THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 5-1 (3-0 vs. the Giants and 2-1 vs. the Red Sox), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a loss to the White Sox last night...tonight, they will play the second of three on the South Side through the weekend...after tomorrow afternoon's game, they will travel to New York to begin a four-game series against the Yankees in The Bronx from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 27-34 on the road.

⚡ The Twins are looking to snap a season-long six-game losing streak on the road and win their first game away from Minnesota since a 4-0 victory at Los Angeles-AL on August 12 (also Tyler Mahle start)...their last six-game road losing streak came April 16-27, 2021 (6)...their last road losing streak longer than six was eight straight from September 1-15, 2018.

⚡ The Twins are 1-9 in their last 10 road games.

WILD ENDING ENDS IN WALK-OFF: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night in Chicago by a score of 4-3 in walk-off fashion, their sixth walk-off defeat of the season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not faction into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched, exiting with right hamstring tightness...Jorge López (4-7) suffered the loss, allowing a run to score on a fielder's choice in the ninth inning...the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Luis Arraez and Jose Miranda...Nick Gordon drove in all three Twins runs with a two-run double in the first inning and a groundout in the eighth inning.

THE AMAZING RACE: The Twins enter today one game back of Cleveland in the AL Central and two games ahead of Chicago...below is a closer look at the top three teams in the division:

MAHLE TIME: The Twins have reinstated right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle from the 15-day Injured List...Mahle, who was placed on the Injured List on August 20 with right shoulder inflammation, has made three starts for the Twins since being acquired at the trade deadline from Cincinnati, going 1-0, 2.51 ERA (14.1 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 12 strikeouts and a 0.84 WHIP...to make room for Mahle on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned left-handed pitcher Jovani Moran to Triple-A St. Paul...Moran, who was recalled by Minnesota on Monday, made one relief appearance during his most recent stint with the Twins, allowing one run on three hits in 3.0 innings on Wednesday vs. Boston.

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 12th of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 6-5 against the Sox in 2022, going 4-3 at Target Field and 2-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins are just 1-5 in their last six against Chicago after starting the season 5-0...Twins have been outscored by the Sox 52-57 this season.

⚡ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 19 of his last 20 games against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...he is hitting .326 (60-for-184) in 51 career games vs. the White Sox...the 60 career hits are his most against any opponent.

⚡ The Twins have hit 100 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (59 games), ahead of second place Kansas City's 72...Max Kepler leads baseball in that span with 16.

⚡ The Twins have homered 15 times in 11 games at Guaranteed Rate Field this season, tied with New York-AL for the most by an opponent this season.

MIRANDA WATCH: Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 300 at-bats this season, Jose Miranda ranks second in batting average (.275), slugging percentage (.448), on-base percentage (.328) and OPS (.775)...since the All-Star break, he is hitting .307 (42-for-137) with five doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, a .373 on-base percentage, a .453 slugging percentage and an .825 OPS in 36 games.

ARRAEZ, FROM A TO Z: Luis Arraez went 2-for-5 last night and has now hit safely in five straight, raising his batting average to .319...he has not hit below .318 since he was hitting .313 through May 20...the lowest his batting average has dipped this season was .296 on May 2...below are his AL ranks in a few categories:

I AM THE ONE WHO NICKS: Nick Gordon has hit safely in five-straight games, slashing .471/.500/.882 with 11 RBI during the stretch...since August 28, he has 37% of the club's RBI (11 of 30)...additionally, in his last 30 games, he has hit .333 (31-for-93) with 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 22 RBI, seven walks, 12 runs scored, a .373 on-base percentage, a .559 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa is hitting .299 (20-for-67) with 15 walks, eight RBI, a .417 on-base percentage and an .850 OPS in his last 19 games...in his last seven games, he is slashing .346/.469/.969.

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: In their last 17 games, since August 15, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.33 ERA (69.2 IP, 18 ER) with 14 walks, 77 strikeouts (5.50 K/BB) and just four home runs allowed...in their last seven games, they have a 1.74 ERA with a .204 opponent average.

