MORE ON THE STREAK: The Twins' current five-game winning streak is tied with Arizona for the longest active streak in baseball...the Twins are one of six teams in baseball with three different winning streaks of five-plus games (LAD - 6, NYY - 5, HOU - 4, PHI - 5, SF - 5)... below are some numbers from the streak:

₱ Four of the five wins have been in come-from-behind fashion.

₱ Twins batters have hit .276 (45-for-163) with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 26 walks and an .854 OPS...they have hit .341 (14-for-41) with a 1.111 OPS with RISP.

100K GOLD: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold on August 21 and currently has 113 strikeouts on the season...he is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...Ryan currently owns the 10th-most single-season strikeouts by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present), trailing lim Shaw (164 in 1914), Doc Ayers (148 in 1914), Francisco Liriano (144 in 2006). Bert Blyleven (135), Bob Groom (131 in 1909), Jim Hughes (130 in 1975), Roger Erickson (121 in 1978), Mark Redman (117 in 2000) and Joe Mays (117 in 1999).

SOCK 'EM: Ryan is facing the Red Sox for the second time this season/in his career tonight...earned the 8-4 win on April 15 at Fenway Park, allowing one run on five hits, including an Alex Verdugo solo homer in the second inning, with no walks and seven strikeouts...marked his first win of the season after taking the loss in Opening Day (April 8)...is facing the American League ast division for the fourth time this season/in his career, going 1-0, 2.04 ERA (17.2 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 17 strikeouts in his prior three starts against Baltimore (2x) and Boston (1x).
