THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (1-2 at Chicago-AL and 1-3 at New York-AL), the Iwins began their penultimate homestand of 2022 season consecutive losses to the Guardians the last two nights...today, they will continue their sixgame, seven-day homestand with the three-game series finale against Cleveland...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Royals for three games from Tuesday-Thursday... the Iwins have gone 40-31 at home and 29-38 on the road.

▼ The Iwins have fell to .500 for the first time since being 8-8 through their game on April 24...last time they were under .500 was 7-8 through April 23.

▼ Iwins are looking to avoid being swept for the sixth time this season, first time since August 23-25 at Houston, first time at Target Field since May 10-12 vs. Houston, and first time by Cleveland since June 16-18, 2017 at Target Field (4 games).

TWINS RUN OUT OF TIME AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night by a score of 6-4... Chris Archer (2-8) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on two hits in 2.0 innings pitched, exiting the game early with right pectoral muscle tightness...the offense recorded 12 hits, three apiece from Luis Arraez and Carlos Correa, and two from Nick Gordon...the Twins scored all four of their runs in the bottom of the ninth inning and stranded runners on the corners, as Max Kepler grounded out to third base to end the game.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Josh Winder and select the contract of right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton from Triple-A St. Paul...Winder, 25, recently made two starts for the Saints, going 0-0, 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER), two walks and five strikeouts. He appeared in 10 games (6 starts) for the Twins earlier this season...Cotton, who will be making his fifth stint with the Twins this season, has gone 1-0, 2.70 ERA (13.1 IP, 4 ER), one save, five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .156 opponent batting average in his last 12 appearances for the Saints...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Chris Archer on the 15-day Injured List with right pectoral tightness and optioned right-handed pitcher Cole Sands to Triple-A St. Paul.

GUARD UP: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 14th of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 5-8 against the Guards this season, going 3-5 at Target Field and 2-3 at Progressive Field...these two will meet again from Friday-Monday for five games at Progressive Field, which included a doubleheader on Saturday.

♣ The Iwins have outscored Cleveland 71-48 this season.

♣ Since the start of 2020, 34 of the 42 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 23 have been decided by two runs-or-less...seven of the 12 games this season have been decided by one run...since the start of last season, eight of the 31 games between these two have gone into extra innings.

♣ Notables this season vs. the Guardians; Carlos Correa is hitting. 459 (17-for-37) with one double, five home runs, 10 RBI, five walks, a. 524 on-base percentage, an. 892 slugging percentage and a 1.416 OPS in 10 games...Gio Urshela is hitting. 353 (18-for-51) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, nine RBI, a. 686 slugging percentage and a 1.052 OPS in 13 games...Nick Gordon is hitting. 333 (11-for-33) with two doubles, two home runs and three RBI in 12 games.

The In his last 15 games, he is hitting .383 (23-for-60) with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, seven walks, a .448 on-base percentage, a .683 slugging percentage and a 1.131 OPS.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic and Low-A Fort Myers infielder Keoni Cavaco as the club's minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week:

Balazovic, who turns 24 on Saturday, made two starts for the Saints, going 0-0, 1.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 1 ER) with four walks and 15 strikeouts...the Mississauga, Ontario native was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Martin Secondary School in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada.

Cavaco, 21, appeared in four games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .357 (5-for-14) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, a .375 on-base percentage, a .929 slugging percentage and a 1.304 OPS...the Chula Vista, California native was selected by the Twins 13th overall in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Eastlake High School in Chula Vista.

ONE DEGREE OF WATKINS SEPARATION: Twins third base coach Tommy Watkins' cousin Sammy Watkins is in Minneapolis this weekend... Sammy plays wide receiver for the Green Bay Packers as they play the Minnesota Vikings at U.S. Bank Stadium at 3:25 pm (CT).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1974**, Harmon Killebrew hit his final home run as a Twin, a walk-off two-run shot in the bottom of the 10th to give the Twins a 5-3 victory over Oakland...in **1999**, Eric Milton threw the fourth no-hitter in Twins history, defeating the Angels 7-0 at the Metrodome...he walked two and struck out 13 batters, the most strikeouts in a no-hitter in Twins/Senators history (passing Walter Johnson's 10 K on July 1, 1920)...in **2013**, *Baseball America* named Byron Buxton its Minor League Player of the Year.

WELCOME BACK TO THE BIG LEAGUES: Was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul today to make the start in this afternoon's series finale...last pitched in the majors on July 12 vs. Milwaukee (L, 5.0 lp, 4 H, 5 R/ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 2 K)...this is his fourth stint with the Twins this season (Opening Day-June 23, June 28, July 5-13).

LAST TIME OUT, IN THE MINORS: Did not factor into the decision in his last start for the Saints, a 4-2 loss to the Omaha Storm Chasers on September 4 at CHS Field...allowed just two base runners — a Maikel Garcia single to lead off the fourth inning and Vinnie Pasquantino reaching on a fielding error with one out in the fourth — and one unearned run, with three strikeouts in 4.0 innings...tossed 38 of his 52 pitches for strikes, good for a 73.1 strike percentage, his second-best mark of the season in the majors or the minors.

This second restriction of the season in the majors or the minors.
 Was reinstated from the 7-day Injured List on August 30 and made two starts for the Saints, going 0-0, 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and five strikeouts combined from August 30-September 4...those two outings are his only non-rehab minor league starts of the season so far.

LAST TIME OUT, IN THE MAJORS: Winder's last major league start and appearance came on July 12 vs. Milwaukee at Target Field...took the 6-3 loss after allowing a career-high five runs on four hits (including a career-high 2 home runs), with two walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work... yielded a two-run homer to Andrew McCutchen in the opening frame before working scoreless second, third and fourth innings...ran into trouble in the fifth, walking the leadoff man before allowing a one-out RBI single to Jonathan Davis and a two-out, two-run homer to Willy Adames.

CLEVELAND ROCKS: Facing Cleveland for the second time in his career, after earning the 6-0 shutout win on June 28 at Progressive Field, in the second game of the doubleheader...allowed just four hits, one walk and one hit batter, with one strikeout in a career-high 6.0 innings of work while serving as the 27th man.

Today marks Winder's fourth career appearance and third start against the American League Central division...is 2-0, 1.80 ERA (15.0 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts in his prior outings, against Cleveland (1x) and Chicago-AL (2x).

IT'S TIME TO START: Winder has gone 4-2, 2.87 ERA (31.1 IP, 10 ER) as a major league starter... per Baseball Reference, his 2.87 ERA is eighth lowest in Minnesota history (since 1961) through a pitcher's first six career starts (min. 30.0 IP)...prior to his last major league start on July 12 vs. Milwaukee, had a 1.71 ERA through his first five career starts, the lowest mark in Twins history (1961-present, min. 25.0 IP).

© On May 1 at Tampa Bay, became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first career start...the others are Mike Fornieles on September 2, 1952 (9.0 IP, 1 H, 6 BB, 4 K), Wally Holborow on August 4, 1945 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K), Claude Thomas on September 18, 1916 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 5 BB, 2 K) and George Dumont on September 14, 1915 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 4 BB, 2 K).

♣ All 44 of his career minor league outings from 2018-21 were starts, going 14-3, 2.82 ERA (236.1 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 240 strikeouts over three seasons...15 of his 44 starts were quality and recorded eight starts of at least 7.0 innings (including two of 8.0 IP)...also fanned seven-or-more batters in 17 starts, including a career-high nine batters thrice.

REVERSE SPLITS: Winder has had markedly better success against left-handed batters (.182, 12-for-66 with 5 XBH, 9 BB and 13 K) than against righties (.286, 30-for-105 with 12 XBH, 5 BB and 16 K) thus far in his young career.

THE ARSENAL: Winder has displayed a four-pitch mix through his first nine career appearances, with his four-seam fastball leading the way at a 40.9-percent use rate...his put-away pitch has been his slider, as 16 of his 29 career strikeouts have come on the pitch...opponents are hitless off his curveball (0-for-14) and are a combined 13-for-84 (155) with 19 strikeouts off his slider and curve...here is a look at the