YOU THINK YOU KNOW A.J.: Tonight's FOX analyst A.J. Pierzynski was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 1994 First-Year Player Draft...he played six seasons and 430 games for Minnesota from 1998-2003...he was traded to San Francisco on November 14, 2003, in exchange for Joe Nathan, Francisco Liriano and Boof Bonser...he played one season for the Giants then signed with the White Sox and played eight seasons on the South Side from 2005-12...A.J. made the AL All-Star team for both clubs (2002 - MIN & 2006 - CWS), one of two players to do so, the other being Hall of Famer Jim Kaat.

- Makes his fourth start with the Twins tonight and his 23rd start and appearance overall this season...also his 118th career appearance and 117th start. Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to tonight's game, after missing the Twins' last 14 games with right shoulder inflammation. Facing the White Sox for the second time in his career, after earning the 7-1 win on September 18, 2020 at Great American Ball Park (5.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 8 K). Acquired from the Cincinnati Reds via trade on August 2, in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajjar.

WELCOME BACK: Mahle was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to tonight's game, after missing the Twins' last 14 games with right shoulder inflammation...he was removed from his last start on August 17 vs. KC and placed on the IL August 20 (retroactive to August 18)...threw a 25-pitch bullpen session at Target Field on August 26, and an approximately 30-pitch bullpen session along with a pair of 15-pitch simulated innings at Target Field on August 29 in advance of his reinstatement.

LAST TIME OUT: Mahle did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 17 vs. Kansas City, after tossing 2.1 shutout innings (1 BB, 1 K) in the Twins' 4-0 win...he was removed after recording the first out in the top of the third inning (strikeout) due to right shoulder fatigue.

TWO STARTS AGO: Mahle earned his first win in a Twins uniform on August 12 at Los Angeles-AL, leading the Twins to a 4-0 shutout victory at Angel Stadium...tossed 6.0 innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and six strikeouts...marked his third scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings this season, also doing so on May 29 vs. San Francisco (6.2 IP) and June 14 at Arizona (9.0 IP)...also marked his 10th quality start of the season, two shy of his career high of 12, set in 2021.

CENTRAL COMMAND: Is facing the White Sox for the second time in his career tonight, after earning the win on September 18, 2020 at Great American Ball Park with Cincinnati (5.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 8 K). Tonight marks his fourth start this season against the American League Central division, posting no record and a 3.55 ERA (12.2 IP, 5 ER) with five walks, nine strikeouts and a .167 (7-for-42) opponent batting average in his three prior starts (2 against Cleveland with Cincinnati, 1 vs. Kansas City with Minnesota). Is a career 5-2, 4.17 ERA (69.0 IP, 32 ER) with 37 walks and 78 strikeouts in 15 games (14 starts) against the AL Central.

MASTER OF THE OPEN ROAD: Tonight marks Mahle's ninth road start and appearance this season; has gone 4-2, 3.33 ERA (46.0 IP, 17 ER) with 13 walks, 51 strikeouts and a .185 (31-for-168) opponent batting average in his eight prior starts...has performed better on the road than in his home ballpark, going 2-5, 4.71 ERA (72.2 IP, 38 ER) with 30 walks, 75 strikeouts and a .249 (68-for-273) opponent batting average in 14 home starts this year. His .242 opponent on-base percentage on the road is fourth best in the majors (min. 45.0 IP), while his .185 opponent batting average is fifth best and his .545 opponent OPS is sixth best under those same parameters.

DAY AND NIGHT, NIGHT AND DAY: Mahle has gone 4-3, 4.21 ERA (51.1 IP, 24 ER) with 13 walks, 57 strikeouts and .249 (49-for-197) opponent batting average in nine cumulative night starts this season, two for Minnesota and seven for Cincinnati...this compares his 2-4, 4.14 ERA (67.1 IP, 31 ER) with 30 walks, 69 strikeouts and a .205 (50-for-244) opponent batting average in 13 day starts this season. Earned the win in his last night start on August 12 at Los Angeles-AL, tossing the first 6.0 innings of a Twins 4-0 shutout win (3 H, 2 BB, 6 K).

