**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-5 through six games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 1-4 at Cleveland, followed by a loss at Kansas City last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals...after tomorrow afternoon's season/series finale, they will travel home to begin their final homestand of 2022, with three against the Angels over the weekend, an off-day on Monday and then three against the White Sox next week.  
 ☞ The Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 30-43 on the road...they are 3-15 in their last 18 road games and 5-21 in their last 26 away from Target Field.

**ROYAL BLUES:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 5-4, suffering their 25th one-run loss (20-25) of the season...the loss snapped a seven-game winning streak over Kansas City and marked their first loss since a 7-3 defeat on May 28 at Target Field...Dylan Bundy was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on four hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Michael Fulmer (5-6) was issued the loss, allowing a run in the seventh inning on a Salvador Perez double...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from both Carlos Correa and Nick Gordon, who doubled twice, giving him 26 on the season.

**TWINS-ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the 18th of 19 meetings in 2022...they are 12-5 against Kansas City this season, going 4-3 at Kauffman Stadium and 8-2 at Target Field.  
 ☞ The 12 wins are their most against any opponent this season...the last time they had as many wins against KC in one season was 2019, when they went 14-5.  
 ☞ They have outscored the Royals 82-50 this season...after starting the season 0-2, they have won 12 of their last 15 against KC.  
 ☞ Twins batters have hit .300 (172-for-573) with 29 doubles, three triples, 14 home runs, 60 walks and an .801 OPS against the Royals this season.  
 ☞ Twins starting pitchers have gone 8-2, 2.26 ERA (87.2 IP, 22 ER) with 18 walks, 78 strikeouts and a .190 (60-for-315) opponent batting average this season against KC.  
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .366 (37-for-101) with five doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI, 16 walks, a .453 on-base percentage and a 1.047 OPS in 27 games against the Royals since 2019...Correa has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games at Kauffman Stadium, hitting .400 (18-for-45) with a 1.039 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .450 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.050 OPS in 10 games vs. KC.  
 ☞ Jake Cave is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with a .931 OPS in his last 10 games at Kauffman.

**NICK AND NIGHT:** Nick Gordon is hitting .309 (50-for-162) with a .358 on-base percentage, a .519 slugging percentage and an .876 OPS in 51 games since the All-Star Break...below is a closer look at his season:

**RANKS AMONG AL PLAYERS AFTER THE BREAK:** 10th in SLG, 11th in AVG, 12th in OPS  
**ADDITIONALLY:** Gordon has homered three times in his last seven games and has a career-high nine on the season...his minor league career high was nine, done in 2017 with Double-A Chattanooga.

**CORREA KEEPIN' ON:** In 19 games this month, Carlos Correa is hitting .377 (29-for-77) with four doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, a .435 on-base percentage, a .662 slugging percentage and a 1.098 OPS...among all AL players in September, he ranks second in hits, fifth in OPS, tied for fifth in homers, tied for sixth in extra-base hits (10) and RBI, and seventh in slugging.  
 ☞ Correa is now hitting .288 (137-for-475) in 124 games on the season, the second-highest mark of his career after he hit .315 in 109 games with Houston in 2017...Correa has raised his batting average 25 points in 37 games since August 12, going from .263 to .288.  
 ☞ Correa is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with a 1.072 OPS in his last 16 games with runners in scoring position...he is 5-for-his-last-10 with RISP.

**UR THE MAN:** Gio Urshela is hitting .373 (19-for-51) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, five walks, a .441 on-base percentage, a .490 slugging percentage and a .931 OPS in his last 14 games.  
 ☞ Urshela leads the American League in line drive percentage on the season at 29.3% and ranks fifth in all of baseball, trailing Freddie Freeman (31.8%), Starling Marte (29.7%), Justin Turner (29.4%) and Kyle Farmer (29.3%).  
 ☞ Gio is starting at leadoff for the first time in his career...he has registered three career plate appearances in the leadoff spot, all as a substitute (1 hit)...he is the seventh different player to lead off a game this season (Arraez - 84, Buxton - 50, Polanco - 6, Garlick - 5, Kepler - 2, Miranda - 1).

