THE TWINS: After beginning their final homestand of the season with a three-game series loss to the Angels over the weekend, the Twins began their final home series of 2022 with consecutive wins over the White Sox the last two nights...today, Minnesota will play the Target Field season finale against the White Sox...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Detroit to begin their final roadtrip of 2022 with three against the Tigers at Comerica Park this weekend, followed by three against the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday.

The Twins have gone 46-34 at home, compared to 30-45 on the road...they have won six of their last eight at Target Field, 11 of their last 17, and 15 of their last 24.

TWINS SECURE SERIES WIN OVER SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 8-4, securing the series victory, their 21st of the season (21-22-6) and 15th at home (15-7-4)...Josh Winder was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, including three apiece from Gio Urshela and Jake Cave...Matt Wallner added two hits, walked once and drove in three runs.

TWINS-SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 16th of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 9-6 against the Sox in 2022, going 6-3 at Target Field and 3-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field... the Iwins began the season 5-0 vs. the Sox, then went 1-6 in their next seven, and have now won three straight.

◆ These two will meet again at Guaranteed Rate Field for a three-game series from October 2-5, to complete the regular season, a series that was originally scheduled to open the 2022 season but moved due to the offseason MLB work stoppage.

◆ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 23 of his last 24 games against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...in 15 games against the Sox this season, he is hitting .364 (24-for-66) with a .391 on-base percentage and an .861 OPS.

◆ The last time the Twins finished their home schedule with the White Sox was on September 30, 2018, as Joe Mauer played in his final major league game.

LAST TIME OUT: Varland took the 4-2 loss in the homestand opener on September 23, opposite Shohei Ohtani and the Los Angeles Angels...allowed three runs on seven hits (career-high 2 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts in a career-high 5.2 innings of work...marked his first career start at Target Field.

SECOND START SUMMARY: Took the loss in game one of the doubleheader on September 17 at Cleveland as the Twins fell, 5-1...allowed four runs on nine hits (1 home run), with two walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...marked his most earned runs allowed since also giving up four on May 12 with Double-A Wichita...marked his first career major league loss and decision.
