**THE TWINS:** Began their seven-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series loss on the South Side against the White Sox over the weekend, salvaging the third game of the series...today, they will continue the trip with the first of four against the Yankees in the Bronx through Thursday... the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 28-35 on the road...the Twins are 2-10 in their last 12 road games.

**BUNDY SAVES THE SERIES ON THE SOUTH SIDE:** The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 5-1...Dylan Bundy (8-6) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, one walk and four strikeouts, improving his ERA to 1.80 in his last five starts and 3.36 in his last 14 starts...the offense recorded 12 hits, their most since August 16 vs. Kansas City (16)...Carlos Correa went 2-for-5 with two RBI, including his 16th home run and 17th double of the season...Jose Miranda also went 2-for-5 and drove in two runs, giving him a team-leading 58 RBI.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the fourth of seven meetings in 2022 today...the Twins hosted the Yankees for a three-game series from June 7-9, winning the middle game...in that series, the Yankees outscored the Twins 21-19...the series was tied at 1-1 as the Twins tagged Gerrit Cole for five home runs and seven runs allowed in the third game, but the bullpen combined to allow seven runs in the final five innings, dropping the rubber game 10-7. 

The Inhead-to-head regular season games since 2017, the Twins have gone 8-21 against the Yankees...since 2002, they have gone 37-95 against New York.

Carlos Correa is hitting .312 (39-for-125) with seven doubles, nine home runs, 26 RBI, 15 walks, a .383 on-base percentage, a .584 slugging percentage and a .967 OPS in 33 career regular season games against the Yankees...Correa hit .389 (14-for-36) with a 1.175 OPS in his first nine regular season games at Yankee Stadium from 2015-17, but has gone 0-for-20 here since 2018.

Gary Sánchez went 0-for-8 last series against the Yankees...he was signed by the Yankees as an undrafted free agent on July 2, 2009...he made his major league debut with New York in 2015 and played seven seasons with the Yankees from 2015-21...he played in 538 games, hitting .230 (444-for-1932) with 78 doubles, 138 home runs, 340 RBI and an .804 OPS...he was named an AL All-Star in both 2017 and 2019.

Gio Urshela played three seasons for the Yankees from 2019-21, hitting .292 (296-for-1013) with 63 doubles, 41 home runs, 153 RBI, a .335 on-base percentage, a .480 slugging percentage and an .815 OPS in 291 career games for New York...in 2019 Urshela hit .314 (139-for-442) with 34 doubles, 21 home runs, 74 RBI and an .889 OPS in 132 games.

BRONX BUMMERS: The Twins' last trip to Yankee Stadium was a 6-5 loss on September 13.

**BRONX BUMMERS:** The Twins' last trip to Yankee Stadium was a 6-5 loss on September 13, 2021 in a stand-alone game that was previously scheduled for August 22, but postponed due to Hurricane Henri...their last complete series here was August 19-21, getting swept in three games...since the start of 2017, they are 1-13 in regular season games at Yankee Stadium...their only win came on May 4, 2019 by a final score of 7-3 (Odorizzi over Happ).

THE AMAZING RACE: The Twins are tied with the Guardians for first-place in the AL Central and two games ahead of Chicago...below is a closer look at the top three teams in the division:

ADDITIONALLY: Today marks the first time for the Twins to either be in first place or share for the division lead since August 9...a win today and a Cleveland loss will give the Twins sole possession of first place for the first time since the off-day on August 8.

I AM THE ONE WHO NICKS: In his last 32 games, Nick Gordon has hit .313 (31-for-99) with 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 22 RBI, eight walks, a .358 on-base percentage, a .525 slugging percentage and an .883 OPS...below is a closer look at his season, from April 8-July 26 and July 27-present:

ARRAEZ PARTY: Luis Arraez went 1-for-5 yesterday and has now hit safely in seven-straight games...his season-high hitting streak is 11, from May 21-31 (Game 1)...Arraez enters today leading the AL in hitting just ahead of Boston's Xander Bogaerts...Arraez's average sits at .3171, compared to Bogaerts' ..165...he is hitting .339 (121-for-357) against right-handed pitching, 21 points ahead of New York-AL's Andrew Benintendi (.318).

### Arraez is leading off for the ninth-consecutive game today and a team-leading 72nd time in 2022.

HARD-HITTING INFO: Twins hitters enter today fourth in baseball in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage at 6.3%, trailing Atlanta (7.4%) New York-AL (6.6%) and Los Angeles-NL (6.4%)...Twins also enter fourth in baseball with an 89.6 mph team average exit velocity, behind Toronto (90.3), Atlanta (90.0) and New York-AL (89.9).

BROADWAY JOSE: Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 300 at-bats this season, Jose Miranda ranks second in batting average (.274) and OPS (.772), and third in slugging percentage (.446) and on-base percentage (.326)...since the All-Star Break, he is hitting .303 (44-for-145) with six doubles, five home runs, 26 RBI, a .366 on-base percentage, a .448 slugging percentage and an .815 OPS in 38 games.

The Miranda's two RBI yesterday afternoon gave him 58 on the season, breaking a tie for the team lead with Jorge Polanco (IL)...Miranda did not join the Twins until May 2 and has played in 95 games this season...the last Twins rookie to lead the club in RBI by the end of a season was Kent Hrbek with 92 in 1982.

The Miranda is the cousing actor playwright and filmmaker Lin-Manuel Miranda.

**C4, EX-'LOS-IVE:** Carlos Correa went 2-for-5 yesterday afternoon, snapping his 0-for-last-9...he is hitting .297 (22-for-74) with 15 walks, 10 RBI, a .407 on-base percentage and an .880 OPS in his last 21 games...in his last nine games, he is slashing .333/.436/.576 with 11 hits and six walks...on the season, he is slashing .242/.330/.404 in 52 road games, compared to .295/.372/.462 in 56 home games. 

