BEGINNINGS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 5-1 (3-0 vs. the Giants and 2-1 vs. the Red Sox), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with consecutive losses to the White Sox over the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale on the South Side...after today's game, they will travel to New York to begin a four-game series against the Yankees in The Bronx from tomorrow-Thursday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 27-35 on the road.

- The Twins are looking to snap a season-long seven-game losing streak on the road and win their first game away from Minnesota since a 4-0 victory at Los Angeles-AL on August 12...their last seven-game road losing streak came September 1-15, 2018, when they dropped eight straight.
- The Twins are 1-10 in their last 11 road games.

SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Twins were shut out and one-hit by Dylan Cease and the White Sox last night by a score of 13-0 (season-high in runs allowed)...Tyler Mahle made his return from the Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) and allowed four runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, averaging 88.4 mph on his fastball...Aron Sanchez pitched 5.0 innings in relief of Mahle...the Twins were held hitless for 8.2 innings until Luis Arraez broke up Cease's no-hitter with a single to rightfield...it marked their 13th time being shut out this season, tied for fourth-most in baseball.

ONLY YOU: Last night marked the 35th time in club history the Twins have been one-hit (since 1961) and third time this season (also 4/13 vs. LAD & 7/17 vs. CWS)...it marked the 13th time that the Twins broke-up the no-hitter in the ninth inning...below are the last six, including last night:

TWINS, CHICAGO - LIVE: Twins and White Sox are playing the 13th of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 6-6 against the Sox in 2022, going 4-3 at Target Field and 2-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins are just 1-6 in their last seven against Chicago after starting the season 5-0...Twins have been outscored by the Sox 65-57 this season...these two will meet next for a three-game series at Target Field from September 27-29...they will finish the 2022 regular season with three at Guaranteed Rate Field from October 3-5.

- Luis Arraez has hit safely in 20 of his last 21 games against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021...he is hitting .324 (61-for-188) in 52 career games vs. the White Sox...the 61 career hits are his most against any opponent.
- The Twins have hit 100 home runs against Chicago since the start of 2019 (59 games), ahead of second place Kansas City's 72...Max Kepler leads baseball in that span with 16.
- The Twins have homered nine times in five games at Guaranteed Rate Field this season, tied with New York-AL for the most by an opponent this season...they have been held homerless in two straight here, their last homer at GRF coming on July 6 (Urshela).

(25 OR) 6 TO 4: Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 300 at-bats this season, Jose Miranda ranks second in batting average (.272) and OPS (.768), and third in slugging percentage (.443) and on-base percentage (.325)...since the All-Star Break, he is hitting .300 (42-for-140) with five doubles, five home runs, 24 RBI, a .365 on-base percentage, a .443 slugging percentage and an .808 OPS in 37 games.

- In Miranda's last 162 games, which dates back to July 11, 2021 and includes his games at Triple-A St. Paul last season and the beginning of this season, he is hitting .291 (180-for-618) with 39 doubles, 23 home runs, 97 RBI, a .321 on-base percentage, a .466 slugging percentage and a .787 OPS.

FEELIN' STRONGER EVERY DAY: Luis Arraez went 1-for-4 last night and has now hit safely in six-straight games...his season-high hitting streak is 11, from May 21-31 (Game 1)...below are his AL ranks in a few categories:

YOU'RE THE INSPIRATION: In his last 31 games, Nick Gordon has hit .323 (31-for-96) with 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 22 RBI, seven walks, a .362 on-base percentage, a .542 slugging percentage and a .904 OPS...since August 28, he has 37% of the club's RBI (11 of 30).

BABY, WHAT A BIG SURPRISE: The Twins have named Triple-A St Paul outfielder Matt Wallner and Double-A Wichita left-handed pitcher Brent Headrick as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

- Wallner, 24, played in six games for the Saints, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI and seven walks...he recorded the first cycle in Saints history on Thursday night against Omaha and finished the game with five hits...this marks the Forest Lake, MN native's fourth time being named in 2022, the most ever for a Twins minor leaguer in one season.
- Headrick, 24, made one start for the Wind Surge last Sunday at Frisco, allowing one run on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and nine strikeouts...he has struck out 27 batters in his last three starts (15.0 IP)...the Braidwood, IL native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Illinois State.

OLD DAYS: On this day in 2010, Jim Thome hit his 583rd and 584th career home runs to pass Mark McGwire and take over ninth place on baseball's all-time list in a Twins 12-4 win over Texas...Thome currently ranks eighth on baseball's all-time list with 612 home runs...he hit 37 career homers as a Twin (2010-11) and 134 with the White Sox (2006-09)...in 2020, the Twins played a doubleheader at Target Field against Detroit, playing the road team in Game 2, winning 3-2...it marked the first ever scheduled away game for the Twins in Minnesota.

