THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, dropping the first three games to Cleveland, followed by a win yesterday afternoon...today, they will play the five-game series and season finale against the Guardians at Progressive Field...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play three at Kauffman Stadium through Thursday.

▼ The Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 30-41 on the road...the Twins have gone 3-13 in their last 16 road games and 5-19 in their last 24 away from Target Field.
▼ The Twins are now 6.0 games back of Cleveland in the AL Central with 16 left to play...they have seven games remaining against teams over .500 and nine against teams under .500.

SUNDAY FUNDAY IN CLEVELAND: The Twins shut out the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 3-0, snapping their three-game losing streak...the win also snapped an eight-game losing streak to Cleveland...Joe Ryan (12-8) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.2 shutout innings with three hits allowed, two walks and five strikeouts... Jhoan Duran earned his eighth save in eight chances, pitching a scoreless ninth innings... it marked the 15th shutout for the Twins this season, tied with Houston for fourth-most in baseball (NYM - 18, LAA - 17, STL - 16)...the offense recorded 10 hits, led by Carlos Correa, who went 3-for-5, and Luis Arraez, who went 2-for-5 with two RBI...Jake Cave added a home run, his fifth of the season.

TWINS-GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 19th and final time in 2022...
the Twins have gone 6-12 against the Guards this season, going 3-6 at Target Field and 3-6
at Progressive Field...these two teams will meet next on May 5, 2023 at Progressive Field and
play each other 13 times next season.

◆ 14 of the 18 games this season have been decided by three runs-or-less and nine have
been by one run...eight of the Twins' 12 losses to Cleveland in 2022 have been by one run.

◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .373 (22-for-59) with one double, five home runs, 10 RBI, six
walks, a .439 on-base percentage, a .644 slugging percentage and a 1.083 OPS in 15
games vs. Cleveland this season.

◆ Gio Urshela is hitting .338 (24-for-71) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 11
RBI, a 592 slugging percentage and a .956 OPS in 18 games against the Guards this
season, including .361 (13-for-36) with an .882 OPS in his last nine.

◆ Twins starters have gone 5-4, 3.22 ERA (92.1 IP, 33 ER) this season and relievers have
gone 1-8, 3.81 ERA (75.2 IP, 32 ER) vs. Cleveland.

TWO-HIT LUE: Luis Arraez went 2-for-5 yesterday afternoon, giving him 45 multi-hit games, tied for sixth-most in the American League...below are his ranks in a few offensive categories among AL players:

UR THE MAN: Gio Urshela is hitting .409 (18-for-44) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, five walks, a .471 on-base percentage, a .523 slugging percentage and a .993 OPS in his last 12 games.

 ⊕ He is hitting .571 (4-for-7) with one home run lifetime against Cal Quantrill.

 ⊕ He is hitting .328 (22-for-67) in close and late situations, tied with Josh Naylor for sixth-best in the AL (minimum 50 at-bats)...he is hitting .316 (43-for-136) in one-run games, fifth-best in the AL (minimum 100 at-bats).

CORREA, SO HOT RIGHT NOW: In 14 games this month, Carlos Correa is hitting .348 (24-for-69) with four doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, a .408 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.075 OPS...among all AL players in September, he ranks tied for fourth in homers, tied for fifth in hits and extra-base hits (10), seventh in OPS, and tied for seventh in RBI and slugging percentage.

© Correa has six home runs this month, one shy of his monthly career best of seven, done in May 2017, June '17 and June '21.

ANOTHER BRICK IN THE WALLNER: Matt Wallner went 2-for-3 yesterday and has now gone 3-for-12 with a home run through three games to start his major league career...in his last 42 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota, he is hitting .286 (46-for-161) with 17 doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 31 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .559 slugging percentage and a .963 OPS...in his last 16 games, he is slashing .318/.392/.652 with a 1.043 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in **2019**, the Twins beat the Royals by a score of 8-5 and improved to 94-59 on the season... the 94 wins made Rocco Baldelli the fifth rookie manager in Twins/Senators franchise history to reach that mark...Ron Gardenhire went 94-67 in 2002, Billy Martin went 97-65 in 1969, Bill Rigney went 98-64 in 1970 and Joe Cronin went 99-53 in 1933...in **2020**, the Twins clinched a playoff berth with an 8-1 victory over the Cubs...they went on to win the American League Central on the season's final day, then were swept in two games by Houston in the American League Wild Card Series.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on September 14 as the Twins beat Kansas City, 4-0...tossed 7.0 score-less innings with three hits, one walk and eight strikeouts...his 7.0 innings pitched tied a season high for the third time (also May 24 vs. Detroit and June 27 at Cleveland)...marked his ninth quality start of the season, second most on the Twins behind Joe Ryan (10)...has won seven-straight starts against the Royals, since April 16, 2016; marks his second-longest winning streak against a single opponent (trails his 9-straight wins over Texas from April 28, 2014-June 16, 2019)...has pitched 5.0-or-more innings in each of his 10 career starts against the Royals...has gone 3-0 when facing Zack Greinke this season

Season.

