THE TWINS: Have gone 4-2 through six games on their seven-game homestand, winning two of three against the Tigers this week, followed by going 2-1 against the Blue Jays over the last three nights...today, the Twins will conclude the homestand and series with the four-game series finale against Toronto...following today's game, the Twins will travel to Los Angeles...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, play the Dodgers for two games on Tuesday and Wednesday, then another off-day on Thursday, and finish with three games against the Angels next weekend...the Twins are 31-24 at home and 26-26 on the road.

TWINS PITCH THEIR WAY OVER THE JAYS: The Twins beat the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 7-3...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the club used six relievers to complete 5.0 innings of relief...Twins pitchers combined for 11 strikeouts, marking the fifth time in six games having double-digit strikeouts totals on this homestand...the offense recorded 11 hits, highlighted by Luis Arraez, who went 3-for-5, marking his 11th game of three-plus hits this season, third most in the American League.

TWINS AND TORONTO: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the seventh and final time this season...they have gone 4-2 vs. Toronto this season, going 2-1 at Toronto from June 3-5 and 2-1 this series at Target Field...last night's victory secured the season series over Toronto for the fourth-straight season (4-3 in 2017, 4-2 in 2018, 4-3 in 2019 and 3-2 in 2022).
 ☞ The Twins have gone just 33-48 vs. the Jays since 2010, but have gone 15-9 in their last 24, dating back to May of 2018.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .305 (29-for-95) with nine doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBI and a 1.030 OPS in 25 career games vs. the Jays...he has reached safely in 12 straight against the Jays, dating back to May of 2019.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .310 (27-for-87) with four doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI and a .938 OPS in 21 career regular season games vs. the Jays.

I AM THE ONE WHO NICKS: After going 2-for-3 with a walk last night, Nick Gordon has reached base safely in eight of his last 12 plate appearances...in his last nine games, Gordon has hit .519 (14-for-27) with six doubles, one home run, seven RBI, six runs scored, five walks, a .559 on-base percentage, an .852 slugging percentage and a 1.411 OPS...since the All-Star Break, he has posted a 1.153 OPS, a .476 OBP and a .676 SLG, ranking eighth in the AL in OPS, ninth in OBP and 14th in SLG.
 ☞ In his last 52 games, since May 27, he is hitting .306 (45-for-147) with an .872 OPS.

CAVE ENTRANCE: Jake Cave has hit safely in all five games since joining the Twins on Tuesday, hitting .316 (6-for-19) with a .632 slugging percentage and a .982 OPS in that span...he is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with a 1.134 OPS in his last 12 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota.

ARRAEZ RULES: Luis Arraez went 3-for-5 with two doubles and two runs scored last night...he has now scored 59 runs this season, passing his previous season-high of 58, done last season...at 18 doubles, he needs two to tie his career-best of 20, done in 2019...at 117 hits, he needs nine to tie his career-best of 126, set in 2021.

MOUND MATES: In their last eight games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 2-1, 3.43 ERA (39.1 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks, 49 strikeouts, six home runs allowed and a .204 (29-for-142) opponent batting average.
 ☞ Through six games on this homestand, Twins starters have struck out 41 batters in 29.1 innings pitched and held opponents to a .192 (20-for-104) batting average...the staff as a whole on this homestand has recorded double-digit strikeout totals in five of the six games (14, 13, 14, 9, 12 and 11).

OK JOSE: Since July 1, Jose Miranda is hitting .337 (30-for-89) with three doubles, six home runs, 26 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .573 slugging percentage and a .977 OPS in 26 games...among all AL players since that date, he ranks second in RBI, fourth in batting average, sixth in OPS, eighth in on-base and seventh in slugging (.573).
 ☞ Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 200 at-bats this season, he ranks second in batting average (.277) and slugging percentage (.477), third in OPS (.802) and fourth in on-base percentage (.325).

