DANI CALIFORNIA: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 18th and 19th times in their history...they played a two-game series at target Field from April 12-13 and were swept...the Twins are 6-11 all-time, going 1-5 at Dodger Stadium, 2-6 at Target Field and 3-0 atMetrodome...they have lost eight-straight to the Dodgers, dating back to April 30 ,
2014...their current losing streak is the longest active streak for the Twins against one team.
