**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-2 through five games on their seven-game homestand, winning two of three against the Tigers this week, followed by a split of the first two games against he Blue Jays over the last two nights...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the third of four against Toronto through tomorrow...following tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will travel to Los Angeles to begin a seven-day, five-game roadtrip with two against the Dodgers from Tuesday-Wednesday and three against the Angels next weekend...the Twins are 30-24 at home and 26-26 on the road.

FRIDAY NIGHT FREE BASEBALL: The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 6-5 in 10 innings, making them 4-5 in extra-innings and 16-15 in one-run games... Tyler Mahle made his Twins debut but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, including three home runs allowed...Jorge López blew his fifth save, snapping his consecutive save streak at seven...the offense recorded 11 hits, including three hits from Nick Gordon and two from Carlos Correa...Gordon hit his 15th double, his fifth home run and drove in three of the six runs...the offense went 3-for-15 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

TWINS AND TORONTO: The Twins are playing the sixth of seven games vs. the Blue Jays this season...they have gone 3-2 vs. Toronto this season, going 2-1 at Toronto from June 3-5 and 1-1 this series at Target Field...Twins batters hit. 270 (48-for-178) with eight doubles, one triple, 11 home runs and 5.8 runs-per-game with an .848 OPS this season.

♣ The Twins have gone just 32-48 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 14-9 in their last 23, dating back to May of 2018.

♣ Twins hitters have homered 40 times against the Jays since the start of 2019, but just 12 of those have come at Target Field.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (28-for-91) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.036 OPS in 24 career games vs. the Jays...he has reached safely in 11 straight against the Jays, dating back to May of 2019.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with four doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI and a .975 OPS in 20 career regular season games vs. the Jays.

I AM THE ONE WHO NICKS: After going 3-for-5 with a double, a home run and three RBI last night, Nick Gordon is hitting .500 (12-for-24) with six doubles, one home run, seven RBI, four walks, four runs scored, a .533 on-base percentage, an .875 slugging percentage and a 1.408 OPS in his last eight games...since the All-Star Break, he has posted a 1.225 OPS, a .447 OBP and a .677 SLG, ranking seventh in the AL in OPS and eighth in both OBP and SLG.

**REV UP THE BUCK TRUCK**: Byron Buxton is hitting .297 (11-for-37) with one double, one triple, three home runs, three RBI, nine runs scored, a .381 on-base percentage, a .622 slugging percentage and a 1.003 OPS in his last 11 games...since homering off Los Angeles-NL's Tony Gonsolin at the All-Star Game, Buck has homered three times in his seven games played out of the break (all solo).

**FOR STARTERS:** In their last seven games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 2-1, 3.31 ERA (35.1 IP, 13 ER) with 12 walks, 43 strikeouts, five home runs allowed and a .192 (24-for-125) opponent batting average...through five games on this homestand, Twins starters have struck out 35 batters in 25.1 innings pitched and held opponents to a .172 batting average (15-for-87).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Minor League Baseball yesterday afternoon announced the Player and Pitcher of the Month Award winners for July in each of the 14 leagues in Major League Baseball's player development system...two Twins farmhands were recognized in their respective leagues:

◆ DSL left-handed pitcher Cesar Lares went 1-0 with a 0.43 ERA in five starts as he allowed just 10 hits and six walks in 21.0 innings while striking out 36...Lares held opponents to a .135 average...Lares, 19. was signed by the Twins as an international free agent out of Maracay, Venezuela, on May 3, 2022.

◆ FCL Twins catcher/outfielder Ricardo Olivar batted .344/.444/.721 and led the league in doubles (8), triples (3), total bases (44), slugging percentage (.721) and OPS (1.165)... he was third in average (.344) and on-base percentage (.444) and was fifth in home runs (three)...Olivar, 20, was signed by Minnesota as an international free agent out of Barquisimeto, Venezuela, on July 2, 2019.

BASEBALL IMMORTALITY: Tonight, the Twins will celebrate franchise legends and 2022 National Baseball Hall of Fame inductees Jim Kaat and Tony Oliva throughout the evening...the Twins were enshrined into Cooperstown on July 24.

THIS AND THAT:

The Twins have recorded double-digit hit totals 43 times this season, third-most in baseball, trailing Colorado (48) and Toronto (48).

Carlos Correa has reached safely in seven-straight games since July 30, posting a .355 on-base percentage in that span.

Since July 1, Jose Miranda is hitting .329 (28-for-85) with two doubles, five home runs, 25 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, a .529 slugging percentage and a .929 OPS in 25 games.