SERIES FINALE: The Twins are 16-12-5 in series play this season, going 9-5-3 at home and 7-7-2 on the road...they began the season going 11-5-4 in series play, but have gone 5-7-1 since...Minnesota is looking to take their second-straight series against the Blue Jays after going 2-1 at Toronto from June 3-5...the last time they won both series over the Jays in one season came in 2014, going 2-1 in both.
 ☞ Twins are looking for their first four-game series victory since taking three of four at Cleveland from September 6-9, 2021.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul infielder/outfielder Michael Helman and Low-A right-handed pitcher Pierson Ohl have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Helman, 26, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .333 (10-for-30) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, seven RBI, seven runs scored, an .867 slugging percentage and a 1.222 OPS, including a five-hit game on Tuesday at Omaha...the Lincoln, Nebraska native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas A&M.
 ☞ Ohl, 22, made one start for the Mighty Mussels on Tuesday vs. Bradenton, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with five hits allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts (ND)...the Moorpark, California native was selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the First-Year Player Draft out of Grand Canyon University.

DID YOU KNOW?: Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins appeared in 20 career games (3 starts) against the Blue Jays, going 0-2, 3.38 ERA (34.2 IP, 13 ER), with one save, three holds, nine walks and 26 strikeouts...Toronto was the only AL opponent in which he did not get multiple saves against...his second career major league start was against the Jays on May 15, 2008 at the Metrodome facing this lineup: 1) Brad Wilkerson, RF 2) Aaron Hill, 2B 3) Alex Rios, CF 4) Scott Rolen, 3B 5) Kevin Mench, LF 6) Shannon Stewart, DH 7) Lyle Overbay, 1B 8) Rod Barajas, C 9) Marco Scutaro, SS...Perk allowed two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched (ND), with two walks and six strikeouts in a Twins 3-2, 11th inning loss.

PEOPLE WILL COME, RAY: Per Major League Baseball, yesterday's games drew a cumulative 596,775 fans, the largest one-day attendance total for MLB since March 28, 2019, traditional Opening Day...yesterday's average crowd was 35,104.

- ☞ Making his 19th start of the season, matching Dylan Bundy for the team lead and his most since making 23 for Pittsburgh in 2019...is his 234th career start and 237th career appearance.
- ☞ Will make his 26th career start and appearance against Toronto, but first since May 6, 2018 (with Tampa Bay)...is 7-4, 3.01 ERA (155.1 IP, 52 ER) in his first 25 starts vs. the Blue Jays.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on March 27...two-time American League All-Star (2015 and '17) previously pitched for Tampa Bay (2012-18) and Pittsburgh (2018-20).

LAST TIME OUT: Turned in his most effective outing since June on Tuesday night vs. Detroit at Target Field, but did not factor in the decision as the Tigers rallied for a 5-3 win (4.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 3 BB, 8 K)...eight strikeouts was a season high and his most since fanning 10 on August 14, 2019 at Los Angeles-AL, with Pittsburgh...blanked the Tigers on one hit through 4.0 innings, took a 2-0 lead into the fifth and struck out the first batter he faced in the frame, before walking the next hitter and allowing an RBI double to Jonathan Schoop before being removed (Schoop later scored)...marked the second time in three starts he took a shutout into the fifth inning and retired at least the first batter in that inning, before then failing to complete the frame (also, July 17 vs. Chicago-AL).

- ☞ Induced a season-high 15 swings-and-misses (his 8th start this season with double-digit whiffs on his pitches).
- ☞ Hit 96.5 mph on his four-seamer and averaged 94.1 mph with the pitch, up from his season average entering the game of 93.1 mph (now 93.2).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his second-consecutive loss as the Twins were defeated, 10-4 by the Milwaukee Brewers on July 27 at American Family Field (3.0 IP, 3 H, 6 R/ER, 6 BB, 2 K)...six earned runs allowed were his most since yielding seven on June 11, 2019 at Atlanta (with Pittsburgh).

- ☞ Rowdy Tellez's three-run home run in the first inning was the first allowed by Archer this season with runners on base (previous multi-run HR off Archer was a two-run shot by Minnesota's Jorge Polanco on September 4, 2021 at Tropicana Field).
- ☞ Became the first Twins pitcher since Lance Lynn in 2018 to have two six-walk games in one season; prior to Archer's first such outing on June 30 at Cleveland, the last Minnesota pitcher to walk six in a contest was Kyle Gibson on August 8, 2019.
- ☞ Now has four six-walk games in his career (also May 15, 2017 at Cleveland with Tampa Bay and May 26, 2019 vs. Los Angeles-NL with Pittsburgh).

