THE TWINS: After beginning their final homestand of the season with a three-game series loss to the Angels over the weekend, the Twins began their final home series of 2022 with a win over the White Sox last night...

⊕ The Twins have gone 45-34 at home, compared to 30-45 on the road...they have won five of their last seven at Target Field, 10 of their last 16, and 14 of their last 23.

I'LL TAKE THE OBER: The Twins shut out the White Sox last night by a score of 4-0, recording their 16th shutout of the season, fifth-best in baseball...Bailey Ober (2-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.1 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and a career-high 10 strikeouts...

SUPER-ZEROS: Last night's shutout marked the 16th of the season for the Twins' staff, the 11th at home...the most at home in a single season in Twins history, breaking a tie with the 1967 Twins (10)...below are where the 16 shutouts rank among all MLB teams and where it ranks in club history (since 1961):

TWINS-SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 15th of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 8-6 against the Sox in 2022, going 5-3 at Target Field and 3-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...

⊕ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 22 of his last 23 games against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in 14 games against the Sox this season, he is hitting .361 (22-for-61) with a .391 on-base percentage and an .866 OPS.

ALL EYES ON ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez went 1-for-4 last night and is now hitting .313, trailing Aaron Judge (.314) in the American League batting race...below are the top three hitters for average in the American League:

ADDITIONALLY: Arraez ranks fifth in batting average in all of baseball as National Leaguers Freddie Freeman (.327), Jeff McNeil (.319) and Paul Goldschmidt (.318) hold the top three spots.

JOSE HITS: Jose Miranda made his debut on May 2 at Baltimore and began his major league career by hitting .094 (5-for-53) with a .332 OPS in his first 14 games...in 103 games since then, he has hit .299 (110-for-368) with an .825 OPS...below are Miranda's ranks in a few offensive categories among all AL rookies with a minimum of 300 at-bats this season:

SEPTEMBER TO REMEMBER: Carlos Correa has hit safely in eight-straight games, going 14-for-33 (.424) in that span...his current streak ties his season-high, done twice previously from June 21-28 and August 9-17...his last streak longer than eight was nine, from September 20, 2019-July 31, 2020, with Houston...his career-long is 16, done in 2019...additionally, in 24 games this month, Correa is hitting .361 (35-for-97) with seven doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI, a .415 on-base percentage, a .619 slugging percentage and a 1.034 OPS.

TO THE WINDOW TO THE WALLNER: In his last 49 games between Triple-A St. Paul and Minnesota, Matt Wallner is hitting .282 (51-for-181) with 18 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 34 RBI, 29 runs scored, 30 walks, a .3398 on-base percentage, a .547 slugging percentage and a .945 OPS...in 20 games between both teams this month, he is slashing .297/.373/.593 with a .966 OPS.

⊕ Through 11 games with the Twins, Wallner has posted an average exit velocity of 94.6 mph...by comparison, the top five qualifiers in baseball are Aaron Judge (95.6 mph), Yordan Alvarez (95.3 mph), Giancarlo Stanton (95.0 mph), Joc Pederson (93.1 mph) and Rafael Devers (93.0 mph).

I'M LEAVING WICHITA: Double-A Wichita lost to Frisco last night by a score of 7-5 in 10 innings, ending the Wing Surge's season, falling short of the Texas League Championship for the second consecutive season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Winder was saddled with the 4-1 loss in his last start on September 22 at Kansas City, his first career loss in a quality start...yielded three runs on six hits (2 home runs), with one walk and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...his 6.0 innings and two home runs allowed tied his single-game career highs, while his 89 pitches were the most he's thrown in an outing in his major league career.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Winder did not factor into the decision, a 7-6 Twins loss in the second game of the doubleheader on September 17 at Cleveland...allowed four runs on six hits (1 home run), with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...yielded one run in the first inning on an Oscar Gonzalez two-out double...retired 10-straight batters from the bottom of the first to the bottom of the fourth, before running into trouble in the fifth; recorded the first two outs of the inning before permitting a walk, single, three-run homer to Amed Rosario and single to José Ramirez prior to departing in favor of Jovani Moran.

The Twins lost, 7-6, when Cleveland walked off in the bottom of the 15th inning...marked the first game in the majors to reach 15 innings this season and, at 5:24, is also the longest game by time in the majors this season...was also the Twins' longest game by both time and innings since an 18-inning, 5:42 5-2 loss to Tampa Bay on June 27, 2019.

**SOCK 'EM:** Facing Chicago-AL for the third time in his career tonight, making his second start; is 1-0, 3.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and five strikeouts in his two prior outings...first faced the White Sox in relief on April 24 at Target Field, a 6-4 Twins win (4.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 K)...earned the 8-2 win in a start on July 5 at Guaranteed Rate Field (5.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 3 K).

