THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their penultimate homestand of 2022 season by getting swept in three games by Cleveland over the weekend, followed by consecutive wins over the Royals...tonight, they will complete their six-game, seven-day homestand with the three-game series finale against Kansas City...after tonight's game, the Twins will travel to Cleveland and begin an eight-game, seven-day roadtrip...they will play five games in Cleveland from Friday-Monday, including a doubleheader on Saturday, then three in Kansas City from next Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 42-32 at home and 29-38 on the road.
 ☞ After tonight's game, the Twins will have six home games remaining, three against the Angels from September 23-25 and three against the White Sox from September 27-29.

TWINS BLANK THE ROYALS AGAIN: The Twins shut out the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 4-0, their 13th shutout this season (tied for 2nd most in AL) and fourth of Kansas City in 2022...Sonny Gray (8-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Carlos Correa, who doubled for the 20th time this season...Gary Sanchez went 1-for-4 with two of the club's three RBI and hit his 100th career double in the first inning.
 ☞ After Joe Ryan's 7.0 no-hit innings on Tuesday night, the Twins have now had consecutive scoreless starts of at least 7.0 innings each for the first time since May 6-7, 2019 at Toronto (Martin Pérez and José Berrios, both 7.0 IP).

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are seeking their eighth sweep of the season today...their seven sweeps are listed in the right margin below...the Twins recorded just four sweeps in 2021...seven sweeps is their most since sweeping opponents 11 times in 2019.

☞ Since 2014, the Twins have swept the Royals eight times (50 total series)...the only teams they have swept as much in that span are the Tigers and White Sox, also eight times each.
 ☞ They are seeking their third sweep of the Royals this season...they have never swept the Royals more than twice in a season...the last time the Twins swept an opponent at least three times in one season came in 2003, when they swept Detroit four times.

I'LL TAKE TARGET FIELD WINS FOR 500: The Twins enter tonight's game with 499 wins (495 losses) in Target Field's regular season history (since 2010)...below are the Twins milestone victories in this ballpark:

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing the 16th of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 11-4 against Kansas City this season, going 4-2 at Kauffman Stadium and 7-2 at Target Field...their final three games will be next week from Tuesday-Thursday at Kauffman Stadium.
 ☞ The 11 wins are their most against any opponent this season...the last time they had as many wins against KC in one season was 2019, when they went 14-5.
 ☞ Their current six-game winning streak over the Royals is their longest since their seven-game winning streak over KC from September 29, 2016-May 19, 2017.

☞ They have outscored the Royals 75-43 this season...after starting the season 0-2, they have won 11 of their last 13 against KC.
 ☞ Twins batters have hit .300 (152-for-507) with 23 doubles, three triples, 12 home runs and 58 walks against the Royals this season.
 ☞ Twins starting pitchers have gone 8-2, 1.82 ERA (79.0 IP, 16 ER) with 17 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .185 (52-for-281) opponent batting average this season against KC.

C4, DETONATE: Carlos Correa is hitting .336 (38-for-113) with five doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 16 walks, 15 runs scored, a .412 on-base percentage, a .584 slugging percentage and a .996 OPS in his last 30 games.

☞ Correa has reached base safely in 14 of 15 games against Kansas City this season, hitting .317 (19-for-60) with a .388 OBP, a .467 SLG and an .855 OPS.
 ☞ Correa has a 43.2 hard hit percentage, the second-highest of his career (44.9% in 2017)...his 11.8 barrel percentage is also the second-best of his career (12.9% in 2019).

MIRANDA'S THE MAN: Jose Miranda has reached base safely in a career-long 10 straight games, posting a .422 on-base percentage in that span...in 12 games this month, he is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, eight walks, a .442 on-base percentage, a .535 slugging percentage and a .977 OPS.

MINOR KINGS: A quick look at a couple of the Twins minor league affiliates in the playoffs:
 ☞ High-A Cedar Rapids will host South Bend tonight in game two of the three-game series for the Midwest League Western Division title at 6:35 pm (CT)...South Bend won game one by a score of 2-1 on Tuesday night...Travis Adams will get the start for the Kernels.
 ☞ Low-A Fort Myers will play Dunedin in game two of a best-of-three series for the FSL West Division Championship at Hammond Stadium in Fort Myers, FL at 6:00 pm (CT)...Marco Raya will start for the Mighty Mussels...Dunedin won game one on Tuesday night by a score of 6-4.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE DAY: Centerfielder Byron Buxton is the Twins' nominee for the 2022 Roberto Clemente Award, in celebration of both his performances on the field and his dedication to the Twins community off the field...alongside MLB and the other 29 clubs, the Twins will recognize the 21st annual Roberto Clemente Day tonight...the day was established by MLB to honor Clemente's legacy as a humanitarian and to formally acknowledge club nominees of the Roberto Clemente Award...as part of the league-wide celebration, the Roberto Clemente Day logo will appear on the bases and official dugout lineup cards and a special tribute video will be played in ballparks...additionally, a customized tribute video to both Roberto and his wife Vera - Momentito (in English and Spanish) - will be shown in all MLB ballparks today.
 ☞ To honor Clemente, Carlos Correa, Jose Miranda, Emilio Pagán, Jorge López, Jovani Moran and Byron Buxton will all wear uniform number 21.

