THE TWINS: After completing their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 1-7 (1-4 at Cleveland and 0-3 at Kansas City), the Twins began their final homestand of the season with a loss to the Angels last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three against the Angels at Target Field...they will finish the season series tomorrow afternoon, enjoy an off-day on Monday and then play three games against the White Sox from Tuesday-Thursday.

FRIDAY NIGHT SHO TIME LIGHTS: The Twins lost to the Angels last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2, dropping their fifth-straight game and slipping a season-low five games under .500...Louie Varland made his third major league start opposite Shohei Ohtani, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched with six walks and seven strikeouts...Emilio Pagan pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief with no hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, including two from Jake Cave, who singled twice and drove in a run.

KINGS OF THEIR HILL: Twins pitchers have posted a 3.53 ERA (694.0 IP, 272 ER) in 76 home games, compared to a 4.51 ERA (648.0 IP, 325 ER) in 75 road games...the 0.98 difference in ERA between home and road is the widest margin in baseball...below are the Twins' home and road hitting and pitching comparisons:

RYAN KING: Joe Ryan enters today with 138 strikeouts, second on the club's all-time list for a rookie pitcher, trailing Francisco Liriano's 2006 total of 144...his 12 wins are tied with six others for third on the club's all-time list for rookies (since 1961)...the Twins rookie wins and strikeouts leaders are to the lower right...below are his AL rookie rankings in a few categories:

TWINS-ANGELS: Tonight marks the fifth of six scheduled meetings with the Angels this season...with wins tonight and tomorrow, the Twins can avoid losing the season series for the second-consecutive season (2-5 in 2021).

☞ Twins are 21-17 in their last 38 meetings with the Angels, dating back to September of 2015.
☞ Since 2018, 18 of 24 games between these two teams have decided by three runs-or-less.
☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with three walks and an .828 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Angels.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (100-for-332) with 22 doubles, 17 home runs, 67 RBI, a .375 on-base percentage, a .521 slugging percentage and an .896 OPS in 89 career games against the Angels...the 67 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 20)...additionally, his 67 RBI are tied for sixth most among actives.

ALL ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez went 1-for-5 last night and is now hitting .312, trailing Aaron Judge (.315) and Xander Bogaerts (.314) in the American League batting race...below are his ranks in a few offensive categories among AL players:

ON THE COUNT OF THREE, GO-RDON: Nick Gordon is hitting .297 (51-for-172) with a .346 on-base percentage, a .494 slugging percentage and an .840 OPS in 54 games since the All-Star Break...below is a closer look at his season:

ADDITIONALLY: Gordon has homered three times in his last nine games and has a career-high nine on the season...his minor league career high was nine, done in 2017 with Double-A Chattanooga.

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins have gone 25-20 in games started by left-handers, compared to 48-58 against right-handers...the Twins have an OPS of .703 against left-handed pitching, compared to .723 against right-handers.

☞ Twins have not hit a homer off a left-handed pitcher since September 15 vs. Kansas City, when Correa (1st inning) and Nick Gordon (2nd inning) each took Daniel Lynch deep...the Twins last faced Reid Detmers on August 13 at Los Angeles-AL (numbers to the right).

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .292 (35-for-120) with a .942 OPS vs. lefties this season...he is hitting .361 (13-for-36) with eight walks, a .457 on-base percentage and a 1.262 OPS in his last 19 games vs. left-handed pitching.

C4, IGNITING: In 21 games this month, Carlos Correa is hitting .369 (31-for-84) with five doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, a .430 on-base percentage, a .643 slugging percentage and a 1.073 OPS...among all AL players in September, he ranks tied for second in hits, fifth in OPS, tied for sixth in extra-base hits (11) and homers, seventh in slugging, and tied for 10th in RBI.

☞ Correa is now hitting .288 (139-for-482) in 126 games on the season, the second-highest mark of his career after he hit .315 in 109 games with Houston in 2017...Correa has raised his batting average 25 points in 39 games since August 12, going from .263 to .288.

☞ Correa is hitting .429 (9-for-21) with a 1.024 OPS in his last 17 games with runners in scoring position...he is 5-for-his-last-11 with RISP.

I'M GOING TO WICHITA: Double-A Wichita beat Tulsa on Thursday night by a score of 11-2, sweeping the Drillers in two games in the Divisional Series to advance to the Texas League Championship Series...they will play at Frisco tomorrow night at 5:05 pm (CT) and will send Kody Funderburk to the mound...Funderburk went 10-5, 2.94 ERA (107.0 IP, 35 ER) in 32 games (17 starts) this season.