Winder is 2-2, 3.64 ERA (29.2 IP, 12 ER) with six walks and 16 strikeouts in six games (5 starts) against the American League Central division, including 0-1, 3.38 ERA (8.0 IP, 3 ER) with one walk and six strikeouts in two games (1 start) against the division at home.

**DISCOMFORTS OF HOME:** Has pitched incrementally better on the road than at home in his young career, going 3-2, 3.93 ERA (36.2 IP, 16 ER) with nine walks and 20 strikeouts in seven games (5 starts) away from Target Field, compared to 1-3, 4.63 ERA (23.1 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 19 strikeouts in six games (4 starts) at home.

Winder went 1-0, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER) with a .167 (6-for-36) opponent batting average in his first three career home outings (1 start) from April 12-May 6...however, is 0-3, 7.30 ERA (12.1 IP, 10 ER) in his last three home starts, since May 12.

**IT'S TIME TO START:** Winder has gone 4-4, 3.72 ERA (46.0 IP, 19 ER) as a major league starter...prior to his start on July 12 vs. Milwaukee, had a 1.71 ERA through his first five career starts, the lowest mark in Twins history (1961-present, min. 25.0 IP)...has gone 0-3, 6.41 ERA (19.2 IP, 14 ER) with five walks and 12 strikeouts in his last four starts, since July 12.

On May 1 at Tampa Bay, became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) and fifth in Twins/Senators history (1901-present) with at least 6.0 shutout innings and two-or-fewer hits allowed in his first career start...the others are Mike Fornieles on September 2, 1952 (9.0 IP, 1 H, 6 BB, 4 K), Wally Holborow on August 4, 1945 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K), Claude Thomas on September 18, 1916 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 5 BB, 2 K) and George Dumont on September 14, 1915 (9.0 IP, 2 H, 4 BB, 2 K).

Has 33 strikeouts against 12 walks as a starter, with a 1.17 WHIP and a .241/.296/.443 opponent slash line (42-for-174 with 11 2B, 8 HR and 2 HBP).

Has worked 6.0 innings while allowing zero earned runs in three of his first nine big league starts (May 1 at Tampa Bay, May 6 vs. Oakland and in Game 2 of the June 28 doubleheader at Cleveland)...has also gone at least 5.0 innings in six of his nine starting efforts and posted four quality starts, including in his last start on September 22 at Kansas City.

His major league debut on April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL marked his first career professional relief outing...is 0-1, 5.79 ERA (14.0 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and six strikeouts in four appearances out of the Twins bullpen.

All 44 of his career minor league outings from 2018-21 were starts, going 14-3, 2.82 ERA (236.1 IP, 74 ER) with 49 walks and 240 strikeouts over three seasons...15 of his 44 starts were quality and recorded eight starts of at least 7.0 innings (including two of 8.0 IP)...also fanned seven-or-more batters in 17 starts, including a career-high nine batters thrice.

**REVERSE SPLITS REVERSED:** Winder has had better success against left-handed batters (.219, 21-for-96 with 9 XBH, 9 BB and 18 K) than against righties (.276, 37-for-134 with 16 XBH, 8 BB and 21 K) thus far in his young career.

In his start on September 11 vs. Cleveland, left-handed batters went 4-for-8 with one double and two home runs against Winder, while righties went 0-for-8 with one walk; was just the second time in his career he held right-handed batters hitless in an outing (also, April 12 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 0-for-2).

**THE ARSENAL:** Winder has displayed a four-pitch mix through his first 13 career appearances, with his four-seam fastball leading the way at a 40.7-percent use rate...his put-away pitch has been his slider, as 20 of his 39 career strikeouts have come on the pitch...opponents have recorded just one hit off his curveball (1-for-21) and are a combined 17-for-108 (.157) with 25 strikeouts off his slider and curve...here is a look at the rookie's arsenal this season, per Baseball Savant:

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP LOUIE VARLAND (2022 SEASON: 0-2, 5.06 ERA // CAREER: 0-2, 5.06 ERA)**

Rookie right-hander Louie Varland is scheduled to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, in the Twins' final home game of the 2022 season...will be making his fourth career start and appearance, as well as his second at Target Field; also due to face the White Sox for the first time in his career...took the 4-2 loss in his last start on September 23 vs. Los Angeles-AL, the first game of this current homestand; allowed three runs on seven hits (2 home runs), with one walk and three strikeouts in a career-high 5.2 innings of work.

- Made his major league debut in a relief appearance for the Twins on April 12, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL (1.0 IP, 0 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K).
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.
- In 2021, went a combined 4-0, 2.63 ERA (72.0 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 80 strikeouts and a .211 (55-for-261) opponent batting average in 14 starts between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul.
- Selected to the American League team in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field...tossed 0.1 inning (1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 K, 1 WP).
