**THE TWINS:** After completing their eight-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 1-7 (1-4 at Cleveland and 0-3 at Kansas City), the Twins began their final homestand of the season with a loss to the Angels on Friday night, followed by a win in game two last night...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale against Los Angeles-AL at Target Field...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then play three games against the White Sox on Tuesday-Thursday.  
 ☞ The Twins have gone 44-33 at home, compared to 30-45 on the road...they have won four of their last five at Target Field, nine of their last 14, and 13 of their last 21.

**TWINS EVEN SERIES VS. ANGELS:** The Twins beat the Angels last night at Target Field by a score of 8-4...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Ryan struck out five batters, moving himself within one of tying Francisco Liriano (144 - 2006) for first on the club's all-time single-season rookie strikeout list...the bullpen combined to pitch 5.0 innings with just one run allowed on three hits...the offense recorded 11 hits, including three apiece from Jose Miranda and Gio Urshela...Gary Sánchez hit his 15th home run and drove in four runs.

**KINGS OF THEIR HILL:** Twins pitchers have posted a 3.53 ERA (703.0 IP, 276 ER) in 77 home games, compared to a 4.51 ERA (648.0 IP, 325 ER) in 75 road games...the 0.98 difference in ERA between home and road is tied with St. Louis (3.29 at home, 4.27 on the road) for the widest margin in baseball...below are the Twins' home and road hitting and pitching comparisons:

**TWINS-ANGELS:** Today marks the Twins' sixth and final game with the Angels this season... Twins have gone 2-3 vs. Los Angeles this season, 1-2 at Angel Stadium (August 12-14) and 1-1 at Target Field...with a win today, the Twins can avoid losing the season series for the second-consecutive season (2-5 in 2021).

- ☞ Twins are 22-17 in their last 39 meetings with the Angels, dating back to September of 2015.
- ☞ Since 2018, 18 of 25 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less.
- ☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with three walks and an .844 OPS in 11 career games vs. the Angels.
- ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (101-for-337) with 22 doubles, 17 home runs, 68 RBI, a .372 on-base percentage, a .516 slugging percentage and an .889 OPS in 90 career games against the Angels...the 68 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 20)...additionally, his 68 RBI are sixth most among actives.
- ☞ Angels manager, Phil Nevin, played 16 games for the AL Central Champion Twins in 2006... Nevin was acquired by the Twins via trade with Chicago-NL (for IF Adam Harben) at the trade waiver deadline on August 31 and hit .190 (8-for-42) with one double, one home run, four RBI, 10 walks and a .340 on-base percentage down the stretch.

**THE BATTING ARRAGE:** Luis Arraez went 2-for-4 last night and is now hitting .313, trailing Xander Bogaerts (.315) and Aaron Judge (.314) in the American League batting race...below are the top three hitters for average in the American League:

**ADDITIONALLY:** Arraez ranks sixth in batting average in all of baseball as National Leaguers Freddie Freeman (.328), Paul Goldschmidt (.319) and Jeff McNeil (.318) hold the top three spots.

**C4, DETONATE:** In 22 games this month, Carlos Correa is hitting .360 (32-for-89) with five doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI, a .418 on-base percentage, a .618 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS...among all AL players in September, he ranks second in hits, tied for third in total bases (55), fifth in OPS, tied for eighth in extra-base hits (11) and homers, tied for ninth in RBI, and 10th in slugging percentage.  
 ☞ Correa is now hitting .287 (140-for-487) in 127 games on the season, the second-highest mark of his career after he hit .315 in 109 games with Houston in 2017...he has raised his batting average 24 points in 40 games since August 12, going from .263 to .287.  
 ☞ He has hit safely in six-straight games, going 11-for-25 (.440) in that span...his season-long hitting streak is eight, done twice from June 21-28 and August 9-17.  
 ☞ He is hitting .455 (10-for-22) with a 1.065 OPS in his last 18 games with runners in scoring position...he is 6-for-his-last-12 with RISP.

**SHOOTING FOR TWO:** The Twins are 20-21-6 in series play this season, going 13-7-4 at home and 7-14-2 on the road...they are looking for their first series win since a three-game sweep of the Royals at Target Field from September 13-15...a win today would give the Twins their first series win over the Angels since sweeping them in three games from May 20-23, 2019...the Twins have gone 7-5 in rubber games this season.

**TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS:** Twins have named Double-A Wichita catcher Jair Camargo and left-handed pitcher Brent Headrick as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.  
 ☞ Camargo, 23, played in four games for the Wind Surge, hitting .375 (6-for-16) with one double, three home runs, nine RBI, two walks, a .444 on-base percentage, a 1.000 slugging percentage and a 1.444 OPS...his week included a two-homer game and five RBI on Thursday when the Wind Surge clinched a spot in the Texas League Championship Series.  
 ☞ Headrick, 24, started game one in the Division Series vs. Tulsa on Tuesday night and earned the win, allowing one unearned run on six hits, with no walks and eight strikeouts.

**HBD, RQC!:** Twins manager Rocco Baldelli turns 41 today...he shares a birthday with actors Michael Douglas, Will Smith and Mark Hamill, rapper T.I., and former NBA stars Chauncey Billups and Scottie Pippen...the Twins lost on Rocco's birthday last year, a 6-1 defeat vs. Toronto at Target Field...they are 2-1 all-time under Rocco on his birthday...full list in upper right.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1965, Jim "Mudcat" Grant threw a complete-game one-hitter, as the Twins defeated the Senators in the first game of a doubleheader...the win marked Grant's 20th of the season, becoming the first African-American pitcher in the American League to win 20 games in a season...in 1985, Bert Blyleven led the Twins to a 5-1 win in Texas, the 2,000th win in Minnesota history...in 2019, the Twins celebrated Rocco Baldelli's 38th birthday and first season as the club's manager with an American League Central title, winning 5-1 over the Tigers at Comerica Park (also a White Sox 8-3 win over Cleveland).

