THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-0 so far on their six-game homestand, sweeping the Giants over the weekend, followed by consecutive wins over the Red Sox...tonight, they will complete the three-game series against Boston...after tonight's series finale, the Twins will travel to Chicago to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, followed by three games against the White Sox on the South Side over the weekend...they will continue the trip with four games next week in New York against the Yankees from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 40-28 at home and 27-33 on the road.

With a win tonight, the Twins will secure an undefeated homestand of six games-or-more for the first time since 2008, when they swept the Nationals from June 17-19 and the Diamondbacks from June 20-22 at the Metrodome.

G CINCO, GRAND SLAM, FIVE STRAIGHT: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 10-5, extending their winning streak to five games and winning their second-straight series...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits and drew six walks...Nick Gordon led the offense, going 2-for-4 with his first career grand slam, a 416-foot shot off Ryan Brasier, giving the Twins a 7-4 lead.

WORTH NOTING: Today marks the final of 20 scheduled home games in August...the Twins have gone 13-6 in 19 home games this month...they enter today tied with Philadelphia (13-5) and St. Louis (13-2) for the most home wins in baseball this month.

I GOT FIVE ON IT: Below are the Twins' longest winning streaks of the season:

MORE ON THE STREAK: The Twins' current five-game winning streak is tied with Arizona for the longest active streak in baseball...the Twins are one of six teams in baseball with three different winning streaks of five-plus games (LAD - 6, NYY - 5, HOU - 4, PHI - 5, SF - 5)...below are some numbers from the streak:

- Four of the five wins have been in come-from-behind fashion.
Twins batters have hit .276 (45-for-163) with 11 doubles, seven home runs, 26 walks and an .854 OPS...they have hit .341 (14-for-41) with a 1.111 OPS with RISP.
Twins pitchers have posted a 2.35 ERA (46.0 IP, 12 ER) with opponents hitting .213 (35-for-164), 16 walks and no home runs...relievers have posted a 1.21 ERA (22.1 IP, 3 ER).
Five-straight homerless games for Twins pitchers is their longest stretch since June 9-15, 2013, when they went seven straight.
Carlos Correa has gone 9-for-19 (.474) with three walks, one double, one home run and five RBI...Jake Cave is 5-for-13 (.385) with one double, two home runs and seven RBI...Max Kepler is 4-for-13 (.308) with five walks...Nick Gordon is 5-for-17 (.294) with one double, one home run and six RBI.

TWINS-SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the seventh and final time in 2022...the Twins are 4-2 against the Red Sox this season...next season, the Twins will visit Fenway Park for a three-game series from April 18-20 and host the Red Sox for four games from June 19-22.

Last night's victory secured a win in the season series over Boston for the first time since going 5-2 in 2015.
Carlos Correa is hitting .321 (53-for-165) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 26 RBI, 36 runs scored, 30 walks, a .425 on-base percentage, a .552 slugging percentage and a .977 OPS in 44 career regular season games against the Red Sox.

CLEAN UP THE SOX: The Twins are seeking their eighth sweep of the season today...their seven sweeps were April 22-24 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), April 26-28 vs. Detroit (3 games), May 6-8 vs. Oakland (3 games), May 20-22 at Kansas City (3 games), July 23-24 at Detroit (2 games), August 15-17 vs. Kansas City (3 games) and August 26-28 vs. San Francisco (3 games)...the Twins recorded just four sweeps in 2021...eight sweeps is their most since 11 in 2019.
Twins' last sweep of the Red Sox came in three games at Target Field from May 25-27, 2015...Glen Perkins saved two games in that series.

G CINCO: Nick Gordon has hit .329 (28-for-85) with 10 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 17 RBI, seven walks, 11 runs scored, a .372 on-base percentage, a .541 slugging percentage and a .914 OPS in his last 24 games...Gordon has 15 RBI this month, second-most on the team, trailing Jose Miranda (17).

CARLITO'S WAY: Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with 12 walks, eight RBI, a .432 on-base percentage and a .916 OPS in his last 17 games...he has reached safely multiple times in 10 of those 17.
He has 17 walks in 27 games this month...his career-high for walks in any month is 19, done in both May and June of last season.

WE TALKIN' ABOUT PRACTICE: The Twins today announced the home schedule for their 2023 Spring Training campaign, the club's 33rd at Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...the Twins' 2023 spring schedule features 33 total games (17 home, 16 road), including a home exhibition on Thursday, March 9 against a to-be-determined opponent from the upcoming World Baseball Classic tournament...the Grapefruit League openers are set for Saturday, February 25; the Twins will play a pair of split-squad games that day, including a home game at Hammond Stadium against the Tampa Bay Rays...the Twins will conclude their Spring Training schedule on Tuesday, March 28 with a road game against the Pittsburgh Pirates in Bradenton, FL, before beginning the 2023 regular season on Thursday, March 30 with an Opening Day contest against the Kansas City Royals at Kauffman Stadium.