ON THIS DAY IN DAZZLE HISTORY: In 1984, the original Ironman, Dan Gladden, played both games of a doubleheader while playing for San Francisco, hosting San Diego, leading off and playing centerfield...Gladden had four hits in eight at-bats on the day, with one RBI, two runs scored, two walks, one strikeout and one stolen base...Gladden played 349 career games in centerfield, 225th most all-time among right-handed-throwing players born in the U.S., trailing Tony Gwynn, Jr. (350) and ahead of Hersh Martin (346); 38 more games and he would have tied Peanuts Lowrey (387) for 208th...17 more games and he would have tied good ol' Wally Westlake (366).

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan earned his team-leading 12th win of the season in his last start on September 18 at Cleveland, a 3-0 Twins shutout victory – the only game Minnesota won in that series...tossed 7.2 shutout innings and allowed three hits and one walk, with five strikeouts...became the second Twins starting pitcher this season to work in the eighth inning, alongside Dylan Bundy on June 18 at Arizona (8.0 IP)...also became the first Twins starting pitcher with 7.0-or-more scoreless innings in consecutive starts since Martin Pérez from May 1-6, 2019 (8.0 IP vs. Houston and 7.0 IP at Toronto).

- ☞ Owns a .102 (6-for-59) opponent batting average in three September starts, tops in the American League (min. 50 AB) and second in the majors, behind Cincinnati's Chase Anderson (.100).

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan earned his 11th win of the season on September 13 vs. Kansas City, as the Twins won 6-3...tossed 7.0 no-hit innings, with two walks and nine strikeouts...Jovani Moran carried the no-hit bid for another 1.1 innings before yielding a one-out, run-scoring double to Bobby Witt Jr. in the top of the ninth...Ryan threw 106 pitches in the start, his third most in an outing in his career (107 on August 9 at Los Angeles-NL and 107 on August 26 vs. San Francisco)...also matched his season high with nine strikeouts.

- ☞ Became the first rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with a complete outing of at least 7.0 no-hit innings.

100K GOLD: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold on August 21 and currently has 138 strikeouts on the season...he is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015.

- ☞ Ryan currently has the fourth-most single-season strikeouts by a rookie in Twins/Senators history (1901-present), trailing only Jim Hughes (164 in 1914), Doc Ayers (148 in 1914) and Francisco Liriano (144 in 2006)...he currently ranks second in Twins history, behind only Liriano.
- ☞ Ryan enters today first in the American League and third among major league rookies this season in strikeouts, behind Atlanta's Spencer Strider (202) and Cincinnati's Hunter Greene (146).

SOMETIMES YOU WIN, SOMETIMES YOU LOSE: Ryan earned his 10th win of the season on August 26, becoming the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below)...he enters today leading all major league rookies in wins, with 12.

- ☞ Ryan's 12 wins this season are tied with Jesse Crain (2005), Scott Diamond (2012), Francisco Liriano (2006), Glen Perkins (2008), Mark Redman (2000) and Kevin Tapani (1990) for third most in a single season by a Twins rookie, behind only Jim Hughes (16 in 1975) and Roger Erickson (14 in 1978).

HEAVENLY NEWCOMER: Ryan is facing the Angels for the first time in his career tonight...owns four career starts and appearances against the American League West division, all coming this season; has gone 0-4, 5.68 ERA (19.0 IP, 12 ER) with 13 walks and 16 strikeouts in those prior outings against Seattle (2x), Houston (1x) and Texas (1x)...the AL West is the only division he's faced and never won against (has yet to face a team from the National League East in his career).

- ☞ Three of his four starts against the AL West have come at Target Field, going 0-3, 5.02 ERA (14.1 IP, 8 ER) with 12 walks and 13 strikeouts in those outings.

GETTING BACK ON TARGET: Making his 15th start at Target Field this season; has gone 7-4, 2.85 ERA (79.0 IP, 25 ER) with 26 walks and 85 strikeouts at home...this compares to 5-4, 4.66 ERA (58.0 IP, 30 ER) with 17 walks and 53 strikeouts in 11 starts on the road...his road numbers are skewed by the 10 earned runs he permitted in 4.2 innings on July 29 at San Diego; prior to that start, had posted a 3.94 ERA on the road.

- ☞ Has a .180 (51-for-284) opponent batting average at home, tops in the American League and third best in the majors (min. 75.0 IP at home) behind Arizona's Zac Gallen (.176) and San Diego's Yu Darvish (.177).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball – he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 60.0% of the time through his first 25 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

- ☞ Ryan has a .270 wOBA on his four seamer, sixth best in the majors this season (min. 250 PA)...also has a -18 run value on the pitch, tied for fifth among major league pitchers under those same parameters.
