THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 5-1, sweeping the Giants in three games last weekend, followed by going 2-1 against the Red Sox from Monday-Wednesday...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game homestand with the first of three against the White Sox on the South Side through the weekend...they will continue the trip with four games next week in New York against the Yankees from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 27-33 on the road.

The Twins are looking to snap a season-long five-game losing streak on the road and win their first game away from Minnesota since a 4-0 victory at Los Angeles-AL on August 12...the Twins are 1-8 in their last nine road games.

TWINS CAN'T COMPLETE SWEEP ON SOX: The Twins lost to the Red Sox on Wednesday night by a score of 6-5...Joe Ryan (10-7) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing five runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts...Jovani Moran pitched a career-high 3.0 innings on 52 pitches...Nick Gordon led the offense, recording two of the club's nine hits, including one double and two RBI...the Twins scored one run in the seventh inning and two runs in the eighth inning, but left two men on with nobody out in the ninth inning as the comeback just fell short.

SEPTEMBER ADDS: The Twins have activated left-handed pitcher Austin Davis and selected the contract of outfielder Billy Hamilton from Triple-A St. Paul.

Davis, who was claimed off waivers from Boston on Wednesday, appeared in 50 games (3 starts) for the Red Sox this season, going 2-1, 5.47 ERA (54.1 IP, 33 ER), 29 walks, 61 strikeouts, three holds and a .260 (56-for-215) opponent batting average.

Hamilton, who was signed to a minor league contract by Minnesota on August 25, played in two games for the Saints, going 1-for-7 with one double, one walk, one stolen base and two runs scored...the 31-year-old played 20 games for the Miami Marlins earlier this season, going 1-for-13 with one walk, seven stolen bases and nine runs scored.

To make room for Hamilton on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred outfielder Trevor Larnach to the 60-day Injured List...Larnach has missed the Twins' last 58 games after undergoing surgery at the end of June to repair a core muscle injury.

LONG BALLS GUARANTEED: The Twins have hit 311 home runs at Guaranteed Rate Field all-time...below are the club's all-time road homers by ballpark (since 1961):

ADDITIONALLY: The Twins have homered 15 times in 10 games at Guaranteed Rate Field this season, tied with New York-AL for the most by an opponent this season.

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 11th of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 6-4 against the Sox in 2022, going 4-3 at Target Field and 2-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field...these two met for a four-game series at Target Field from July 14-17 as the Twins lost the series three games to one...the last meeting in Chicago was from July 4-6 as the Twins won the three-game series, which included two 10-inning games.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with one double, one triple, seven home runs, 17 RBI and a 1.170 OPS in his last 17 games against the White Sox...Polanco has 20 career home runs against the Sox, his most against any opponent (91 games), including 14 at Guaranteed Rate Field, his most in any opposing ballpark.

Luis Arraez has hit safely in 18 of his last 19 games against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...he had an 18-game hitting streak until an 0-for-4 in his last game on July 17...he is hitting .324 (58-for-179) in 50 career games vs. the White Sox.

The Twins have hit 100 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (58 games), ahead of second place Kansas City's 72...Max Kepler leads baseball in that span with 16.

EASY COME, EASY GO-RDON: Nick Gordon has hit safely in four-straight games, going 7-for-12 (.583) with three doubles, one home run and eight RBI in that span...in his last 29 games, he has hit .337 (30-for-89) with 12 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 19 RBI, seven walks, 12 runs scored, a .378 on-base percentage, a .562 slugging percentage and a .939 OPS.

C4: Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with 13 walks, eight RBI, a .418 on-base percentage and an .817 OPS in his last 18 games...he finished the six-game homestand hitting .391 (9-for-23) with four walks, five RBI and a 1.047 OPS.

THE WALL: Last night, Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner became the first player in Saints history to hit for the cycle, doing so against the Omaha Storm Chasers in an 18-6 victory at CHS Field...the Forest Lake, MN native and the club's number five prospect (per MLB.com) doubled in his first at-bat, singled in his second at-bat, homered in his third at-bat and tripled in his fifth at-bat, finishing the night 5-for-6 with two runs scored and six RBI.

TWINS ON A STICK: The 2022 Minnesota State Fair is taking place in St. Paul through Labor Day...the Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily, rain or shine, throughout the fair's duration...fans can have the opportunity to meet T.C. Bear, play wiffle ball home run derby/batting practice, win giveaway items, shop for their favorite Twins clothing and merchandise, and much more. Hall of Famer Tony Oliva visited the fair yesterday to meet and greet fans.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 3-2 victory on August 27 vs. San Francisco...allowed one run on one hit, with four walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...the Twins scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning on two-out, RBI singles from Carlos Correa and Jake Cave to tie the game, before earning a walk-off win on a Gilberto Celestino bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the 10th.

