THE TWINS: Completed their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 1-7, going 1-4 at Cleveland, followed by a three-game sweep at the hands of Kansas City...their only win on the trip was a 3-0 victory on Sunday afternoon at Progressive Field...today, Minnesota will begin their final homestand of 2022, with three against the Angels this weekend, followed by an off-day on Monday and then three against the White Sox from Tuesday-Thursday.

TWINS SWEEPED OUT OF KC: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 4-1, suffering their seventh sweep of the season...Josh Winder (4-5) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, his fourth quality start of the season...the offense recorded just two hits, both singles from Luis Arraez and Carlos Correa...Caleb Hamilton reached twice, drawing two walks on the day.

THIS LAND IS VARLAND: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Louie Varland from Triple-A St. Paul...Varland has made two starts for the Twins this season, going 0-1, 5.23 ERA (10.1 IP, 6 ER), three walks and 10 strikeouts...the St. Paul, Minnesota native has gone 8-5, 3.06 ERA (126.1 IP, 43 ER), 42 walks and 146 strikeouts in 24 games (23 starts) between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul this season and was recently named Twins Minor League Player of the Year by *Baseball America*...to make room for Varland on the 28-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Aaron Sanchez for release or assignment.

FEELING MINNESOTA: This season Louie Varland and Matt Wallner became the 31st and 32nd Minnesota natives to play for the Twins...along with Caleb Thielbar, they become the first trio to play on the same Twins roster since 2015 (Mauer, Perkins and Thielbar)...below are the all-time Minnesota natives to play for the Twins:

ALL ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez went 1-for-4 yesterday at Kauffman Stadium, finishing the roadtrip 5-for-27 (.185)...he now trails Aaron Judge (.316) and Xander Bogaerts (.314) in the American League batting race...below are his ranks in a few offensive categories among AL players:

TWINS-ANGELS: Tonight marks the fourth of six scheduled meetings with the Angels this season...these two teams last met for a three-game series at Angel Stadium from August 12-14 as the Twins won the first game and lost the final two.

- ☞ Twins are 21-16 in their last 37 meetings with the Angels, dating back to September of 2015.
- ☞ Since 2018, 17 of 23 games between these two teams have decided by three runs-or-less.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with three walks and an .890 OPS in nine career games vs. the Angels — all in Anaheim...he has multiple hits in four of those.
- ☞ The Twins are facing Shohei Ohtani for the second time tonight, the first coming on May 13, 2018 as the lineup went 3-for-22 with two walks and 11 strikeouts against him (starting lineup in the upper right)...Fernando Romero was the starter opposite Ohtani as the Twins lost 2-1 at Angel Stadium.

TO THE WINDOW TO THE WALLNER: Matt Wallner has hit safely in five of seven games since joining the Twins last Saturday...he has now gone 8-for-25 (.320) with three extra-base hits and four RBI in seven games to start his major league career.

☞ In his last 46 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota, he is hitting .293 (51-for-174) with 19 doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 34 RBI, 29 runs scored, 29 walks, a .409 on-base percentage, a .558 slugging percentage and a .966 OPS...in 20 games between both teams this month, he is slashing .329/.405/.633 with a 1.037 OPS.

HITTING THE TARGET: Twins pitchers have posted a 3.52 ERA (685.0 IP, 268 ER) in 75 home games, compared to a 4.51 ERA (648.0 IP, 325 ER) in 75 road games...the 0.99 difference in ERA between home and road is the second-widest margin in baseball, trailing St. Louis' 1.01 (4.30 ERA on the road, 3.29 ERA at home).

JHO KNOWS: 22 of Jhoan Duran's last 24 outings have been scoreless, posting a 0.68 ERA (26.2 IP, 2 ER) with nine walks, 39 strikeouts and a .189 (18-for-95) opponent batting average in that span...he has thrown 372 pitches at 100-plus mph this season, 72 more than the next closest pitcher, Cincinnati's Hunter Greene, who has thrown 300.

WICHITA SURGING: Double-A Wichita beat Tulsa last night by a score of 11-2, sweeping the Drillers in two games in the Divisional Series to advance to the Texas League Championship Series where they will play the winner of Frisco and San Antonio on Sunday at 5:05 pm (CT)...the Wind Surge outscored the Drillers 28-2 in the two-game series.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2003, the Twins clinched the AL Central for the second-straight season; the 4-1 win over Cleveland marked the 10th win in an 11-game winning streak.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss in his last start in game one of the doubleheader on September 17 at Cleveland as the Twins fell, 5-1...allowed four runs on nine hits (1 home run), with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...marked his most earned runs allowed since also giving up four on May 12 with Double-A Wichita...marked his first career major league loss and decision.

Varland was returned to Triple-A St. Paul following game two but did not appear in a game for the Saints.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in his major league debut in game one of the doubleheader on September 7 at New York-AL, as the Twins fell 5-4 in 12 innings...allowed two runs on three hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched...his first career strikeout was of Aaron Judge; however also gave up his first career home run to Judge in his second time through the batting order...the Twins were leading 3-1 in the sixth inning when Varland allowed a leadoff single and then struck out the next batter before exiting...Griffin Jax allowed the game-tying home run to Gleyber Torres two batters later...the Yankees scored twice in the bottom of the 12th for the walk-off win.

Varland became the fourth pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least seven strikeouts and one-or-fewer walks allowed in his major league debut, joining Hall of Famer Bert Blyleven (7 K, 1 BB on June 5, 1970), Johan Pino (7 K, 1 BB on June 19, 2014) and Devin Smeltzer (7 K, 0 BB on May 28, 2019).

Became the third player in Twins history (1961-present) to make his major league debut as the starting pitcher in the first game of a doubleheader, joining Charlie Barnes (July 17, 2021 at Detroit; L, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 HR, 1 K) and Bert Cueto (June 18, 1961 at Chicago-AL; ND, 8.1 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 3 K).

2022 MINORS RECAP: Varland was recently named Twins 2022 Minor League Player of the Year by *Baseball America*...posted an 8-5 record, 3.06 ERA (126.1 IP, 43 ER) with 42 walks and 146 strikeouts in 24 games (23 starts) between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul this season...the Wind Surge were 14-6 in games which Varland pitched and the Saints were 2-2.

Currently leads all Twins minor league pitchers in innings pitched and strikeouts, and is tied for first in games started (with Brent Headrick).

Varland became the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became the Twins' Triple-A affiliate in 2020.

BREAKING OUT IN 2021: Varland was named the 2021 Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year, after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERA (103.0 IP, 24 ER), 30 walks, 142 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids.

Led all Twins minor league pitchers in ERA, strikeouts and WHIP.

Was named the starting pitcher on the Twins' MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.

MINNESOTA MADE: Varland was born and raised in St. Paul, Minnesota and attended North St. Paul High School, where he was an All-Metro East Conference performer and letterwinner in three sports (baseball, wrestling and football)...continued his academic and athletic career at Division II Concordia University in St. Paul, Minnesota where his 1.41 ERA as a sophomore in 2018 was second best in school history and fourth best in the nation by a DII pitcher...was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft...will make his Target Field debut with tonight's start.

With his MLB debut on September 7, became the eighth Minnesota-born player to make a start for the Twins...is one of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins (1961-present).

Varland, Caleb Thielbar (Northfield, MN) and Matt Wallner (Forest Lake, MN) are the first three Minnesota-born Twins teammates since Joe Mauer (St. Paul, MN), Glen Perkins (St. Paul, MN) and Thielbar in 2015.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland used a four-pitch mix in his first two starts, including a four-seam fastball, slider, cutter and changeup according to Baseball Savant...below is a look at his repertoire.