ARSENAL: Here's a look at Mahle's repertoire in his first 22 starts of the season, per Baseball Savant...he throws a four-pitch mix, primarily relying on his two fastballs, the 4-seam and split finger. (# vs. RHB/LHB) RESULTS 4-Seam Fastball (93.3)..... 51.6% (1065 pitches, 518/547)..... .193 (45-for-233), 9 2B, 9 HR, 87 K Split Finger (85.4)..... 24.0% (496 pitches, 150/346)..... .244 (30-for-123), 9 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR, 21 K Cutter (85.6)..... 12.8% (264 pitches, 79/185)..... .256 (10-for-35), 1 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 5 K Slider (83.9)..... 11.6% (239 pitches, 226/13)..... .304 (14-for-46), 2 2B, 1 HR, 13 K

LEFT IS RIGHT: Mahle is holding opposing left-handed batters to a .193 (43-for-223) batting average this season, eighth best in the majors (min. 200 AB)...has held lefties to just 1-for-15 (.067) since joining the Twins...by contrast, righties are hitting .257 (56-for-218) against him this season. Owns a .193 (124-for-641) opponent batting average against left-handed hitters since the start of 2020, second best in the majors in that span (min. 500 AB), behind only Milwaukee's Brandon Woodruff (.191).

WITH THE REDS: Went 5-7, 4.40 ERA (104.1 IP, 51 ER) with 39 walks, 114 strikeouts and a .248 (91-for-393) opponent batting average in 19 starts with the Reds this season...had an 18-day stint on the 15-day Injured List from July 6-23 with a right shoulder strain...in his last nine starts for the Reds, he went 3-2, 2.83 ERA (57.1 IP, 18 ER) with seven quality starts, 16 walks and a .212 (44-for-208) opponent batting average. Produced four consecutive quality starts from May 29-June 14, the longest such streak of his career.

- In his outing on May 29 vs. San Francisco, did not allow a hit until Thairo Estrada, Mahle's final batter, doubled with two outs in the seventh inning...left the game with a 2-0 lead but was the victim of a blown save when the Giants scored six runs in the eighth inning, all with two outs...the Reds lost, 6-4. In the 12-inning, 5-3 win on June 14 at Arizona, Mahle became the first pitcher in the major leagues since 1900 to not earn a win after throwing at least 9.0 scoreless innings on the road with zero walks and at least 12 strikeouts (Elías)...became the first Reds pitcher to throw at least 9.0 scoreless innings without earning a win since left-handed pitcher Travis Wood (9 IP, 1 H, 0 BB, 8 K) did so in an 11-inning, 1-0 loss on July 10, 2010 at Philadelphia. Made the first Opening Day start of his career and earned the 6-3 win on April 7 at Atlanta (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/0 ER, 2 BB, 7 K) at Atlanta.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP DYLAN BUNDY [2022 SEASON: 7-6, 4.53 ERA // CAREER: 53-63, 4.69 ERA]

Right-handed pitcher Dylan Bundy is slated to start tomorrow's series finale against the White Sox in Chicago...did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 29 vs. Boston, an eventual 4-2 Twins win...allowed two runs on nine hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work; Twins scored thrice in the bottom of the fifth inning to take the lead for good...is due to face the White Sox for the fourth time this season, going 2-0, 2.35 ERA (15.1 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 13 strikeouts in his three prior starts.

CAREER NOTES

- Acquired by Minnesota via trade from Cincinnati on August 2, 2022 in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajjar. Named the Reds' 2022 Opening Day starter, making his first Opening Day start and his fifth-consecutive Opening Day roster. In 2021, established single-season career highs in wins (13), starts (33), quality starts (12), innings pitched (180.0), strikeouts (201) and batters faced (759)...had 13 wins after entering the season with 13 victories in his career...ranked among the National League pitching leaders in starts (7-1st), wins (7-10th), ERA (16th), strikeouts (9th) and strikeouts-per-9.0 innings (7th, 10.50). His strikeouts-per-9 innings ratio of 10.50 in 2021 was third best in Reds franchise history behind Luis Castillo (10.67 in 2019) and Sonny Gray (10.52 in 2019). Opponents hit just .198 (34-for-172) against Mahle in 2020...went 2-2, 3.59 ERA (47.2 IP, 19 ER) with six home runs, 21 walks and 60 strikeouts over the course of the season. Made the first relief appearance of his major league career, following 54 consecutive starts, on August 12, 2020 vs. Kansas City (3.1 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 K)...was his first professional relief appearance since 2015, when he made 26 starts and one relief outing.