Jake Cave has hit safely in all four games since joining the Twins on Tuesday...he is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with a 1.143 OPS in his last 11 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.

LAST TIME OUT: Bundy took the loss in his last start on July 31 at San Diego, as the Twins fell 3-2... allowed three runs on four hits (1 home run), with no walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings (plus two batters) of work...eased through scoreless first and second innings before yielding a two-out solo homer to Jurickson Profar in the bottom of the third...the Twins tied the game in the fifth and took a one-run lead in the sixth, before Bundy ran into trouble in the bottom of the sixth, allowing singles to Trent Grisham and Profar to start the frame, before departing in favor of Emilio Pagán; both runners later scored on RBI singles by Jake Cronenworth and Luke Voit.

The outing marked Bundy's fifth start this season in which he did not walk a batter and fourth

The outing marked Bundy's fifth start this season in which he did not walk a batter and fourth such start on the road.

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy did not factor into the decision on July 26 at Milwaukee...allowed five runs on seven hits (2 home runs), with two walks and five strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...departed after completing 4.0 innings with the Twins trailing 5-3; Minnesota took a 6-5 lead in the top of the fifth inning on Gio Urshela's three-run homer...however, the Brewers tied the game in the bottom of that frame and won the game on Luis Urías's walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth.

**STAYING IN THE ZONE:** Bundy threw 56 of his 78 pitches for strikes in his last start on July 31, good for a 71.8 strike percentage...marked the 10th time this season (out of 18 starts) that he posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in a single start...owns a 69.20 strike percentage on the season, second best in the majors (min. 80.0 IP), behind Toronto's Kevin Gausman (70.02).

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 19 batters in 89.1 innings, including five starts with no walks allowed...this equates to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.91 walks-per-9.0 IP...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (33.6%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.5%).

This 5.0 walk percentage ranks 10th in the American League (min. 80.0 IP), while his 1.91 walks-per-9.0 IP is 11th under those same parameters.

Additionally, his chase rate ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball this season and his walk percentage ranks in the 90th percentile.

FEELING BLUE: Bundy is facing Toronto for the second time this season, after taking the loss on June 4 at Rogers Centre; tossed 2.1 innings, allowing six runs (5 earned), with one walk and two strikeouts in a 12-3 Twins defeat — marked his shortest start (by innings) since August 24, 2021 at Baltimore (with Los Angeles-AL) and remains his shortest start of the season.

◆ Is a career 5-5, 3.76 ERA (76.2 IP, 32 ER) with 20 walks, 79 strikeouts and a .241 (70-for-290) opponent batting average in 17 games (13 starts) against the Blue Jays...this includes 4-5, 4.00 ERA (72.0 IP, 32 ER) with 17 walks, 75 strikeouts and a .246 (68-for-276) opponent batting average in his 13 starts.

◆ Last defeated Toronto on September 24, 2019, earning the win in Baltimore's 11-4 victory at Rogers Centre...allowed two runs on three hits (1 home run), with two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 innings in the outing...however, is 0-2, 11.37 ERA (6.1 IP, 8 ER) with one walk and four strikeouts in his last two starts vs. the Blue Jays since that win.

**ON TARGET:** Bundy has pitched well at Target Field so far this season, going 3-1, 2.61 ERA (31.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks, 18 strikeouts and a .209 (24-for-115) opponent batting average in his six home starts...however, just one third of his outings this season (6 of 18) have come at home...this compares to his 3-4, 6.33 ERA (58.1 IP, 41 ER), 13 walks, 50 strikeouts and .301 (72-for-239) opponent batting

average he's posted in 12 road starts.

Earned the win in his last start at Target Field on July 16 vs. Chicago-AL, leading the Twins to a 6-3 victory...went 5.1 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and three strikeouts.

**KEEP UP THE TEMPO:** Has an average pitch tempo of 15.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant...is the second-fastest worker on the Twins this season (min. 100 pitches) with the bases empty, trailing Cole Sands (14.0 seconds) and Bailey Ober (15.7 seconds)...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.2 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth fastest on the Twins' current active roster and eighth fastest worker overall for the Twins this season.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 18 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

WELL SUPPORTED: The Twins have scored 71 runs in support of Bundy in his 18 starts this season, including 35 cumulative runs of support across his last eight starts...he has a 7.15 run support average this season, good for second in baseball (min. 80.0 IP), trailing only Atlanta's lan Anderson (7.75 RSA).
