ROAD TRIPPIN': The Twins completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3, going 2-1 against the Tigers, followed by a four-game split with the Blue Jays...tonight, they begin a week-long roadtrip in California, starting with a two-game series vs. the Dodgers in Los Angeles, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then play three against the Angels in Anaheim over the weekend.

TWINS GIVE IT AWAY TO JAYS: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings, making them 4-6 in extras this season and 16-16 in one run games...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Luis Arráez, who drove in the game-tying run in the bottom of the ninth... Toronto took the lead in the top of the 10th on a sacrifice fly by Cavan Biggio, scoring Whit Merrifield...Merrifield was originally called out on a throw from leftfielder Tim Beckham but called safe upon replay review...it was ruled that catcher Gary Sánchez interfered with the path of the runner...Rocco Baldelli argued the overturn and was ejected for the third time this season.

DANI CALIFORNIA: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 18th and 19th times in their history...they played a two-game series at Target Field from April 12-13 and were swept...the Twins are 6-11 all-time, going 1-5 at Dodger Stadium, 2-6 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome...they have lost eight-straight to the Dodgers, dating back to April 30, 2014...their current losing streak is the longest active streak for the Twins against one team.

STADIUM ARCADIA: The Twins last played at Dodger Stadium from July 24-26, 2017 and were swept in three games...the last and only regular season (or Postseason) win here came on June 11, 2005, a 5-3 victory (Carlos Silva over Derek Lowe)...they have not won here in 6,268 days, their longest drought in any ballpark in their history.

DARK NECE-CC-ITIES: Carlos Correa has hit .315 (23-for-73) with a .934 OPS in 19 career regular and Postseason games against the Dodgers...he played in all seven games for the Astros against the Dodgers in the 2017 World Series, hitting .276 (8-for-29) with two home runs, five RBI and an .817 OPS...he had a three-hit game with a home run in Game 2 at Dodger Stadium.

U-NL-IMITED LOVE: The Twins are 5-10 against the National League this season, going 0-2 vs. the Dodgers, 1-2 vs. the D-Backs, 2-1 vs. the Rockies, 1-3 vs. the Brewers and 1-2 vs. the Padres...after this series, the remaining NL schedule consists of just three games against the Giants at Target Field from August 26-28—the only team that has yet to play at Target Field.
 ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.237 OPS in 10 games against NL opponents this season.

SNOW (J-DE): Joe Ryan enters today leading AL rookies in wins (8), strikeouts (89), innings pitched (90.2) and is tied for first in starts (17)...additionally, he ranks second in opponent batting average (.215) and third ERA (3.67), among pitchers with a minimum of 75.0 IP.

BLOOD SUGAR BUX MAGIK: Byron Buxton started for the AL All-Stars in this ballpark on July 19 for MLB's 92nd Midsummer Classic...he went 1-for-2, striking out against Miami's Sandy Alcantara in the second inning and homered off Los Angeles-NL's Tony Gonsolin in the fourth inning...he's the fourth Twin to homer in the ASG, joining Harmon Killebrew (1961, 1965, 1971), Kirby Puckett (1993) and Brian Dozier (2015), as well as the first to hit a go-ahead homer.
 ☞ Buxton has posted a .970 OPS in his last 13 games, hitting two doubles, one triple and three home runs in that span.

CAN'T STOP: Luis Arráez was a reserve in the All-Star Game here three weeks ago, going 1-for-2, entering the game in the fourth inning at first base...he struck out in his first at-bat against Cincinnati's Luis Castillo but singled to rightfield in his second at-bat against St. Louis' Ryan Helsley.
 ☞ He went 3-for-5 with a double on Sunday, his second straight three-hit game, giving him 12 on the season, tied for third-most in baseball...at 19 doubles, he needs one to tie his career-best of 20, done in 2019...at 120 hits, he needs six to tie his career-best of 126, set in 2021...additionally, he enters today as the AL leader in batting average (.329) and ranks second in on-base percentage (.394).

GO(RDON) ROBOT: In his last 10 games, Nick Gordon has hit .438 (14-for-32) with six doubles, one home run, seven RBI, six runs scored, five walks, a .487 on-base percentage, a .719 slugging percentage and a 1.206 OPS...Nick's brother, Dee Strange-Gordon, played four seasons with the Dodgers from 2011-14, including an All-Star appearance in 2014 at Target Field.