Correa needs one home run to reach 150 for his career...he has eight home runs on the road this season and eight at home.

DOING MAJOR WORK ON LABOR DAY: The Twins are 43-25 on Labor Day since 1961, including a 21-13 record at home and 22-12 record on the road... on Labor Day in 2021, the Twins beat Cleveland at Progressive Field by a score of 5-2 as the club was managed by Bill Evers (Baldelli - Paternity List)... Bailey Ober made the start and was "piggy-backed" by Michael Pineda who earned the win with 3.0 scoreless innings of relief... the offense recorded 12 hits, including a four-hit day for Jorge Polanco, who recorded three doubles and one home run.

Twins have won each of their last three Labor Day games and are 6-3 in their last nine.

LAST TIME OUT: Twins snapped a streak of eight-consecutive losses in Archer's starts with a 10-5 victory over the Boston Red Sox on August 30 at Target Field...worked 4.1 innings, allowing four runs on five hits, with two walks and three strikeouts...no-hit Boston through his first 3.0 innings (1 BB, 2 K) and took a 3-0 lead into the fourth, but gave up a run in that inning and was charged with three in the fifth (two after he departed) as the Red Sox took a 4-3 lead...Twins grabbed the lead right back in the bottom of the fifth on Nick Gordon's first career grand slam.

The Marked his fourth start in which he blanked an opponent over the first three innings, only to allow multiple runs in the fourth and/or fifth to end his outing.

Threw 66.2 percent of his pitches for strikes (49-of-74), his third-best mark of the season (behind 69.2 percent on August 14 at Los Angeles-AL and 68.4 percent on May 5 at Baltimore).

TWO STARTS AGO: Handed his fourth-straight losing decision in a 6-3 setback to the Houston Astros on August 25 at Minute Maid Park...allowed five runs on a season-high eight hits (1 home run) in 4.0 innings, with one walk and two strikeouts...big blow was Trey Mancini's two-out, three-run homer to cap a four-run first inning.

© Threw 88 pitches, his second most this season (behind only the 90 he threw on June 30 at Cleveland).

A TALE OF TWO ARCHERS: The Twins went 7-7 in Archer's first 14 starts through June 25, while he was 2-3, 3.14 ERA (57.1 IP, 20 ER) with 24 walks, 45 strikeouts and a .216 opponent batting average (46-for-213)...since then, however, Minnesota is 1-8 when Archer takes the mound, while he is 0-4, 6.57 ERA (38.1 IP, 28 ER) with 21 walks, 36 strikeouts and a .243 opponent batting average

U-4, 6.57 EMA (36.1 If, 26 EM) WITH 21 Walks, 30 Stiffeedus and a .2-75 opposition setting accessed (35-for-144) in those nine starts.
 Minnesota's 10-5 victory over Boston on August 30 snapped a stretch of eight-straight losses in Archer's starts, a career-worst stretch for the veteran right-hander (surpassing the 7-straight Pittsburgh defeats between July 12 through August 14, 2019 and the 7 Tampa Bay losses from June 11 through July 15, 2016).
 His last personal victory came June 25 vs. Colorado at Target Field, a combined 6-0 shutout (5.0 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 5 K).

NEW YORK, NEW YORK: Archer will make his second start of the season against the Yankees, after earning his first win in a Twins uniform in an 8-1 victory over Nestor Cortes on June 8 at Target Field... held New York to one run on two hits over 5.0 innings, with four walks and two strikeouts...induced a pair of double play grounders to escape jams.

Today's game will be his first Yankee Stadium appearance since April 3, 2018 (5.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 3 BB, 8 K for a no-decision in Tampa Bay's 11-4 loss).

Is 3-3, 3.44 ERA (65.1 IP, 25 ER) in 10 career starts in this ballpark, but has not won in the Bronx since September 9, 2014; is 0-3, 4.62 ERA (37.0 IP, 19 ER) in six starts since.

ROAD STORY: Archer is 0-4, 8.05 ERA (19.0 IP, 17 ER) in his last five road starts, after posting a 2.49 ERA (25.1 IP, 7 ER) in his first six efforts away from Target Field...is 0-4, 4.87 ERA (44.1 IP, 24 ER) in his 11 road starts overall this season.

◆ Is looking for his first road win since September 25, 2018 at Chicago-NL (with Pittsburgh)... is 0-10, 5.79 ERA (112.0 IP, 72 ER) in 25 road games (24 starts) since (his teams are 7-18).

**BEWARE THE SUN:** Archer has scuffled to an 0-5 mark with a 5.53 ERA (40.2 IP, 25 ER) and a .229 opponent batting average (35-for-153) in 10 day starts this season...by contrast, is 2-2, 3.76 ERA (55.0 IP, 23 ER) with a .225 opponent batting average (46-for-204) in 13 starts under the lights.

TROUBLE GETTING OFF THE FIELD: 38.5 percent of the runs Archer has allowed this season (20-of-52) have come after he recorded the first two outs of an inning; 12 of those have come after there were two out and nobody on.

© Opposing batters have a .258 average (32-for-124) and a .757 OPS (10 2B, 2 HR and 21 BB) off Archer with two outs...collectively, MLB players are hitting .237 with a .703 OPS with two outs.

**TAKE YOUR TIME:** Archer has an average pitch tempo of 20.2 seconds between pitches with the bases empty (per Baseball Savant), slowest among Twins starters and 2.1 seconds longer than league average (18.1)...averages 24.2 seconds between pitches with runners on base, ninth among the 15 qualified Twins pitchers and slightly worse than league average (23.3).
