THE TWINS: Have gone 1-6 through seven games on their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 1-4 at Cleveland, followed by consecutive losses at Kansas City the last two nights... their only win on this trip was a 3-0 victory on Sunday afternoon at Progressive Field... today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium against the Royals... after today's season/series finale, they will travel home to begin their final homestand of 2022, with three against the Angels over the weekend, an off-day on Monday and then three against the White Sox from Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 30-44 on the road... they are 3-16 in their last 19 road games and 5-22 in their last 27 away from Target Field.

☞ Minnesota is looking to avoid falling four games under .500, which would match a low-water mark on the season, previously done when they were 4-8 through games of April 20 at Kansas City.

DO YOU REMEMBER, THE 21st NIGHT OF SEPTEMBER: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 5-2, dropping the series, making them 20-21-6 in series play this season... Bailey Ober (1-3) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts... the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Matt Wallner, who went 3-for-4 with a double (2) and two RBI (4)... Carlos Correa also added a double, extending his on-base streak to 10 games.

CHANGING THE MINDS OF PRETENDERS: Nick Gordon is hitting .301 (50-for-166) with a .350 on-base percentage, a .506 slugging percentage and an .856 OPS in 52 games since the All-Star Break... below is a closer look at his season:

O-UR HEARTS ARE RINGIN': Gio Urshela is hitting .364 (20-for-55) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, five walks, a .429 on-base percentage, a .473 slugging percentage and a .901 OPS in his last 15 games... Gio ranks second on the club in games (131), trailing Luis Arraez (135) and third in hits (124), trailing Arraez (160) and Carlos Correa (138).

HOW THE STARS STOLE THE NIGHT AWAY: Matt Wallner has hit safely in four straight and in five of six games since joining the Twins on Saturday... he has now gone 8-for-23 (.348) with three extra-base hits and four RBI in six games to start his major league career.

☞ His at-bat in the top of the ninth inning last night, which was originally ruled an error on Bobby Witt Jr., was changed to an infield single.

SAY, DO YOU REMEMBER: On this day in 1968, César Tovar played one inning at each position for the Twins, becoming only the second major leaguer in history to do it... Bert Campaneris of the Oakland Athletics was the first, earlier that season... in 2021, at Wrigley Field, Joe Ryan became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to strike out 11 batters in a start of 5.0 innings-or-less.

DANCIN' IN SEPTEMBER: In 20 games this month, Carlos Correa is hitting .375 (30-for-80) with five doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, a .438 on-base percentage, a .663 slugging percentage and a 1.101 OPS... among all AL players in September, he ranks tied for second in hits, fifth in OPS, tied for fifth in extra-base hits (11), tied for sixth in homers, seventh in slugging, and tied for seventh in RBI.

☞ Correa is now hitting .289 (138-for-478) in 125 games on the season, the second-highest mark of his career after he hit .315 in 109 games with Houston in 2017... Correa has raised his batting average 26 points in 38 games since August 12, going from .263 to .289.

☞ Correa is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with a 1.072 OPS in his last 16 games with runners in scoring position... he is 5-for-his-last-10 with RISP.

NEVER WAS A CLOUDY DAY: The Twins are playing their fourth day game in their last seven games... Twins have gone 32-30 in day games this season, tied for fifth-most wins in the AL and tied for seventh-most in baseball.

☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .296 (42-for-142) with seven home runs, 30 RBI and an .866 OPS in 41 day games this season.

ONLY (ROYAL) BLUE TALK: The Twins and Royals are playing the last of 19 meetings in 2022... they are 12-6 against Kansas City this season, going 4-4 at Kauffman Stadium and 8-2 at Target Field... their next meeting will open the 2023 season with three games at Kauffman from March 30-April 2.

☞ The 12 wins are their most against any opponent this season... the last time they had as many wins against KC in one season was 2019, when they went 14-5.

☞ They have outscored the Royals 84-55 this season... after starting the season 0-2, they have won 12 of their last 16 against KC.

☞ Twins batters have hit .294 (178-for-606) with 31 doubles, three triples, 14 home runs, 62 walks and an .785 OPS vs. KC in 2022.

☞ Starting pitchers have gone 8-3, 2.43 ERA (92.2 IP, 25 ER) with 19 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .199 (67-for-337) BAA vs. KC in 2022.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .365 (38-for-104) with six doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI, 17 walks, a .455 on-base percentage and a 1.051 OPS in 28 games against the Royals since 2019... Correa has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games at Kauffman Stadium, hitting .396 (19-for-48) with a 1.048 OPS in that span.

☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .409 on-base percentage, a .538 slugging percentage and a .948 OPS in 11 games vs. KC.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .373 (59-for-158) with seven doubles, one triple, 12 RBI, 19 walks, a .442 on-base percentage and an .872 OPS in 45 career games vs. the Royals.

