THE TWINS: Began their seven-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series loss on the South Side against the White Sox over the weekend, followed by a loss in the opener at Yankee Stadium yesterday afternoon...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of four against the Yankees in the Bronx through Thursday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 28-36 on the road...the Twins are 2-11 in their last 13 road game; their two road wins in that span are a 4-0 victory on August 12 at Los Angeles-AL and a 5-1 victory on Sunday afternoon at Chicago-AL.

FORMER TWINS AND FORMER YANKEES DO WORK ON LABOR DAY: The Twins lost to the Yankees yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-2...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to allow three runs in 3.0 innings of relief as Trevor Megill (3-2) was dealt the loss, allowing a two-run sixth inning that broke a 2-2 tie...the offense recorded six hits and was led by Gary Sánchez, who went 1-for-4 with a home run and two RBI...the 473-foot homer by Sánchez was the fourth-longest homer at Yankee Stadium in the Statcast era (since 2015) and longest hit there since Gary himself hit one 481 feet on June 21, 2019, off Houston's Brad Peacock.

TWINS-YANKEES: The Twins and Yankees are playing the fifth of seven meetings in 2022 today...the Twins are 1-3 against New York this season, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 7-9 and 0-1 at Yankee Stadium...they have been outscored by the Yankees 26-21 this season. In head-to-head regular season games since 2017, the Twins have gone 8-22 against the Yankees...since 2002, they have gone 37-96 against New York.

Since the start of 2017, they are 1-14 in regular season games at Yankee Stadium...their only win came on May 4, 2019 by a final score of 7-3 (Odoriz/over Happ).

Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (40-for-128) with seven doubles, nine home runs, 26 RBI, 16 walks, a .386 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a .964 OPS in 34 career regular season games against the Yankees.

Gary Sánchez hit his 75th career home run at Yankee Stadium yesterday (leaders to lower right)...he has six home runs in his last 13 games at Yankee Stadium.

FROM THE WORD GO-RDON: Nick Gordon has hit safely in 21 of his last 33 games...in that span, he is hitting .311 (32-for-103) with 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 22 RBI, eight walks, a .354 on-base percentage, a .515 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS...below is a closer look at his season, from April 8-July 26 and July 27-present:

THE MIRANDAS: Since the All-Star Break, Jose Miranda is hitting .302 (45-for-149) with six doubles, five home runs, 26 RBI, a .364 on-base percentage, a .443 slugging percentage and an .807 OPS in 39 games.

Miranda has a team-leading 58 RBI on the season despite not joining the Twins until May 2 and playing in only 96 games this season...the last Twins rookie to lead the club in RBI by the end of a season was Kent Hrbek with 92 in 1982.

Miranda is the cousin of actor, playwright and filmmaker Lin-Manuel Miranda.

COLE, WET BLANKET: The last time the Twins faced Gerrit Cole was on June 9 at Target Field, as they led the game off with three-straight homers from Luis Arraez (5th pitch), Byron Buxton (first pitch) and Carlos Correa (2nd pitch) in Cole's first eight pitches...Cole went on to allow two more home runs, another to Buxton in the second inning and one to Trevor Larnach in the third inning...the Twins went on to lose 10-7 as the Yankees scored in every inning except the third, fourth and ninth.

The game marked the first time Cole had allowed three-or-more home runs in his career (last gave up 3 HR on June 27, 2021 at Boston)...was the second-shortest start of his career, trailing his 1.2-inning outing on April 19 at Detroit earlier this season...was the seventh time an opposing team has scored seven-or-more runs against him in his career, the first time since September 19, 2021 at Cleveland (7).

With three-straight homers to start the game, the Twins became just the seventh team to accomplish the feat since 1900 (also San Diego on April 13, 1987, Atlanta on May 23, 2003, Milwaukee on September 9, 2007, Baltimore on May 10, 2012 and Arizona on July 21, 2017 and June 10, 2019)...they were the second team since 1900 to lead off the game with three-straight home runs and lose (also the Padres in 1987).

C4, EX-LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa is hitting .299 (23-for-77) with 16 walks, 10 RBI, a .411 on-base percentage and an .878 OPS in his last 22 games...in his last 10 games, he is slashing .333/.442/.556 with 12 hits and seven walks...on the season, he is slashing .244/.333/.403 in 53 road games, compared to .295/.372/.462 in 56 home games.

Correa needs one home run to reach 150 for his career...he has eight home runs on the road this season and eight at home.

