THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3 (0-3 vs. Cleveland and 3-0 vs. Kansas City), the Twins began their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with three consecutive losses to the Guardians in Cleveland...today, they will play the fourth of five games at Progressive Field...after this series concludes tomorrow afternoon, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play three at Kauffman Stadium from Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 29-41 on the road...the Twins have gone 2-13 in their last 15 road games and 4-19 in their last 23 away from Target Field.

☞ The Twins are now 7.0 games back of Cleveland in the AL Central with 17 left to play...they have eight games remaining against teams over .500 and nine against teams under .500.

12 HOURS OF BASEBALL, TWO BIG L's: The Twins lost both game of the doubleheader yesterday at Progressive Field, dropping game one by a score of 5-1 and game two by a score of 7-6 in 15 innings — the longest game in the majors this season and second-longest in the current extra-innings rule era (LAD at SD, 16 innings — August 25, 2021)...Louie Varland (0-1) was the game one starter, making his second major league appearance, allowing four runs on nine hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits in the first game, highlighted by Matt Wallner's first career home run, a solo shot of Shane Bieber in the eighth inning...Josh Winder made the start in game two, allowing four runs on six hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the offense scored five runs in the top of the eighth inning of the second game, highlighted by a Nick Gordon two-run, game-tying homer, his eighth of the season.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez from Triple-A St. Paul and optioned Derek Rodriguez to Triple-A St. Paul...Henriquez, 22, has appeared in 24 games (14 starts) for the Saints this season, going 3-4, 5.66 ERA (95.1 IP, 60 ER), 33 walks and 106 strikeouts...in his last five appearances, he posted a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), with four walks, 24 strikeouts and a .208 opponent batting average...the Bonaio, Dominican Republic native was acquired by the Twins in a trade with the Rangers during the offseason (Mitch Garver) and ranks as the club's 22nd best prospect in the system by MLB.com.

RYAN KING: Joe Ryan enters today with 133 strikeouts, third on the club's all-time list for a rookie pitcher, trailing Francisco Liriano's 2006 total of 144 and second-place Bert Blyleven's 1970 total of 135...his 11 wins are tied with four others for ninth on the club's all-time list for rookies (since 1961)...the Twins rookie win leaders are to the lower right...below are his AL rookie rankings in a few categories:

TWINS-GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 18th of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 5-12 against the Guards this season, going 3-6 at Target Field and 2-6 at Progressive Field.

☞ 13 of the 17 games this season have been decided by three runs-or-less and nine have been by one run...eight of the Twins' 12 losses to Cleveland in 2022 have been by one run.

☞ The current eight-game losing is their longest since August 12-September 24, 2011 (also 8)...the last time they lost nine-straight to Cleveland was May 9, 1961-August 20, 1982 (9).

☞ Notables this season vs. the Guardians: Carlos Correa is hitting .352 (19-for-54) with one double, five home runs, 10 RBI, six walks, a .426 on-base percentage, a .648 slugging percentage and a 1.074 OPS in 14 games...Gio Urshela is hitting .353 (24-for-68) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 11 RBI, a .618 slugging percentage and a .989 OPS in 17 games, including 394 (13-for-33) with a .944 OPS in his last eight.

☞ Twins starters have gone 4-4, 3.51 ERA (84.2 IP, 33 ER) this season and relievers have gone 1-8, 3.87 ERA (74.1 IP, 32 ER) vs. Cleveland.

NUTHIN' BUT A GIO THANG: Gio Urshela went 4-for-10 with a double and a walk yesterday and is hitting .439 (18-for-41) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, four walks, a .489 on-base percentage, a .561 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS in his last 11 games.

☞ He leads the American League in line drive percentage on the season at 29.5% and ranks fifth in all of baseball, trailing Freddie Freeman (31.8%), Kyle Farmer (29.9%), Starling Marte (29.7%) and Alec Bohm (29.6%).

☞ He is hitting .333 (22-for-66) in close and late situations, tied with Josh Naylor for fifth-best in the AL (minimum 50 at-bats).

C4: Carlos Correa has six home runs this month, one shy of his monthly career best of seven, done in May 2017, June '17 and June '21...in 14 games this month, he is hitting .328 (21-for-64) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, a .394 on-base percentage, a .672 slugging percentage and a 1.066 OPS...among all AL players in September, he ranks tied for third in homers, tied for fourth in extra-base hits (10), tied for fifth in RBI, seventh in slugging percentage and OPS, and tied for seventh in hits.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Double-A Wichita infielder Brooks Lee and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher David Festa as the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Lee, 21, played in four games for the Kernels (including all 3 playoff games), going 4-for-15 with two doubles, two RBI and three walks...he was promoted from High-A Cedar Rapids yesterday afternoon after hitting .289 (28-for-97) with four doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and an .848 OPS in 25 games for the Kernels...the San Luis Obispo, California native was selected eighth overall by the Twins in the July First-Year Player Draft out of California Polytechnic State University.