- Making his team-leading 24th start of the season...also his 157th career start and 185th appearance. Facing the White Sox for the fourth time this season...has gone 2-0, 2.35 ERA (15.1 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 13 strikeouts in his three prior starts. Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Bundy did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 29 vs. Boston, a 4-2 Twins win...allowed two runs on nine hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...departed with the Twins down 2-1; Minnesota scored thrice in the bottom of the fifth inning to take the lead for good...marked Bundy's first career start in which he allowed at least nine hits but only two runs.

Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 11 of his last 13 starts, dating back to June 18; is 4-3, 3.61 ERA (67.1 IP, 27 ER) with 14 walks and 43 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 7-6)...has also yielded two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last five starts, since August 6; is 1-1, 2.63 ERA (24.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 12 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 3-2).

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy took his sixth loss of the season on August 24 at Houston, as the Twins fell 5-3...allowed two runs on three hits, with one walk and no strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...gave up a home run to Jose Altuve on his first pitch of the game, but limited to the Astros to one more run over the remainder of his outing (a sacrifice fly by Yuli Gurriel in the bottom of the third)...did not record a strikeout in a start for the third time in his career (also May 8, 2018 vs. Kansas City, with Baltimore; and June 28, 2021 at New York-AL, with Los Angeles-AL).

STAYING IN THE ZONE: Bundy threw 62 of his 86 pitches for strikes in his last start on August 29, good for a 72.1 strike percentage...has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in 13 of his 23 starts this season...ranks second in MLB (min. 100.0 IP) with a 69.42 strike percentage this season, trailing only Toronto's Kevin Gausman (69.82).

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 24 batters in 113.1 innings, including five starts with no walks allowed and 12 starts with one walk...this equates to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.91 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (33.1%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.5%).

His 5.1 walk percentage ranks ninth in the American League (min. 100.0 IP), while his 1.90 walks-per-9.0 IP is 11th under those same parameters. Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 90th percentile in baseball this season and his chase rate ranks in the 89th percentile.

SOUTH SIDE SHOWDOWN: Bundy is facing the White Sox for the fourth time this season, going 2-0, 2.35 ERA (15.1 IP, 4 RE) with two walks, 13 strikeouts and a 0.91 WHIP in his three prior starts...this includes one start at Guaranteed Rate Field, a no-decision on July 4 (6-3 W, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 6 K)...is 6-0, 3.47 ERA (49.1 IP, 19 ER) with nine walks, 50 strikeouts and a 0.97 WHIP in nine career games (8 starts) against Chicago-AL.

Bundy's six career wins against the White Sox are his second most against any single opponent in his career, behind his eight wins against Texas...Chicago-AL is the only team he's faced at least four times in his career and never lost against.

Bundy is 3-0, 3.60 ERA (25.0 IP, 10 ER) with six walks, 33 strikeouts and a 0.84 WHIP in four career starts at Guaranteed Rate Field...Guaranteed Rate Field and Globe Life Field in Texas (3-0) are the only ballparks Bundy has started at least three times at and never lost at in his career.

Bundy is 2-0, 3.09 ERA (32.0 IP, 11 ER) with four walks, 23 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in six starts against the American League Central division this season...owns no record, a 3.94 ERA (16.0 IP, 7 ER) with two walks, seven strikeouts and a 1.25 WHIP in three road divisional starts this year.

ON THE ROAD: Bundy has struggled on the road this season, going 3-5, 5.66 ERA (68.1 IP, 43 ER) with 15 walks, 51 strikeouts and a 1.35 WHIP in 14 road starts...Twins have lost 10 of Bundy's 14 road starts this season...this compares to his 4-1 record, 2.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 14 ER) with nine walks, 29 strikeouts and 1.09 WHIP in nine home starts.

Bundy has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last three road starts, going 0-2, 3.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks, four strikeouts, a .173 (9-for-52) opponent batting average and a 0.73 WHIP in that span (Twins are 0-3).

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.4 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth-fastest worker among qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds, Joe Ryan - 21.7 seconds and Tyler Duffey - 22.2 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.3 seconds with runners on base.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 23 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...38 of his 80 strikeouts this season (48 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 2-7, 4.52 ERA // CAREER: 63-88, 3.92 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is due to start tomorrow afternoon's Labor Day series opener against New York-AL in The Bronx...did not factor into the decision in his last stat on August 30 vs. Boston, a 10-5 Twins win that snapped an eight-game streak of Twins losses when Archer starts...allowed four runs on five hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in 4.1 innings; Twins scored four times in the bottom of the fifth inning to take the lead for good...Archer is slated to face the Yankees for the second time this season, after earning the 8-1 win on June 8 at Target Field (5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 4 BB, 2 K)...is 7-7, 3.03 ERA (124.2 IP, 42 ER) with 35 walks and 121 strikeouts in 20 career starts against New York-AL.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews.
