**THE TWINS:** Completed their penultimate homestand of 2022 season with a record of 3-3, going 0-3 vs. Cleveland followed by going 3-0 vs. Kansas City...tonight, the Twins will begin an eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with the first of five at Cleveland...after these next four days, which includes a doubleheader tomorrow, the Twins will travel to Kansas City for three against the Royals from next Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 29-38 on the road...the Twins have gone 2-10 in their last 12 road games and 4-16 in their last 20 away from Target Field.

**TWINS SWEEP ROYALS:** The Twins beat the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2, sweeping Kansas City in three games, their eighth sweep of the season (3rd of the Royals)...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and two strikeouts...the bullpen combined for 5.0 scoreless innings as Jhoan Duran earned his seventh save with a scoreless ninth...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by home runs from Carlos Correa (21) and Nick Gordon (7).

**OBBER TIME:** The Twins announced several roster moves ahead of tonight's game:

☞ Right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober has been returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List...Ober, who was originally placed on the 15-day Injured List on June 6 with a right groin strain, made three rehab starts between Low-A Fort Myers and Triple-A St. Paul, posting a 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER), with three walks and 12 strikeouts...he has made seven starts for the Twins this season, going 1-2, 4.01 ERA (33.2 IP, 15 ER), seven walks, 29 strikeouts and a 1.28 WHIP.

☞ Outfielder Kyle Garlick has been placed on the 10-day Injured List with a left wrist sprain...Garlick exited last night's game against Kansas City early and has hit .233 (35-for-150) with three doubles, nine home runs, 18 RBI, 23 runs scored, eight walks and a .433 slugging percentage in 66 games for the Twins this season.

☞ To replace Garlick on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Mark Contreras from Triple-A St. Paul...Contreras hit .275 (30-for-109) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 18 runs and a 1.801 OPS in 28 games during his most recent stint with the Saints, dating back to August 9...the 27-year-old has gone 3-for-25 with two home runs and four RBI in 12 games over five previous stints with the Twins this season.

☞ To make room for Ober on the 28-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Jharel Cotton for release or assignment.

☞ Additionally, right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak has cleared outright waivers and accepted his assignment to Triple-A.

**TWINS-GUARDS:** The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 15th of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 5-9 against the Guardians this season, going 3-6 at Target Field and 2-3 at Progressive Field...these two met last week at Target Field as the Twins were swept in three games and outscored 17-13.

☞ The Twins have outscored Cleveland 72-62 this season.

☞ Since the start of 2020, 35 of the 43 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less...seven of the 14 games this season have been decided by one run.

☞ Notables this season vs. the Guardians: Carlos Correa is hitting .415 (17-for-41) with one double, five home runs, 10 RBI, five walks, a .478 on-base percentage, an .805 slugging percentage and a 1.283 OPS in 11 games...Gio Urshela is hitting .345 (19-for-55) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, nine RBI, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.012 OPS in 14 games...Nick Gordon is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with three doubles, two home runs and three RBI in 13 games.

**NOW THAT'S PROGRESSIVE:** The Twins are 2-3 in Cleveland this season and 8-5 in their last 13 at Progressive Field...they played a five-game series here from June 27-30, when the Twins won two of the first three then lost the last two on walk-offs, which included a four-run 10th inning for the Guardians in game four and an Andrés Giménez walk-off homer in game five.

☞ The Twins have hit 27 home runs at Cleveland since the start of 2021, their most outside of Target Field in that span...the Twins had a franchise-best 15-game home run streak in Cleveland, up until their last game there on June 30...it marked their longest streak in an opposing ballpark since homering in 21 straight at Kauffman Stadium from July 30, 1998-August 25, 2001.

☞ For his career, Max Kepler has 43 hits, 14 home runs, 30 runs scored and 31 RBI at Progressive Field (47 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark.

**C4, DETONATE:** Carlos Correa hit his 21st home run of the season last night, five short of his career-high of 26, done last season with Houston...he has six home runs this month, one shy of his monthly career best of seven, done in May 2017, June 2017 and June 2021.

☞ In 13 games this month, he is hitting .373 (19-for-51) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, a .429 on-base percentage, an .804 slugging percentage and a 1.232 OPS...among all AL players in September, he ranks third in extra-base hits, tied for third in homers, fourth in slugging percentage, tied for fourth in RBI, fifth in OPS, tied for sixth in hits and eighth in on-base percentage.

**UR ON FIRE:** Gio Urshela is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with one double, one home run, two RBI, three walks, a .515 on-base percentage, a .607 slugging percentage and a 1.122 OPS in his last eight games...he leads the American League in line drive percentage on the season at 29.8% and ranks fourth in all of baseball, trailing Freddie Freeman (31.6%), Kyle Farmer (30.3%) and Alec Bohm (30.0%).

**MINOR KINGS:** A quick look at a couple of the Twins minor league affiliates in the playoffs:

☞ High-A Cedar Rapids evened their best-of-three series for the Midwest League Western Division title last night at one game apiece...the Cardinals rallied to score three runs in the fifth inning and beat South Bend by a score of 5-3...the Cardinals will host the decisive game three tonight with first pitch at 6:35 pm (CT)...a win tonight and they will advance to the MWL Championship series against the winner of Lake County and Great Lakes, beginning Sunday.