**THE LEFTORIUM:** The Twins have gone 25-19 in games started by left-handers, compared to 48-56 against right-handers...the Twins have an OPS of .707 against left-handed pitching, compared to .728 against right-handers.  
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with eight walks, a .455 on-base percentage and a 1.249 OPS in his last 18 games vs. left-handed pitching.  
 ☞ The Twins are facing Daniel Lynch for the sixth time this season...the last lefty to face the Twins six times in one season was Detroit's Matthew Boyd in 2017...Lynch is 1-3 vs. the Twins in 2022...the last lefty starter to lose four times to Minnesota in a season was Chicago-AL's Chris Sale in 2015, when he went 1-4...notables vs. Lynch to the right.

**ANOTHER BRICK IN THE WALLNER:** Matt Wallner went 1-for-4 with his first career double last night and has now gone 5-for-19 through five games to start his major league career...in his last 44 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota, he is hitting .286 (48-for-168) with 18 doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 32 RBI, a .403 on-base percentage, a .554 slugging percentage and a .957 OPS...in his last 18 games, he is slashing .315/.390/.630 with a 1.020 OPS.

**OFFENSIVE SURGE:** Double-A Wichita beat Tulsa last night at Riverfront Stadium by a score of 17-1 in game one of the divisional series...game two will be tomorrow night at 7:05 pm (CT) against the Drillers as Daniel Gossett will start for the Wind Surge.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2010, the Twins defeated Cleveland by a score of 6-4 and clinched their sixth division title in nine years as Ron Gardenhire earned his 800th managerial win...in 1997, Brad Radke pitched 10 innings to beat the Brewers 2-1 and earned his 20th win...he is one of 13 pitchers in club history to win 20 games and the last Twins starter to pitch 10 innings in a game.

- Making his ninth start and appearance of the season...also 29th career start and appearance. Making his third start against Kansas City this season, going 0-0, 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in his two prior starts...is a career 0-0, 4.41 ERA (16.1 IP, 8 ER) with two walks and 19 strikeouts in four starts against the Royals. Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

LAST TIME OUT IN THE MAJORS: Ober did not factor into the decision of a 4-3 Twins loss in Cleveland on September 16, in the first game of a five-game series...dominated in his first major league outing since June 1, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings and allowing just one hit and one walk, with two hit batters and five strikeouts...marked his fourth career start of at least 5.0 scoreless innings, first since August 25, 2021 at Boston (5.0 IP, 4 H), as well as his first time plunking two batters in an outing...departed with a 3-0 lead; the Guardians scored thrice in the seventh to tie the game and once in the eighth to win.

REHAB AND RETURN REDUX: Ober was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List prior to his last start on September 16, after missing 89 games with injuries related to a right groin strain; was originally placed on the Injured List on June 6 (retroactive to June 3)...an MRI and subsequent second opinions in late June revealed an aponeurotic plate injury, for which the only cure is rest...this most recent stint on the IL was Ober's second of the season, after missing time from April 30-May 21 with a similar injury.

- Prior to his reinstatement, Ober made a trio of rehab starts earlier this month, two with Low-A Fort Myers on September 1 and 6, and one with Triple-A St. Paul on September 11...posted a combined 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in those outings. Returned to the mound on September 1 at Bradenton, allowing one run on three hits (1 home run), with no walks and three strikeouts, throwing 42 pitches...ramped up further in his next outing for Fort Myers on September 6 vs. St. Lucie; worked 4.0 shutout innings, with just one hit and one walk allowed, and three strikeouts while throwing 52 pitches...increased both his inning and pitch counts further in his final rehab outing on September 11 for St. Paul at Toledo; allowed one run on a solo homer, with two walks and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work, while throwing 66 pitches.

TWO STARTS AGO, IN THE MAJORS: Took the 5-0 loss on June 1 at Detroit...allowed a career-high-tying five runs on a career-high nine hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of work...also tossed 86 pitches in the outing, his second most in a single start in his career behind his 93-pitch start on July 5, Chicago-AL.

