60-day Injured List prior to his last start on September 16, after missing 89 games with injuries related to a right groin strain; was originally placed on the Injured List on June 6 (retroactive to June 3)...an MRI and subsequent second opinions in late June revealed an aponeurotic plate injury, for which the only cure is rest...this most recent stint on the IL was Ober's second of the season, after missing time from April $30-\mathrm{May} 21$ with a similar injury.