☞ Low-A Fort Myers evened their best-of-three series for the FSL West Division Championship last night vs. Dunedin at one game apiece...the Mighty Mussels won 7-5 at Hammond Stadium, highlighted by a Keoni Cavaco eighth-inning grand slam...Jordan Carr will start tonight with first pitch at 7:00 pm (ET)...a win tonight and the Mussels will advance to play St. Lucie in the FSL Championship series on Sunday night.

**BETTER CALL FALL:** Arizona Fall League teams were announced earlier today...select Twins minor leaguers will play for the Glendale Desert Dogs...the players/coaches representing the organization are infielder/outfielder Austin Martin, second baseman Edouard Julien, catcher/first baseman Alex Isola, right-handed reliever Francis Peguero, right-handed starter Jon Olson, right-handed reliever Ryan Shreve, left-handed reliever Denny Bentley and pitching coach Bobby Hearn...the Fall League season will officially begin on Monday, October 3.

**WELCOME BACK TO THE BIG LEAGUES:** Ober was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List today, after missing 89 games with injuries related to a right groin strain; was originally placed on the Injured List on June 6 (retroactive to June 3)...an MRI and subsequent second opinions in late June revealed an aponeurotic plate injury, for which the only cure is rest...this most recent stint on the IL was Ober's second of the season, after missing time from April 30-May 21 with a similar injury.

- ☞ Prior to his reinstatement, Ober made a trio of rehab starts earlier this month, two with Low-A Fort Myers on September 1 and 6, and one with Triple-A St. Paul on September 11...posted a combined 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in those outings.
- ☞ Returned to the mound on September 1 at Bradenton, allowing one run on three hits (1 home run), with no walks and three strikeouts, throwing 42 pitches...ramped up further in his next outing for Fort Myers on September 6 vs. St. Lucie; worked 4.0 shutout innings, with just one hit and one walk allowed, and three strikeouts while throwing 52 pitches...increased both his inning and pitch counts further in his final rehab outing on September 11 for St. Paul at Toledo; allowed one run on a solo homer, with two walks and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work, while throwing 66 pitches.

**LAST TIME OUT IN THE MAJORS:** Ober's last major league outing came on June 1 at Detroit, a 5-0 Twins loss...allowed a career-high-tying five runs on a career-high nine hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...also tossed 86 pitches in the outing, his second most in a single start in his career behind his 93-pitch start on July 5, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision in his second-straight start against the Royals on May 27 as the Twins won, 10-7...tossed 3.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...marked his shortest start of the year (previously 3.2 innings vs. Detroit on April 28 when he exited the game with right groin tightness).

**GUARDING THE DIVISION:** Ober is slated to make his third career start and appearance against Cleveland tonight, going 0-1, 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) with no walks and seven strikeouts in his two prior starts...those outings include one start at Progressive Field on September 6, 2021; did not factor into the decision of a 5-2 Twins win, allowing two runs on six hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...departed after the fourth inning with the Twins ahead 3-2 in favor of Michael Pineda.

- ☞ Is 0-1, 4.37 ERA (22.2 IP, 11 ER) with four walks and 22 strikeouts in five starts against the American League Central division this season...career 2-3, 4.56 ERA (73.0 IP, 37 ER) with 14 walks and 72 strikeouts in 16 starts against the AL Central; 16 of his 27 career starts (59.3%) have come against the division.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Making his fourth road start of the season tonight...has gone 0-2, 3.18 ERA (17.0 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 11 strikeouts in his three prior starts...this compares to 1-0, 4.86 ERA (16.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 18 strikeouts in four home starts this season.

- ☞ Ober is 0-3, 4.32 ERA (25.0 IP, 12 ER) with four walks and 18 strikeouts in his last five road starts, since September 6, 2021 (Twins are 2-3 in those outings)...his lone career road win came in his outing prior to this current stretch, on August 30, 2021 at Detroit, a 3-2 Twins victory and a quality start for Ober (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 5 K).

**TROUBLE SEEING IN THE DARK:** Ober is making his fourth night start this season tonight, going 0-1, 5.79 ERA (14.0 IP, 9 ER) with one walk and 15 strikeouts in his three prior starts (Twins are 2-1)...has performed better in the daytime, going 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and 14 strikeouts in four day starts this season...his last personal win in a night game came on September 24, 2021 vs. Toronto, a 3-1 Twins win and his final start of the 2021 season; allowed one run on four hits (1 home run), with no walks and six strikeouts in the outing.

**ARSENAL:** Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection through seven starts this season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam fastball and slider.

**GOOD RATIOS:** Ober has walked just 26 batters while striking out 125 in 126.0 career innings, good for a 4.81 strikeout-to-walk ratio...since the start of 2021, his 4.81 K/BB ranks 10th in the American League (min. 125.0 IP)...also ranks ninth in the AL in that span and under those same parameters by walking just 1.86 batters-per-9.0 innings.

**LOOKING BACK AT 2021:** Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 3 R/2 ER) and August 30 at Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 ER).