CAGING THE JAYS: Archer is set to make his 26th career start and appearance against Toronto, but his first since May 6, 2018...is 7-4, 3.01 ERA (155.1 IP, 52 ER), 47 walks and 167 strikeouts in his first 25 starts vs. the Blue Jays, all with Tampa Bay...Archer's 25 career starts, 155.1 innings pitched, 167 strikeouts and seven wins against the Jays entering today are all his most vs. any opponent in his career (wins are tied with New York-AL and Minnesota)...his 3.01 ERA is his second-lowest against any team (min. 10 starts), trailing only the 2.77 mark (65.0 IP, 20 ER) he has compiled in 11 starts vs. the Twins.

- ☞ Took a no-decision in that May 6, 2018 game at Tropicana Field (7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 6 K).
- ☞ His last win over the Jays came on August 22, 2017 in Tampa (6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 10 K).
- ☞ Has 19 quality starts and five double-digit strikeout games lifetime vs. Toronto.

ARCHER ON TARGET: Is 2-1, 3.32 ERA (19.0 IP, 7 ER) with 10 hits allowed, nine walks and 20 strikeouts in his last four starts at Target Field (W on June 8 vs. New York-AL, W on June 25 vs. Colorado, L on July 17 vs. Chicago-AL and a ND on August 2 vs. Detroit).

- ☞ In nine home starts overall this season, he is 2-3, 4.14 ERA (37.0 IP, 17 ER) with a .217/.304/.341 opponent slash line (30-for-138 with 11 2B and 2 HR)...in nine road starts, is 0-2, 3.96 ERA (36.1 IP, 16 ER) with a .205/.331/.402 opponent line (27-for-132 with 5 2B and 7 HR).
- ☞ In 14 career starts at Target Field (8 with Minnesota, 5 with Tampa Bay and 1 with Pittsburgh), Archer is 6-3, 3.18 ERA (68.0 IP, 24 ER).

HOPING FOR MORE EVEN-MONTH SUCCESS: Archer's 2022 season has rotated between solid and poor months...he is a combined 2-1, 2.31 ERA (46.2 IP, 12 ER) with a .168 opponent batting average (27-for-161) in 11 "even" month starts (April, June and August) this season...by contrast, he is 0-4, 7.09 ERA (26.2 IP, 21 ER) with a .252 batting average against (30-for-119) in seven "odd" month outings (May and July).

BEWARE THE SUN: Archer is set to make his ninth start in a day game this season, having scuffled to an 0-4 mark with a 5.68 ERA (31.2 IP, 20 ER) in his first eight outings...by contrast, he is 2-1, 2.81 ERA (41.2 IP, 13 ER) in 10 starts at night.

SOFT CONTACT: Among American League pitchers with at least 70.0 innings pitched this season, Archer ranks fifth in opponent batting average on balls in play (.239), 10th in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (7.00) and 11th in opponent batting average (.211, 57-for-270) — all of which would be career bests over a full season...he has allowed an average exit velocity of 89.0 mph, which would also stand as a career-best mark over a full season.

WALKS WILL HAUNT: Archer is walking a career-worst 4.91 batters per 9.0 innings (73.1 IP, 40 BB), which is the second-highest mark in the majors this season (min. 70.0 IP).

- ☞ In his last four starts (all Twins losses), he has walked 16 in 16.0 innings — seven of which have come around to score, accounting 53.8 percent of the runs Archer has allowed in the stretch (13 total, for a 7.31 ERA)...he's the first Twins pitcher to issue at least 16 walks in a four-start span since Lance Lynn in 2018 (17 BB from April 9-30).
- ☞ Nine of those 16 walks (56.3 percent) have come with two outs; two have scored.

THE ARSENAL: Archer has relied on four pitches during his inaugural Twins season, per Baseball Savant...below is the website's tracking of his 2022 campaign:

- ☞ His velocity has been up, when compared with his 2021 numbers...averaging 93.2 mph on the fastball and 88.8 mph on the slider this season (92.0 mph and 87.2 mph, respectively, last year).
- ☞ Opponents are a combined 33-for-192 (.172) with 13 doubles, four homers and 51 strikeouts against Archer's slider, changeup and curveball.
- ☞ Has faced just 10 batters a third time through the order (3-for-6, 2 2B, 3 BB, SF)...opponents are hitting .184 (26-for-141) with a .620 OPS the first time through; .228 (28-for-123) with a .722 OPS the second time.