WAREHOUSE DISTRICT LIVE: In partnership with the Mpls Downtown Improvement District and the City of Minneapolis, the Twins will host free viewing parties in the parking lot between 5th and 6th St. on First Avenue for the club's Friday, September 16 and Saturday, September 17 (Game 2) games vs. the Cleveland Guardians...in addition to large screens showing the Twins-Guardians games at 6:10 pm (CT) each night, additional Warehouse District Live activations include a pop-up t-ball field, food trucks and picnic tables, a beverage tent, street performers and lawn games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, the Twins clinched the AL Central Division title with a 5-0 win over Cleveland at then-Jacobs Field, marking the Twins' first playoff appearance since 1991...they also won the division in the next two seasons...in 2017, the Twins celebrated Big Sexy Night as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colón made the start...Colón allowed four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings as the Twins lost to the Blue Jays by a score of 4-3.

- ☞ Facing Kansas City for the first time since June 7, 2021 (5.2 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 2 K) with Los Angeles-AL...is a career 2-2, 4.08 ERA (46.1 IP, 21 ER) with 14 walks and 43 strikeouts in nine games (8 starts) against the Royals.
- ☞ Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss as Minnesota fell 7-6 against Cleveland on September 9...allowed seven runs on a career-high 12 hits, with no walks and one strikeout in 4.2 innings pitched...the Twins experienced a one hour and 16 minute rain delay before first pitch...gave up a season-high three home runs...snapped a streak of six-straight starts with two-or-fewer earned runs...the seven runs allowed were his second most this season, trailing his nine runs also given up on May 4.

- ☞ Was the fourth time in his career Bundy allowed 10-or-more hits in a start without issuing a walk (also May 29, 2018 vs. Washington, August 15, 2018 vs. New York-NL and August 21, 2018 at Toronto).
- ☞ Was the 11th start of his career with three-or-more home runs allowed, the first since May 31, 2021 at San Francisco as a member of Los Angeles-AL.
- ☞ Was the first Twins pitcher to allow 10-or-more hits, seven-or-more runs and issue no walks in a start since Héctor Santiago on August 20, 2018 at Kansas City (11 H, 8 R/ER, 0 BB).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win on September 4 at Chicago-AL...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with one walk and four strikeouts...improved to 7-0, 3.15 ERA (54.1 IP, 19 ER) in 10 games (9 starts) against the White Sox...Minnesota won 5-1, highlighted by Carlos Correa's two-run home run in the fifth inning and Jose Miranda's two-RBI double in the top of the ninth.

BUMP IN THE ROAD: Despite his struggles in his most recent start, Bundy has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 12 of his last 15 starts, dating back to June 18; is 5-4, 3.97 ERA (77.0 IP, 34 ER) with 15 walks and 48 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 8-7)...has also yielded two-or-fewer earned runs in six of his last seven starts, since August 6; is 2-2, 3.74 ERA (33.2 IP, 14 ER) with six walks and 17 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 4-3)...if his most recent start is removed, his ERA improves to 2.17 (29.0 IP, 7 ER) in that span.

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 25 batters in 123.0 innings, including six starts with no walks allowed and 13 starts with one walk...this equates to a career-low 4.8 walk percentage and a 1.83 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch strike percentage (67.9%).

- ☞ His 4.8 walk percentage is seventh in the American League (min. 100.0 IP), while his 1.83 walks-per-9.0 IP is ninth under those same parameters.
- ☞ Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball this season and his chase rate ranks in the 89th percentile.

AGAINST KANSAS CITY: Is scheduled to face Kansas City for the first time since June 7, 2021 with Los Angeles-AL at Angel Stadium (W, 5.2 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 2 K)...is a career 2-2, 4.08 ERA (46.1 IP, 21 ER) with 14 walks and 43 strikeouts in nine games (8 starts) against the Royals...has recorded six-or-more strikeouts in five of those eight starts, including two performances with eight strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Bundy has gone 4-2, 3.81 ERA (49.2 IP, 21 ER) with nine walks, 30 strikeouts and a .263 (52-for-198) opponent batting average in his 10 home starts this season (Twins are 6-4)...however, his numbers are skewed by his most recent start at home on September 9 vs. Cleveland (7 R/ER)...if you remove his most recent start, he has a 2.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 14 ER) at home...this compares to his 4-5, 5.28 ERA (73.1 IP, 43 ER), 16 walks, 55 strikeouts and a .273 (79-for-289) opponent batting average he's posted in 15 road starts.

- ☞ Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in seven of his 10 home starts this season...the three exceptions are June 9 vs. New York-AL (4 ER), July 16 vs. Chicago-AL (3 ER) and September 9 vs. Cleveland (7 ER)...if you remove those three home starts, Bundy has a 1.77 ERA (35.2 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 25 strikeouts at home this season.

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.3 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth-fastest worker among qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds, Joe Ryan - 21.7 seconds and Tyler Duffey - 22.1 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.3 seconds with runners on base.