☞ Festa, 22, made a start for the Kernels in game one of the MWL Division Championship Series on Tuesday against South Bend, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, no walks and 10 strikeouts...the Verona, New Jersey native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University...this marks Festa's third honor this season (also May 15 and June 19).

FORT MYERS GETS OUT-MUSSELED: The Low-A Fort Myers Mighty Mussels lost to Dunedin yesterday in the decisive game three of the FSL West Division Championship Series by a score of 3-1, ending their season.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1975, Harmon Killebrew hit the 573rd and final home run of his career, doing so in a Kansas City Royals uniform off Minnesota's Eddie Bane at Metropolitan Stadium...Killebrew hit 559 homers as a Twin and 14 as a Royal.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan earned his team-leading 11th win of the season in his last start on September 13 vs. Kansas City, as the Twins won 6-3...tossed 7.0 no-hit innings, with two walks and nine strikeouts...Jovani Moran carried the no-hit bid for another 1.1 innings before yielding a one-out, run-scoring double to Bobby Witt Jr. in the top of the ninth...Ryan threw 106 pitches in the start, his third most in an outing in his career (107 on August 9 at Los Angeles-NL and 107 on August 26 vs. San Francisco...also matched his season high with nine strikeouts).

☞ Became the first rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with a complete outing of at least 7.0 no-hit innings.

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan took the 7-1 loss on September 7 at New York-AL, starting the second game of the doubleheader...allowed four runs on three hits (1 home run), with four walks and three strikeouts in 4.0 innings...marked the first time in his career with losses in back-to-back starts...cruised through 3.0 scoreless innings before allowing a grand slam to Isiah Kiner-Falefa in the fourth, accounting for all four runs...became the 17th pitcher in Twins history to allow multiple grand slams in a single season.

100K GOLD: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold on August 21 and currently has 133 strikeouts on the season...he is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015.

☞ Ryan currently has the fifth-most single-season strikeouts by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present), trailing only Jim Hughes (164 in 1914), Doc Ayers (148 in 1914), Francisco Liriano (144 in 2006) and Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (135 in 1970)...he currently ranks third in Twins history, behind Liriano and Blyleven.

SOMETIMES YOU WIN, SOMETIMES YOU LOSE: Ryan earned his 10th win of the season on August 26, becoming the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below)...he enters today leading all major league rookies in wins, with 11.

☞ Rookies with 10-plus wins in a season, Twins history (1961-present): Bert Blyleven (10-9 in 1970), Jim Hughes (16-14 in 1975, the Twins rookie record for wins), Paul Thormodsgard (11-15 in 1977), Roger Erickson (14-13 in 1978), Kevin Tapani (12-8 in 1990), Brad Radke (11-14 in 1995), Mark Redman (12-9 in 2000), Tony Fiore (10-3 in 2002), Jesse Grain (12-5 in 2005), Francisco Liriano (12-3 in 2006), Nick Blackburn (11-11 in 2008), Glen Perkins (12-4 in 2008) and Scott Diamond (12-9 in 2012).

CLEVELAND COMMANDER: Ryan is facing Cleveland for the third time this season, going 1-0, 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and 12 strikeouts in his two prior starts, both of which have occurred at Target Field...last faced the Guardians on June 21, taking a no-decision in an eventual 6-5 Twins loss (QS, 6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 7 K)...career 2-0, 1.88 ERA (24.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks, 21 strikeouts and a .174 (15-for-86) opponent batting average in four career starts/appearances against Cleveland.

☞ Owns one prior start at Progressive Field, on September 8, 2021 — his second career start/appearance...earned the 3-0 shutout win after working 7.0 innings and allowing just one hit, with four strikeouts.

☞ Is 8-0, 1.72 ERA (57.2 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks, 66 strikeouts and a .180 (37-for-205) opponent batting average in 10 starts against the American League Central division this season (Twins are 8-2 in those starts)...owns the lowest opponent batting average against the AL Central this season (min. 40.0 IP) and third-lowest ERA, behind Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease (1.22) and Johnny Cueto (1.53)...is also 3-0, 1.69 ERA (21.1 IP, 4 ER) with six walks, 21 strikeouts and a .208 (16-for-77) opponent batting average in four road starts against the division (Twins are 3-1).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Today marks Ryan's 11th road start of the season and has gone 4-4, 5.36 ERA (50.1 IP, 30 ER) with 15 walks and 48 strikeouts in his 10 prior starts...is also 7-4, 2.85 ERA (79.0 IP, 25 ER) with 26 walks and 85 strikeouts in 14 home starts this season...has lost each of his last three road outings, since July 29 at San Diego; has a 12.51 ERA (13.2 IP, 19 ER) in that span, after posting a 3.60 ERA (20.0 IP, 8 ER) in his four road starts from May 21-July 23, prior to this current stretch.