BLACK SUMMER-ANDA: Since July 1, Jose Miranda is hitting .340 (32-for-94) with three doubles, six home runs, 27 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .564 slugging percentage and a .968 OPS in 27 games...among all AL players since that date (minimum 100 PA), he ranks second in RBI, fifth in batting average, sixth in OPS, and seventh in on-base and slugging (.573).

UNDUR(AN) THE BRIDGE: Joao Duran enters today with a 9.2 scoreless inning streak...in his last 31 games, he has posted a 1.25 ERA (36.0 IP, 5 ER) with 42 strikeouts and one home run allowed (Seager)...he ranks fifth among AL relievers with 61 strikeouts, third among rookies (Burke, TEX - 63 and Bautista, BAL - 63)...additionally, he has thrown 269 pitches at 100-plus mph this season, the most in baseball.

OTHERSIDE: The Twins are 17-13 this season when facing a left-handed starter...they have an OPS of .718 vs. lefties this season, compared to a .746 OPS against righties...Byron Buxton has a .646 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching, the fifth-best in baseball and third in the AL...his nine home runs vs. lefties are tied for second-most among AL players.
 ☞ Since the start of 2019, Jorge Polanco leads all MLB switch hitters with 476 hits...151 are from the right side of the plate, also the most.

MY FRIENDS: In their last nine games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 2-1, 3.45 ERA (44.1 IP, 17 ER) with 13 walks, 53 strikeouts, six home runs allowed and a .206 (33-for-160) opponent batting average.
 ☞ Twins starters finished the homestand with 45 strikeouts in 34.1 innings and held opponents to a .197 (24-for-122) batting average.

THE ZEPH-URSH SONG: Third baseman Gio Urshela enters today with two defensive runs saved, leading all AL third basemen and ranking fourth in baseball, trailing Pittsburgh's Ke'Bryan Hayes (16), St. Louis' Nolan Arenado (14) and Colorado's Ryan McMahon (10).

IT'S JUST A MINOR THING AND WE ARE MINOR KINGS: Three Twins minor leaguers were recently named Player/Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Triple-A St. Paul (International League) right-handed pitcher Dereck Rodriguez made one start at Omaha, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...he retired 14-straight batters at one point during the start.
 ☞ High-A Cedar Rapids (Midwest League) right-handed pitcher Ryan Shreve made three appearances (1 start), pitching 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts...he retired 18-of-20 batters faced...his opponent average (.100) and WHIP (0.33) led the Midwest League.
 ☞ Low-A Fort Myers (Florida State League) outfielder Misael Urbina hit .360 (9-for-25) with four doubles, one home run and a 1.069 OPS.

SCAR TISSUE: Right-handed pitchers Bailey Ober (right groin strain) and Josh Winder (right shoulder impingement) are set to begin throwing bullpens at the Twins' complex in Fort Myers, FL today.

BY THE WAY: The Twins High-A affiliate, Cedar Rapids will play Quad Cities tonight in Dyersville, IA at the site of the Field of Dreams movie.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan earned his team-leading eighth win in his last start on August 3 vs. Detroit, allowing one run on three hits, with no walks and nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...recorded his fourth career start with no walks (third this season), while his nine strikeouts matched the second-highest single-start total of his career for the second time (also 9 on April 27 vs. Detroit; career high is 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL)...Twins won, 4-1, in the series rubber match at Target Field.

☞ Ryan tossed 63 of his 78 pitches for strikes, good for an 80.8 strike percentage – the highest single-start mark of his career (previous high was 74.6 percent in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland).

