1 IP, 18 ER) in six starting efforts after his September callup and the Reds won three of his last four starts.
- Entered the 2018 season rated as the fourth-best prospect in the Reds organization by *Baseball America* and went 7-9, 4.95 (109.0 IP, 60 ER) in 22 starts before he was optioned to Louisville on August 3...was recalled from Louisville after the minor league season ended but was hampered by right shoulder fatigue and made just one start following that September 4 promotion...among National League rookie pitching leaders, he ranked ninth in ERA (4.98), tied for second in wins (7), tied for fifth in starts (23), eighth in innings pitched (112.0 IP), sixth in strikeouts (110) and ninth in opponent batting average (.283; 125-for-442).
- Made his major league debut in a start on August 27, 2017 vs. Pittsburgh (L, 5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 4 BB, 5 K).

Right-handed pitcher Dylan Bundy is scheduled to start tomorrow night against the Toronto Blue Jays...took the loss in his last start on July 31 at San Diego after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing three runs on four hits, with no walks and three strikeouts...will be his second start against Toronto this season after taking the loss at Rogers Centre on June 4 (2.1 IP, 8 H, 6 R/5 ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 2 K)...is a career 5-5, 3.76 ERA (76.2 IP, 32 ER) with 20 walks and 79 strikeouts in 17 games (13 starts) against the Blue Jays.

TEAM BULLPEN NOTES

- Has combined to go 2-0-1, 7.84 ERA (20.2 IP, 18 ER) with 10 walks & 17 strikeouts in 4 games vs. TOR this season...they have allowed 19 of the staff's 30 runs allowed to the Jays this season.
- They enter today 1st in the AL with 436 K's & 2nd in MLB in strikeouts, trailing the Cubs (486)...6th in MLB in IP (423.1), T-5th in holds (67) and T-8th in wins (23)...30th in save % (51.2).
