they will continue their six-game, seven-day homestand with the second of three against Kansas City...following tomorrow night's series finale, the Twins will travel to Cleveland and begin an eight-game, seven-day roadtrip...they will play five games in Cleveland from Friday-Monday, including a doubleheader on Saturday, then three in Kansas City from September 20-22...the Twins have gone 41-32 at home and 29-38 on the road.

THE RYAN EXPRESS IMPRESSION: The Twins beat the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 6-3...Joe Ryan (11-8) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with two walks allowed and nine strikeouts...Jovani Moran pitched 2.0 relief innings, carrying the combined no-hitter for 8.1 innings, until a Bobby Witt Jr. run-scoring double...the offense recorded 11 hits, three apiece from Luis Arraez and Gio Urshela...Urshela (12), Jose Miranda (15) and Carlos Correa (20) each homered, marking the club's first three-homer game since August 30 vs. Boston...in 11 games since then, they homered just seven times.

© Joe Ryan improved to 4-0 against the Royals this season...according to Elias, Ryan is the first Twins rookie since the franchise relocated to Minnesota in 1961 to earn four-plus wins against a particular team in a season.

© Ryan became the first rookie in Twins/Senators history with a complete outing of at least 7.0 no-hit innings...additionally, the nine strikeouts gave him 133 on the season, the fifth-most single-season strikeouts by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present); trails Jim Shaw (164 in 1914), Doc Ayers (148 in 1914), Francisco Liriano (144 in 2006) and Bert Blyleven (135 in 1970).

ADDITIONALLY: The Twins played two exhibition games vs. St. Louis as a "soft open" in 2010, leading up

to the Inaugural game in Target Field; the results of those games did not count.

RANKING THE ROOKIES: Jose Miranda hit his 15th home run last night, the most for a Twins rookie since Max Kepler had 17 in 2016...Miranda is one of 12 rookies in club history (since 1961) to reach the 15-home run mark, the club record being 33 by Jimmie Hall in 1963 (list lower right)...below are Miranda's ranks in a few offensive categories among all AL rookies with a minimum of 250 at-bats this season:

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing the 15th of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 10-4 against Kansas City this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 6-2 at Target Field... the 10 wins are tied for their second-most against any opponent this season (Detroit - 10-6). 
♣ Last night's win secured the season series for Minnesota for the first time since going 14-5 in 2019 (9-10 in 2021 and 5-5 in 2020). 
♣ They have outscored the Royals 71-43 this season...after starting the season 0-2, they have won 10 of their last 12 against KC, including five straight entering tonight. 
♣ Twins batters have hit .302 (144-for-477) with 21 doubles, three triples, 12 home runs, 54 walks and 71 runs scored against the Royals this season...they have recorded double-digit hit totals in eight of their last nine against KC.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .344 (31-for-90) with four doubles, five home runs, 13 RBI, 14 walks, a .433 on-base percentage and a .988 OPS in 24 games against the Royals since 2019.

♣ Luis Arraez is hitting .387 (58-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, 12 RBI, 19 walks, a .457 on-base percentage and a .903 OPS in 41 carreer games vs. the Royals...this season, he is hitting .444 (24-for-54) with a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.000 OPS...he enters tonight with a 10-game hitting streak against KC, including multiple hits in seven of those.

  Will face Kansas City for the third time this season, after earning wins in his prior two starts on May 29 (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K) and August 16 (6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 10 K)... is a career 6-2, 1.86 ERA (58.0 IP, 12 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts in nine starts against the Royals. Acquired by Minnesota from Cincinnati on March 13, 2022, along with minor league right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in the 4-3 Twins victory over New York-AL on September 8 at Yankee Stadium...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on seven hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...exited with the game tied 2-2, but Carlos Correa put the Twins ahead with a two-run home run in the top of the eighth inning...marked his eighth quality start of the season, second most by a Twins starter this season (trails with Joe Ryan's 9 QS).

© Gray is 1-1, 2.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 7 ER) with eight walks and 29 strikeouts in his last five starts (Twins are 3-2).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision as the Twins fell to the White Sox, 4-3, on September 2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...tossed 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and two strikeouts...grabbed his hamstring in the bottom of the third inning but came back out for the fourth before being removed from the game...allowed just two base runners (two singles) in his first three innings before giving up two runs on three hits and one walk in the fourth...the White Sox earned a walk-off win on José Abreu's walk-off RBI groundout in the bottom of the ninth inning.

ROYAL CONQUEROR: Facing Kansas City for the third time this season, earning the win in his other two starts on May 29 (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 4 K) and August 16 (6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 10 K)...both of his previous starts this season were quality starts and both have come at Target Field... those games also both featured the Gray/Greinke starting pitching matchup...Gray is a career 6-2, 1.86 ERA (58.0 IP, 12 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts in nine starts against Kansas City...those numbers improve to 4-1, 0.90 ERA (30.0 IP, 3 ER) with just four walks and 32 strikeouts in five career starts against the Royals at his home hallpark.

Thas won six-straight starts against the Royals since April 16, 2016, boasting a 1.18 ERA (38.0 IP, 5 ER) with seven walks and 37 strikeouts in that span...ties his second-longest winning streak against a single opponent, trailing his nine-straight wins over Texas (April 28, 2014–June 16, 2019) and matching his six-straight wins against Baltimore (July 20, 2014-August 25, 2018) and Cleveland (May 16, 2014-June 27, 2022).

His 1.86 career ERA against the Royals is his lowest mark against any single opponent that he has faced at least three times.

Has pitched 5.0-or-more innings in each of his nine career starts against the Royals, and has given up two-or-fewer earned runs in seven of the eight.

SHINING POST ALL-STAR BREAK: After yielding 14 runs combined in 13.1 innings in his three starts from July 2-14 (9.45 ERA), has a 2.27 ERA (47.2 IP, 12 ER) in his nine starts after the All-Star Break, since July 24...his ERA after the All-Star Break is ninth lowest in the American League and 14th in the majors (min. 40.0 IP)...Gray is 3-1 in that span, while the Twins are 5-4.

**SONNY SIDE OF SUCCESS:** Gray's strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.18 is his second-highest single-season mark (trails his 3.35 SO/BB in 2013) and his current 2.77 walks-per-9.0 innings is the second-lowest mark in a single season in his career (trails his 2.55 BB/9 mark in 2015)...has allowed just 10 home runs through his first 22 starts (110.2 IP) of the season...is tied for the third-fewest home runs surrendered by an American League starter this year (min. 22 GS), trailing Los Angeles-AL's Patrick Sandoval (7 HR in 23 GS/127.0 IP) and Houston's Framber Valdez (9 HR in 27 GS/179.2 IP)...is tied for seventh-fewest home runs by a pitcher in the major leagues this season under the same parameters.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Will make his first start at Target Field since August 27 vs. San Francisco, after making his previous two starts on the road...has produced a 3-2 record and 2.97 ERA (60.2 IP, 20 ER) in his 12 home efforts this year (Twins are 7-5)...numbers are skewed by a six-run outing on July 14 vs. Chicago-AL (1, 3.2 IP, 9 H, 1 BB, 3 K)...if his July 14 start is excluded, his ERA at Target Field drops to 2.21 (57.0 IP, 14 ER) for the season...in comparison is 4-2, 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER) in 10 starts on the road this year.

- ₱ Is 1-1, 1.23 ERA (22.0 IP, 3 ER) with 11 walks and 25 strikeouts in his last four starts at home, since August 4.
   ₱ Has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in seven of his 10 home starts this season, including four scoreless efforts.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...56 of his 108 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .221 (34-for-154) against the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.