ROYAL RUMBLE: Ober is slated to make his third start and appearance against the Royals this season, posting no record, a 4.50 ERA (8.0 IP, 4 ER), two walks and nine strikeouts in his two prior starts (Twins are 2-0)...last started at Kauffman Stadium on May 22, taking a no-decision in a 7-6 Twins win (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 4 K)...has no decisions, a 4.41 ERA (16.1 IP, 8 ER), two walks and 19 strikeouts in four career starts against Kansas City.

- Is 0-1, 3.58 ERA (27.2 IP, 11 ER) with five walks and 27 strikeouts in six starts against the American League Central division this season...career 2-3, 4.27 ERA (78.0 IP, 37 ER) with 15 walks and 77 strikeouts in 17 starts against the AL Central; 17 of his 28 career starts (60.7%) have come against the division.

ROAD WARRIOR: Making his fifth road start of the season tonight...has gone 0-2, 2.45 ERA (22.0 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and 16 strikeouts in his four prior starts...this compares to 1-0, 4.86 ERA (16.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 18 strikeouts in four home starts this season.

- Ober is 0-3, 3.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER) with five walks and 23 strikeouts in his last six road starts, since September 6, 2021 (Twins are 2-4 in those outings)...has received just 10 total runs of support in those starts, equating to a 3.00 run support average...his lone career road win came in his outing prior to this current stretch, on August 30, 2021 at Detroit, a 3-2 Twins victory and a quality start for Ober (6.0 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 5 K).

TROUBLE SEEING IN THE DARK: Ober is making his fifth night start this season tonight, going 0-1, 4.26 ERA (19.0 IP, 9 ER) with two walks and 20 strikeouts in his four prior starts (Twins are 2-2)...has performed better in the daytime, going 1-1, 2.75 ERA (19.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and 14 strikeouts in four day starts this season...his last personal win in a night game came on September 24, 2021 vs. Toronto, a 3-1 Twins win and his final start of the 2021 season; allowed one run on four hits (1 home run), with no walks and six strikeouts in the outing.

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Ober's pitch selection through eight starts this season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his 4-seam fastball and slider.

GOOD RATIOS: Ober has walked just 27 batters while striking out 130 in 131.0 career innings, good for a 4.81 strikeout-to-walk ratio...since the start of 2021, his 4.81 K/BB ranks ninth in the American League (min. 125.0 IP)...also ranks ninth in the AL in that span and under those same parameters by walking just 1.85 batters-per-9.0 innings.

- Opponents are also hitting just .181 (13-for-72) with one double, five RBI, a .250 on-base percentage and a .444 OPS against Ober with two strikes this season.

LOOKING BACK AT 2021: Made his major league debut on May 18, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL...earned first career win on July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K)...first career quality start on August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R/2 ER, 0 BB, 3 K)...allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 10-straight starts from July 20-September 12, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (50.0 IP, 18 ER), six walks and 50 strikeouts in that span...span included his two quality starts on the season, August 17 vs. Cleveland (6.0 IP, 3 R/2 ER) and August 30 at Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 ER).

- Posted a 5.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the highest single-season mark by a Twins/Senators rookie pitcher (min. 70.0 IP), and tops among all major league rookies last season (also min. 70.0 IP). Struck out a career-high seven batters in third start on June 11 vs. Houston (5.0 IP)...matched career high two more times: July 5 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP) and August 25 at Boston (5.0 IP).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP JOSH WINDER [2022 SEASON: 4-4, 4.17 ERA // CAREER: 4-4, 4.17 ERA]

Rookie right-hander Josh Winder is slated to start the final game of this series tomorrow afternoon against at Kauffman Stadium...did not factor into the decision of a 7-6, 15-inning Twins loss in his last start in the second game of the doubleheader on September 17 at Cleveland, allowing four runs on six hits (1 home run) with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...is due to face Kansas City for the first time in his career; has gone 2-1, 3.42 ERA (23.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 12 strikeouts in five career appearances (4 starts) against the American League Central division.

CAREER NOTES

- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL. Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks, 117 strikeouts and a .252 opponent batting average in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota. In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season. Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