ROSARIO WINS THE WEEK: Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Kala'i Rosario has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...Rosario hit .440 (11-for-25) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored, a .462 on-base percentage, a .720 slugging percentage and a 1.182 OPS in six games for the Mighty Missiles...the Papaikou, HI native was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Waiakea High School in Waiakea, HI...this marks the 20th time for a Twins minor leaguer to win a weekly award, the eighth-most in baseball this season.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, Brad Radke pitched the Twins to a 6-0 victory at the Metrodome, beating the A's and snapping Oakland's 20-game win streak...Radke pitched a complete-game shutout with six hits allowed and one walk...in 2016, The Twins lost 10-3 to the Royals, but Brian Dozier homered in his fifth-straight game, tying a team record, giving him 39 on the season and tying the American League record for a second baseman set by Alfonso Soriano (2003).

Acquired by the Twins from Tampa Bay on July 22, 2021, along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan was saddled with his seventh loss of the season in his last start on August 31 vs. Boston at Target Field...allowed five earned runs - matching his second-highest total of the season for the second time - on eight hits (2 home runs), with one walk, one hit batter and eight strikeouts...

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan earned his 10th win of the season on August 26 vs. San Francisco, the first game of the Twins' last home stand...tossed the first 6.0 innings of a 9-0 shutout win, allowing just two hits, three walks and one hit batter, with eight strikeouts...

100K GOLD: Ryan crossed the 100-strikeout threshold on August 21 and currently has 121 strikeouts on the season...he is the 10th rookie pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 100 strikeouts in a season, first since Trevor May had 110 in 2015...

SOMETIMES YOU WIN, SOMETIMES YOU LOSE: Ryan earned his 10th win of the season on August 26, becoming the 14th rookie in Twins history (1961-present) with at least 10 wins in a single season (full list below)...he enters tonight tops among all major league rookies in wins.

LEADING THE WAY: Enters tonight among rookie pitching leaders in a few categories (min. 55.0 IP). CATEGORY RYAN'S # AL/MLB RANKS. Wins: 10 (1st/1st), Quality Starts: 8 (T-1st/1-2nd), BB/9.0 IP: 2.66 (7th/9th), BAA: .223 (8th/9th), BABIP: .263 (8th/8th), Base runners/9.0 IP: 10.95 (8th/9th), SO/BB: 3.46 (7th/9th), ERA: 3.88 (10th/14th).

NEW YORK CITY TOURIST: Ryan is due to face New York-AL for the first time in his career tonight...also will mark his fifth start of the season/his career against the American League East division, going 1-1, 3.57 ERA (22.2 IP, 9 ER) with three walks, 25 strikeouts and a 1.06 WHIP in his four prior starts...

Ryan is 5-5, 4.92 ERA (71.1 IP, 39 ER) in 14 prior starts when facing an opponent for the first time...earned the win in his last start against a first-time opponent on August 26 vs. San Francisco (6.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 8 K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Due to make his 10th road start of the season tonight (first since August 9 at Los Angeles-NL) and has gone 4-3, 5.05 ERA (46.1 IP, 26 ER) with 11 walks and 45 strikeouts in his nine starts thus far...has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in six of his nine road starts this season...

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the 14th time this season...has a 5-5 record, 4.84 ERA (70.2 IP, 38 ER) with 22 walks and 78 strikeouts in his 13 prior night starts, compared to 5-2, 2.45 ERA (47.2 IP, 13 ER) with 13 walks and 43 strikeouts in nine day games...

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 121 batters so far, which will lead to 6,050 new trees planted.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has displayed a four-pitch mix so far in his career, relying primarily on his fastball - he threw it 65.8% of the time in 2021 and has thrown it 60.4% of the time through his first 22 starts of 2022...here's a look at the rookie's repertoire this season, per Baseball Savant.

Ryan is averaging 16.5 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than league average (18.1 seconds) and sixth among all Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches)...averages 21.7 seconds between pitches with runners on, sixth on the Twins (min. 100 pitches), again faster than league average (23.3 seconds).

- 2022 marks his fifth professional season, including 2020.
Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Single-A Bowling Green (6 starts), Single-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts...earned the win in his professional debut on June 22 vs. Vermont, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings (2 H, 3 K).
Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams, including first team All-America honors by the Division II Conference Commissioners Association...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

THE JOE RYAN EXPERIENCE: Below are some facts that summarize Ryan's career to date.

- Ryan has 151 career strikeouts through his first 27 games, most in Twins/Senators history through a pitcher's first 27 career games...also holds the record through a pitcher's first 28 career games, five ahead of Boof Bonser (146 in 2006-07).
His .214 opponent batting average through his first 27 career games is fifth lowest in Twins/Senators history (min. 115.0 IP), behind George Dumont (.193 from 1915-17), Jim Roland (.196 from 1962-64), Dave Boswell (.204 from 1964-65) and Bob Groom (.207 in 1909).