**I'M GOING TO WICHITA:** Double-A Wichita beat Tulsa on Thursday night by a score of 11-2, sweeping the Drillers in two games in the Divisional Series to advance to the Texas League Championship Series...they will play at Frisco tonight at 5:05 pm (CT) and will send Kody Funderburk to the mound...Funderburk went 10-5, 2.94 ERA (107.0 IP, 35 ER) in 32 games (17 starts) in the regular season.

- Making his team-leading 28th start of the season...also his 161st career start and 189th appearance...marks his most starts in a single season since making 30 for Baltimore in 2019. Facing Los Angeles-AL for the second time this season after not factoring into the decision (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 K) in the Twins' 5-3 loss on August 13 at Angel Stadium...spent 2020-21 with the Angels, including serving as their Opening Day starter in 2021...is a career 1-2, 5.86 ERA (27.2 IP, 18 ER) with six walks and 20 strikeouts in six games (5 starts) against his former team. Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Received a no-decision in his last start on September 20 at Kansas City as the Twins fell, 5-4...allowed four runs on four hits (2 home runs), with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...gave up a two-run home run to MJ Melendez in the third inning and a solo homer to Hunter Dozier in the fifth inning...marked his seventh start with two-or-more home runs this season...has completed 5.0 innings only once in his last five starts (5.0 IP on September 4 at Chicago-AL).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on September 15 vs. Kansas City at Target Field, a 3-2 Twins win...yielded two runs on four hits (1 home run), with no walks and two strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...marked his seventh start this season with no walks as well as his 20th with one-or-fewer walks.

BUMP IN THE ROAD: After going 2-2, 3.74 ERA with six walks and 17 strikeouts in seven starts from August 6-September 4, Bundy has gone 0-1, 8.78 ERA (13.1 IP, 13 ER) with one walk and five strikeouts in his last three starts, since September 9.

- Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 13 of his last 17 starts, dating back to June 18; is 5-4, 4.20 ERA (85.2 IP, 40 ER) with 16 walks and 52 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 9-8). Has also yielded two-or-fewer earned runs in seven of his last nine starts, since August 6; is 2-2, 4.25 ERA (42.1 IP, 20 ER) with seven walks and 21 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 5-4).

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 26 batters in 131.2 innings this season, including seven starts with no walks allowed and 21 starts with one-or-fewer...this equates to a career-low 4.7 walk percentage and a 1.78 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch strike percentage (67.4%). His 4.7 walk percentage is tied for fifth in the American League (min. 125.0 IP) and is eighth in the majors, while his 1.78 walks-per-9.0 IP is sixth in the AL/11th in the majors under those same parameters. Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball this season and his chase rate ranks in the 83rd percentile.

HELLO OLD FRIEND: Making his second start of the season against his former ballclub after not factoring into the decision on August 13 at Angel Stadium (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 1 K)...is a career 1-2, 5.86 ERA (27.2 IP, 18 ER) with six walks and 20 strikeouts in six games (5 starts) against Los Angeles-AL...has only faced the Angels once at his home ballpark, taking the loss on May 11, 2019 at Camden Yards (5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 2 HR, 2 BB, 2 K) as a member of the Baltimore Orioles. Bundy pitched for the Angels from 2020-21, including serving as Los Angeles-AL's 2021 Opening Day starting pitcher...he went 8-12, 4.89 ERA (156.1 IP, 85 ER) with 51 walks and 156 strikeouts in 34 games (30 starts) for Los Angeles-AL in that span...he also finished ninth in the American League Cy Young Award race in 2020, his first time garnering Cy Young votes in his career.

BACK TO TARGET FIELD: Bundy has gone 4-2, 3.86 ERA (53.2 IP, 23 ER) with nine walks, 32 strikeouts and a .262 (56-for-214) opponent batting average in his 11 home starts this season (Twins are 7-4)...however, his numbers are skewed by his start on September 9 vs. Cleveland (7 R/ER)...if you remove this start, he has a 2.94 ERA (49.0 IP, 16 ER) at home...this compares to his 4-5, 5.42 ERA (78.0 IP, 47 ER), 17 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .270 (83-for-307) opponent batting average he's posted in 16 road starts.

Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in eight of his 11 home starts this season...the three exceptions are June 9 vs. New York-AL (4 ER), July 16 vs. Chicago-AL (3 ER) and September 9 vs. Cleveland (7 ER)...if you remove those three home starts, Bundy has a 2.04 ERA (39.2 IP, 9 ER) with seven walks and 27 strikeouts at home this season.

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.0 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.4 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth-fastest worker among qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Joe Ryan - 21.6 seconds, Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds and Tyler Duffey - 22.1 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.3 seconds with runners on base.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 27 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...42 of his 89 strikeouts this season (47.2 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

Has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in 14 of his 27 starts this season...ranks third in MLB (min. 125.0 IP) with a 69.23 strike percentage this season, trailing Toronto's Kevin Gausman (70.11) and Tampa Bay's Corey Kluber (69.45).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhart Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews. Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and Baseball America Minor League All-Star. Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April, 2012 (30 consecutive scoreless IP) and named Orioles top prospect by Baseball America following the season. Originally selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.