☞ The win marked his 10th career victory in his 22nd career start/appearance, becoming the eighth pitcher in Twins/Senators history to earn at least 10 wins within his first 22 career games, joining Wyatt Lee (11 wins, 22 G/20 GS in 1901), Casey Patten (12 wins, 22 G/20 GS in 1901), Horace Lisenbee (10 wins, 22 G/18 GS in 1927), Monte Weaver (10 wins, 22 G/13 GS from 1931-32), Milo Candini (10 wins, 22 G/17 GS in 1943), Scott Diamond (10 wins, 22 G/6 GS from 2011-12) and Jose Berrios (10 wins, 22 G/6 GS from 2016-17)...also joined Diamond and Berrios as the only pitchers to do so whose first 22 career games were all starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan took the loss on July 29 at San Diego, as the Twins fell 10-1...allowed a career-high 10 runs on a career-high-tying eight hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...paired with his start on July 23 at Detroit, fanned at least seven batters in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career (since extended to three-straight starts).

☞ Ryan's five home runs allowed matched a single-game Twins/Senators record for the fourth time, previously done by Firpo Marberry (Game 1, May 30, 1932 at Philadelphia), Bert Blyleven (September 13, 1986 vs. Texas) and Carlos Silva (August 22, 2006 at Baltimore)...also became the only pitcher in Twins/Senators history to yield at least five home runs and strike out at least seven batters in an outing; is the second pitcher to do so in the majors this season, alongside Cincinnati's Hunter Greene on May 5 at Milwaukee (5 HR, 7 K).

☞ Ryan became the first Twins pitcher to permit at least 10 runs since Rick Reed (11 R/10 ER) on April 21, 2003 vs. New York-AL...also just the fourth to do so since 1992, alongside Reed, Pat Mahomes (10 R/ER on April 24, 1993 vs. DET) and Willie Banks (10 R/ER on August 4, 1992 at Chicago-AL).

INTERLEAGUE INFO: Ryan is slated to face the Dodgers for the first time in his career tonight...also making his third career start and appearance against the teams of the National League West division, after facing Colorado on June 26 at Target Field (W, 5.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 1 K) and San Diego on July 29 at Petco Park (L, 4.2 IP, 8 H, 10 R/ER, 5 HR, 2 BB, 7 K).

☞ Ryan is 2-2, 6.84 ERA (25.0 IP, 19 ER) with seven walks, 27 strikeouts and a .247 (24-for-97) opponent batting average in five career starts against the Senior Circuit...his Interleague numbers are skewed by the 10 earned runs he allowed in 4.2 innings on July 29 at San Diego; excluding that start, he's 2-1, 3.98 ERA (20.1 IP, 9 ER) with five walks, 20 strikeouts and a .213 (16-for-75) opponent batting average in his other four outings.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Due to make his ninth road start of the season tonight and has gone 4-2, 4.57 ERA (41.1 IP, 21 ER) with 10 walks and 41 strikeouts in his eight starts thus far...has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in six of his eight road starts this season; the two exceptions have been his starts on June 14 at Seattle (4.2 IP, 4 ER) and July 29 at San Diego (4.2 IP, 10 ER)...his ERA is skewed by his 10 earned runs allowed on July 29 at San Diego; if that start is excluded, his ERA on the road drops to 2.70 (36.2 IP, 11 ER)...by comparison, is 4-2, 2.92 ERA (49.1 IP, 16 ER) with 15 walks and 48 strikeouts in nine home starts this season.

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the 10th time this season...has a 3-3 record, 4.74 ERA (49.1 IP, 26 ER) with 15 walks and 52 strikeouts in his nine prior night starts, compared to 5-1, 2.40 ERA (41.1 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts in eight day games...is also 2-2, 6.39 ERA (25.1 IP, 18 ER) with seven walks and 26 strikeouts in five road night starts this season.

☞ 10 of the 26 earned runs Ryan has allowed at night came in his start on July 29 at San Diego...excluding that outing, he's 3-2, 3.22 ERA (44.2 IP, 16 ER) with 13 walks and 45 strikeouts combined in his other eight night starts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 58.8% of the time through his first 17 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

☞ Ryan has a .267 wOBA on his four seamer, seventh best in the majors this season (min. 150 PA)...also has a -12 run value on the pitch, fifth among major league pitchers under those same parameters.

☞ Ryan is averaging 16.3 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than league average (18.1 seconds) and sixth among Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches)...averages 20.9 seconds between pitches with runners on, fourth on the Twins (min. 100 pitches), again faster than league average (23.4 seconds).

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 89 batters so far, which will lead to 4,450 new trees planted.