(EARTH) WIND SURGE (AND FIRE): After a 17-1 victory over Tulsa on Tuesday night, Double-A Wichita will play game two of their Division Series tonight at 7:05 pm (CT) against the Drillers as Daniel Gossett will start for the Wind Surge.

HBD, CCI! Carlos Correa is celebrating his 28th birthday today... he has gone 1-for-17 with a double and a walk on his birthday... Correa shares a birthday with former Vikings running back Chester Taylor, who was Twins Hall of Famer Dan Gladden's fantasy football keeper from 2006-11.

LAST TIME OUT: Winder did not factor into the decision in his last start, a 7-6 Twins loss in the second game of the doubleheader on September 17 at Cleveland...allowed four runs on six hits (1 home run), with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...yielded one run in the first inning on an Oscar Gonzalez two-out double...retired 10-straight batters from the bottom of the first to the bottom of the fourth, before running into trouble in the fifth; recorded the first two outs of the inning before permitting a walk, single, three-run homer to Amed Rosario and single to José Ramirez prior to departing in favor of Jovani Moran.

The Twins lost, 7-6, when Cleveland walked off in the bottom of the 15th inning...marked the first game in the majors to reach 15 innings this season and, at 5:24, is also the longest game by time in the majors this season...was also the Twins' longest game by both time and innings since an 18-inning, 5:42 5-2 loss to Tampa Bay on June 27, 2019.

TWO STARTS AGO: Winder was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul to make the start on September 11 vs. Cleveland at Target Field...took the 4-1 loss after allowing two runs on four hits (2 home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...both runs came on a pair of solo homers, by Andrés Giménez in the second inning and Steven Kwan in the third...paired with his start on July 12 vs. Milwaukee (his last major league outing prior to that start), yielded multiple homers in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.

NEW OPPONENT, WHO DIS?: Facing Kansas City for the first time in his career in this afternoon's start...today is also his sixth career appearance and fifth start against the American League Central division; is 2-1, 3.42 ERA (23.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 12 strikeouts in his prior outings, against Cleveland (3x) and Chicago-AL (2x).

Winder is 4-2, 2.87 ERA (31.1 IP, 10 ER) with nine walks and 23 strikeouts in six career starts when starting against an opponent for the first time.

IT'S TIME TO START: Winder has gone 4-3, 3.60 ERA (40.0 IP, 16 ER) as a major league starter...prior to his start on July 12 vs. Milwaukee, had a 1.71 ERA through his first five career starts, the lowest mark in Twins history (1961-present, min. 25.0 IP)...has gone 0-2, 7.24 ERA (13.2 IP, 11 ER) with four walks and eight strikeouts in his last three starts, since July 12.

On May 1 at Tampa Bay, became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first career start...the others are Mike Fornieles on September 2, 1952 (9.0 IP, 1 H, 6 BB, 4 K), Wally Holborow on August 4, 1945 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K), Claude Thomas on September 18, 1916 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 5 BB, 2 K) and George Dumont on September 14, 1915 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 4 BB, 2 K).

Has 29 strikeouts against 11 walks as a starter, with a 1.18 WHIP and a .240/.299/.427 opponent slash line (36-for-150 with 10 2B, 6 HR and 2 HBP).

Has worked 6.0 innings while allowing zero earned runs in three of his first eight big league starts (May 1 at Tampa Bay, May 6 vs. Oakland and in Game 2 of the June 28 doubleheader at Cleveland)...has also gone at least 5.0 innings in five of his eight starting efforts.

His major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL marked his first career professional relief outing...is 0-1, 5.79 ERA (14.0 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts in four appearances out of the Twins bullpen.

All 44 of his career minor league outings from 2018-21 were starts, going 14-3, 2.82 ERA (236.1 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 240 strikeouts over three seasons...15 of his 44 starts were quality and recorded eight starts of at least 7.0 innings (including two of 8.0 IP)...also fanned seven-or-more batters in 17 starts, including a career-high nine batters thrice.

REVERSE SPLITS REVERSED: Winder has had better success against left-handed batters (.229, 19-for-96 with 8 XBH, 9 BB and 15 K) than against righties (.268, 33-for-123 with 14 XBH, 7 BB and 20 K) thus far in his young career.

In his start on September 11 vs. Cleveland, left-handed batters went 4-for-8 with one double and two home runs against Winder, while righties went 0-for-8 with one walk; was just the second time in his career he held right-handed batters hitless in an outing (also, April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 0-for-2).

THE ARSENAL: Winder has displayed a four-pitch mix through his first 12 career appearances, with his four-seam fastball leading the way at a 40.9-percent use rate...his put-away pitch has been his slider, as 19 of his 35 career strikeouts have come on the pitch...opponents have recorded just one hit off his curveball (1-for-20) and are a combined 17-for-114 (.149) with 23 strikeouts off his slider and curve...here is a look at the rookie's arsenal this season, per Baseball Savant:
