THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 last week (1-2)
at Chicago-AL and 1-3 at New York-AL), the Twins began their penultimate homestand of
2022 season by getting swept in three games by Cleveland over the weekendtonight, they
will continue their six-game, seven-day homestand with a three-game series against the
Royals through Thursday nightthe Twins have gone 40-32 at home and 29-38 on the road.
The Twins have fallen under 500 for the first time since they were 7-8 through April 23

 Twins are looking to snap a three-game losing streak and win for the first time since the four-game series finale at Yankee Stadium last Thursday.

SUNDAY NOT-SO-FUN DAY: The Twins lost to the Guardians on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-1, suffering their sixth sweep of the season...Josh Winder (4-4) made his return to the Twins and was the starter, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched and was dealt the loss...the offense recorded five hits, two from Nick Gordon, who hit his 24th double of the season...the Twins only run came on a Gary Sánchez fifth-inning pinch-hit single.

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing the 14th of 19 meetings in 2022, they are 9-4 against Kansas City this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 5-2 at Target Field...the nine wins are their second-most against any opponent this season (Detroit - 10-6).

They have outscored the Royals 66-40 this season...after starting the season 0-2, they have won nine of their last 11 against KC, including four straight entering tonight.

Timins batters have hit .299 (133-for-445) with 19 doubles, three triples, nine home runs, 51 walks and 65 runs scored against the Royals this season...they have recorded double-digit hit totals in seven of their last eight against KC.

Carlos Correa is hitting .337 (29-for-86) with three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 14 walks, a .430 on-base percentage and a .942 OPS in 22 games against the Royals since 2019.

KING LUEY: Luis Arraez is hitting .377 (55-for-146) with six doubles, one triple, 12 RBI, 19 walks, a .450 on-base percentage and an .881 OPS in 40 career games vs. the Royals...this season, he is hitting .420 (21-for-50) with a .482 on-base percentage and a .942 OPS...he enters tonight with a nine-game hitting streak against KC, including multiple hits in six of those.

I'II TAKE TARGET FIELD WINS FOR 500: The Twins enter tonight's game with 497 wins (495 losses) in Target Field's history...they have played 992 games here since the park opened prior to the 2010 season...below are the Twins milestone victories:

◆ Correa has a 43.7 hard hit percentage, the second-highest of his career (44.9% in 2017)...his 11.7 barrel percentage is also the second-best of his career (12.9% in 2019).

◆ Correa needs one run scored to reach 500 for his career...he reached 500 RBI earlier this season and 150 home runs earlier this month...49 active players have reached 500 runs, 500 RBI and 150 home runs.

LEFT SIDE IS OUR BEST SIDE: The Twins have gone 23-18 in games started by left-handers. compared to 46-52 against right-handers...the Iwins have an OPS of .702 against left-handed pitching, compared to .732 against right-handers.

© Carlos Correa is hitting .321 (9-for-28) with five walks and a 1.007 OPS in his last 15 games vs. left-handed pitching.

© Kyle Garlick is slashing .265/.329/.544 with six homers vs. lefties, compared to .219/.260/.370 with three homers vs. righties.

© The Twins recorded 10 hits off Bubic in his start on August 15 at Kauffman Stadium, a career-high...his 49 hits allowed vs. Minnesota are his most against any onnonent.

YOU'RE GONNA NEED A LAWYER: Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson has been named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for September 5-11...the 23-year-old made two starts for the Wind Surge, going 1-0, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP) with three hits, one walk and 13 strikeouts...the Bingham, Maine native has combined to go 6-0, 1.51 ERA (89.2 IP, 15 ER) with 25 walks, 106 strikeouts and a 0.96 WHIP in 34 games (9 starts) between Wichita and High-A Cedar Rapids this season...Twins minor leaguers have been named Player or Pitcher of the Week in their respective leagues 21 times this season, tied for eighth-most in baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan took the 7-1 loss in his last start on September 7 at New York-AL, starting the second game of the doubleheader...allowed four runs on three hits (1 home run), with four walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...marked the first time in his career he recorded losses in back-to-back starts...cruised through 3.0 scoreless innings before running into trouble in the fourth; allowed a grand slam to Isiah Kiner-Falefa, accounting for all four runs...became just the 17th pitcher in Twins history to allow multiple grand slams in a single season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan was saddled with his seventh loss of the season on August 31 vs. Boston at Target Field...allowed five earned runs — matching his second-highest total of the season for the second time — on eight hits (2 home runs), with one walk, one hit batter and eight strikeouts. marked his fourth start this season with at least eight strikeouts (season high is nine, done twice), as well as his sixth with at least 100 pitches thrown...paired with his outing on August 26 vs. San Francisco, threw at least 100 pitches in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career (also, June 21-26); also in conjunction with that August 26 start (8 K), fanned at least eight batters in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.

100K GOLD: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold on August 21 and currently has 124 strikeouts on the season...he is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...Ryan currently has the seventhmost single-season strikeouts by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present), trailing Jim Shao (164 in 1914), Doc Ayers (148 in 1914), Francisco Liriano (144 in 2006), Bert Blyleven (135), Bob Groom (131 in 1909) and Jim Hughes (130 in 1975)...he also has the fourth most in Twins history (1961-present), behind Liriano, Blyleven and Hughes.

SOMETIMES YOU WIN, SOMETIMES YOU LOSE: Ryan earned his 10th win of the season on August 26, becoming the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below)...he enters today tied for first among all major league rookies in wins, with Atlanta's Spencer Strider.

ROYAL TRIUMPHS: Ryan is facing the Royals for the fourth time this season/in his career tonight... has gone 3-0, 1.59 ERA (17.0 IP, 3 ER) with five walks, 17 strikeouts and a .210 (13-for-62) opponent batting average in his three prior starts...last faced Kansas City on August 15 at Target Field, earning the 4-2 win after allowing two runs on six hits (1 home run), with two walks and six strikeouts

innings of work.

Is 7-D, 1.95 ERA (50.2 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 57 strikeouts in nine starts against the American League Central division this season...owns the third-lowest ERA against the division this season, behind Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease (1.22) and Johnny Cueto (1.53). Career 8-0, 2.41 ERA (67.1 IP, 18 ER) with 13 walks, 71 strikeouts and a 1.92 (47-for-245) opponent batting average in 12 starts against the AL Central, including 4-0, 3.23 ERA (39.0 IP, 14 ER) in seven divisional home starts.

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his 14th start at Target Field this season; has gone 6-4, 3.13 ERA (72.0 IP, 25 ER) with 24 walks and 76 strikeouts at home...this compares to 4-4, 5.36 ERA (50.1 IP, 30 ER) with 15 walks and 48 strikeouts in 10 starts on the road...his road numbers are skewed by the 10 earned runs he permitted in 4.2 innings on July 29 at San Diego; prior to that start, had posted a 3.94 ERA on the road.

Has a .193 (51-for-264) opponent batting average at home, fourth best in the American League and 11th best in the majors (min. 65.0 IP at home).

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the 14th time this season...has a 5-5 record. 4.84 ERA (70.2 IP, 38 ER) with 22 walks and 78 strikeouts in his 13 prior night starts, compared to 5-3, 2.96 ERA (51.2 IP, 17 ER) with 17 walks and 46 strikeouts in 10 day games.

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 124 batters so far, which will lead to 6,200 new trees planted.