- ☞ Two of Gray's four strikeouts in the start were looking and now 48 of his 99 strikeouts (48.5%) this season have been on called third strikes.
- ☞ His four walks were tied for second most in a start this season (5 BB on August 4 vs. Toronto and 4 BB on May 13 vs. Cleveland).
- ☞ Picked off Austin Slater in the top of the fifth inning, his second pickoff this season (caught Freddie Freeman at second base on August 10 at Los Angeles-NL).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was dealt the loss after allowing two runs on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched on August 22 vs. Texas...allowed a 453-foot home run to Adolis Garcia in the top of the fifth inning, the second-longest home run he has allowed in the Statcast Era (2015-present)...the Rangers scored the winning run in the top of the sixth inning...the Twins' lone run came on a Nick Gordon RBI double that scored Gio Urshela in the bottom of the fourth...was his seventh quality start of the season, but his first loss in a quality start...marked his longest start since he also went 6.0 innings on July 24 at Detroit.

**AGAINST THE WHITE SOX:** Facing Chicago-AL for the second time this season after taking the 12-2 loss on July 14 at Target Field (3.2 IP, 9 H, 6 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K) and the 10th time in his career (9th start)...is a career 4-2, 4.47 ERA (48.1 IP, 24 ER) with 20 walks and 46 strikeouts against Chicago-AL...has struggled against the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field, going 2-1, 5.47 ERA (24.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 25 strikeouts in five outings (4 starts)...this compares to 2-1, 3.42 ERA (23.2 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks and 21 strikeouts in four starts at his home ballpark.

- ☞ Won four-straight starts against the White Sox from April 6, 2016 to August 7, 2018...tied for his second-longest winning streak against a single opponent in his career (won six straight against Kansas City from April 16, 2016 to August 16, 2022 and four against Seattle from September 29, 2013 to July 13, 2014)...that win on August 7, 2018 in relief (3.0 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 4 K) was also his last victory over the White Sox; is 0-2, 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP, 11 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts in his three starts since then.

**BACK INTO THE GROOVE:** After yielding 14 runs combined in 13.1 innings in his three starts from July 2-14 (9.45 ERA), has a 1.91 ERA (37.2 IP, 8 ER) in his seven starts after the All-Star Break, since July 24...his ERA after the All-Star Break is fourth lowest in the American League (min. 35.0 IP)...Gray is 3-1 in that span, while the Twins are 4-3.

**OTHER NOTABLES:** Gray's strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.09 is his fourth-highest single-season mark and his current 2.86 walks-per-9.0 innings is the fourth-lowest mark in a single season in his career...has allowed just nine home runs through his first 20 starts (100.2 IP) of the season...is tied for the second-fewest home runs surrendered by an American League starter this year (min. 20 GS), trailing Los Angeles-AL's Patrick Sandoval (6 HR in 22 GS/122.0 IP)...is tied for sixth-fewest home runs by a pitcher in the major leagues this season under the same parameters.

**HEADING ON THE ROAD:** Scheduled to make his first road start since August 10 at Los Angeles-NL (4.2 IP, 7 H, 4 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 5 K), after most recently making three-straight starts at home...will be his ninth start on the road season, producing a 4-2 record, 3.15 ERA (40.0 IP, 14 ER) in his previous eight efforts (Twins are 5-3)...numbers are skewed by a five-run outing on July 8 at Texas (L, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 0 K)...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in all his other road starts this season...if his July 8 start is excluded, his ERA on the road drops to 2.29 (35.1 IP, 9 ER)...by comparison is 3-2, 2.97 ERA (30.2 IP, 20 ER) in 12 starts at Target Field this year.

**THE ARSENAL:** Gray has consistently relied on six different pitches throughout his big league career and again in 2022, per Baseball Savant...53 of his 99 strikeouts this season have come on his sinker and opponents are hitting .207 (29-for-140) off the pitch...here's a look at his repertoire.

- ☞ His fastball spin ranks in the 97th percentile among all major league pitchers this season and his curve spin is in the 89th percentile.
- ☞ Gray is averaging 18.1 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, matching the league average (18.1 seconds), but fifth slowest among Twins qualified pitchers...averages 25.4 seconds between pitches with runners on, third slowest on the Twins, and slower than the league average (23.4 seconds).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP TYLER MAHLE [2022 SEASON: 6-7, 4.17 ERA // CAREER: 32-38, 4.31 ERA]**

Right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle is scheduled to be reinstated from the 15-day Injured List and make his fourth start for the Twins tomorrow night at Chicago-AL...will be his first start since August 17 vs. Kansas City, tossing 2.1 scoreless innings with no hits, one walk and one strikeout...was removed from that start in the top of the third inning due to right shoulder fatigue and was later placed on the 15-day Injured List...is 4-2, 2.76 ERA (71.2 IP, 22 ER) with 20 walks and 76 strikeouts in his last 12 starts, including eight quality starts...is 1-0, 2.51 ERA (14.1 IP, 4 ER) with four walks and 12 strikeouts in three starts for the Twins (Minnesota is 3-0)...will face Chicago-AL for the second time in his career, after earning the 7-1 win (5.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 8 K) on September 18, 2020 at Great American Ball Park as a member of the Cincinnati Reds.