Paired with his start on September 8 at New York-AL, Gray is 1-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP. 1 ER) with two walks and 15 strikeouts in his last two starts (Twins are 2-0)...Gray is 2-1, 1.59 ERA (34.0 IP. 6 ER) with nine walks and 37 strikeouts in his last six starts (Twins are 4-2).

Now has a 2.91 ERA this season, the fourth-lowest ERA by a Twins starter since 1990 (min. 20 starts), joining Johan Santana (2.61 ERA in 2004, 2.77 ERA in 2006 and 2.87 ERA in 2005). Paired with Joe Ryan's 7.0 no-hit innings on September 13, the Twins had consecutive scoreless starts of at least 7.0 innings each for the first time since May 6-7, 2019 at Toronto (Martín Pérez and José Berríos, both 7.0 IP).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the 4-3 Twins victory over New York-AL on September 8 at Yankee Stadium...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs (1 ER) on six hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...exited with the game tied 2-2, but Carlos Correa put the Twins ahead with a two-run home run in the top of the eighth inning.

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Gray is facing the Guardians for the fourth time this season, going 1-0, 2.93 ERA (15.1 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 15 strikeouts in his three prior starts (Twins are 2-1)...last faced Cleveland on June 27 at Progressive Field, leading the Twins to an 11-1 win by tossing 7.0 scoreless innings (3 H, 1 BB, 3 K)...career 6-3, 3.16 ERA (79.2 IP, 28 ER) with 30 walks, 82 strikeouts and a 1.19 WHIP in 14 games/starts against the Guardians; his 82 strikeouts are his fourth most against any opponent in his career, behind his totals vs. Milwaukee (91), Texas (89) and Seattle (85).

4 Has won each of his last three decisions against Cleveland, a six-start span that dates back to May 5, 2018; he is 3-0, 2.84 ERA (31.2 IP, 10 ER) with three quality starts, 11 walks and 36 strikeouts in that span, with his teams going 5-1.

5 With the exception of his last start on June 27, has historically struggled at Progressive Field, going 3-3, 4.25 ERA (36.0 IP, 17 ER) with 12 walks and 30 strikeouts in six career starts in this ballpark...his June 27 victory snapped a streak of three-straight losses in Cleveland, from July 31, 2016-August 3, 2017.

7 Today marks his 11th start of the season against the American League Central division, going 6-1, 2.45 ERA (55.0 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 59 strikeouts in his 10 prior starts...has won each of his last three decisions against the division, spanning his last four starts since July 24 at Detroit; has a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) with the Twins going 3-1.

SHINING POST ALL-STAR BREAK: After yielding 14 runs combined in 13.1 innings in his three starts from July 2-14 (9.45 ERA), has a 1.81 ERA (54.2 IP, 11 ER) in his 10 starts after the All-Star Break, since July 24...his ERA after the All-Star Break is second lowest in the American League, behind only Houston's Justin Verlander (1.31) and fourth in the majors (min. 40.0 IP)...Gray is 4-1 in that span, while the Twins are 6-4.

SONNY SIDE OF SUCCESS: Gray's strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.31 is his second-highest single-season mark (trails his 3.35 SO/BB in 2013) and his current 2.68 walks-per-9.0 innings is the second-lowest mark in a single season in his career (trails his 2.55 BB/9 mark in 2015)...has allowed just 10 home runs through his first 23 starts (117.2 IP) of the season...has allowed the third-fewest home runs among American League starters this year (min. 22 GS), trailing Los Angeles-AL's Patrick Sandoval (8 HR in 24 GS/132.1 IP) and Houston's Framber Valdez (9 HR in 28 GS/185.2 IP)...has the seventh-fewest home runs by a pitcher in the major leagues this season under the same parameters.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making his 11th road start of the season this afternoon and has gone 4-2, 3.06 ERA (50.0 IP, 17 ER) with 10 walks and 38 strikeouts in his previous 10 starts away from Target Field... is 2-0, 2.81 ERA (25.2 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 26 strikeouts in his last five road starts, since July 24 at Detroit (Twins are 3-2 in that span)...is also 3-1, 2.28 ERA (23.2 IP, 6 ER) with three walks, 21 strikeouts and a .195 (17-for-87) opponent batting average in five road day starts this season.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...59 of his 116 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting 213 (34-for-160) against the nitch—here's a look at his repertoire.
