PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT: The Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series loss on the South Side against the White Sox over the weekend, followed by a loss in the opener at Yankee Stadium on Monday afternoon...today, they will continue the trip with the second and third of the four-game series against the Yankees in the Bronx through tomorrow night...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 28-36 on the road...the Twins are 2-11 in their last 13 road games; their two road wins in that span are a 4-0 victory on August 12 at Los Angeles-AL and a 5-1 victory on Sunday afternoon at Chicago-AL.

SAME OLD EMPIRE STATE OF MIND: The Twins lost to the Yankees Monday afternoon by a score of 5-2...Chris Archer was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to allow three runs in 3.0 innings of relief as Trevor Megill (3-2) was dealt the loss, allowing a two-run sixth inning that broke a 2-2 tie...the offense recorded six hits and was led by Gary Sánchez, who went 1-for-4 with a home run and two RBI...the 473-foot homer by Sánchez was the fourth-longest homer at Yankee Stadium in the Statcast era (since 2015) and longest hit there since Gary himself hit one 481 feet on June 21, 2019, off Houston's Brad Peacock.

EVERYDAY A STAR IS BORN: Louie Varland, 24, has made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, going 1-1, 1.69 ERA (21.1 IP, 4 ER), three walks, 27 strikeouts, one home run allowed and a .192 BAA...he began the season with Double-A Wichita and appeared in 20 games (19 starts), going 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER), 39 walks and 119 strikeouts, earning a promotion to the Saints on August 8...Varland has been named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week on four separate occasions this season (June 12, July 3, August 14 and August 28)...he is the Twins minor league leader in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1)...the St. Paul, Minnesota native was named the Jim Rantz Award winner in 2021 as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year, after going 10-4, 2.10 ERA (103.0 IP, 24 ER), 30 walks, 142 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids...he was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul, Minnesota.

(ALMOST) 99 PROBLEMS: Since 2002, the Twins have gone 37-96 against the Yankees in regular season play...today, these two teams are playing the fifth and sixth of seven meetings in 2022 today...the Twins are 1-3 against New York this season, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 7-9 and 0-1 at Yankee Stadium...they have been outscored by the Yankees 26-21 this season. Since the start of 2017, they are 1-14 in regular season games at Yankee Stadium...their only win came on May 4, 2019 by a final score of 7-3 (Dorizzi over Happ).

ALREADY HOME: Gary Sánchez hit his 75th career home run at Yankee Stadium on Monday (leaders to the right)...he has six home runs in his last 13 games at Yankee Stadium...Carlos Correa is hitting .313 (40-for-128) with seven doubles, nine home runs, 26 RBI, 16 walks, a .386 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a .964 OPS in 34 career regular season games against the Yankees.

ENCORE?: The last time the Twins faced Gerrit Cole was on June 9 at Target Field, as they led the game off with three-straight homers from Luis Arraez (5th pitch), Byron Buxton (first pitch) and Carlos Correa (third pitch) in Cole's first eight pitches...Cole went on to allow two more home runs, another to Buxton in the second inning and one to Trevor Larnach in the third inning. With three-straight homers to start the game, the Twins became the seventh team to do so since 1900 (also San Diego on April 13, 1987, Atlanta on May 23, 2003, Milwaukee on September 9, 2007, Baltimore on May 10, 2012 and Arizona on July 21, 2017 and June 10, 2019)...they were the second team since 1900 to lead off the game with three-straight home runs and lose (also the Padres in 1987).

HARD KNOCKS LIFE: Since the All-Star Break, Jose Miranda is hitting .302 (45-for-149) with six doubles, five home runs, 26 RBI, a .364 on-base percentage, a .443 slugging percentage and an .807 OPS in 39 games. Miranda has a team-leading 58 RBI on the season despite not joining the Twins until May 2 and playing in only 96 games this season...the last Twins rookie to lead the club in RBI by the end of a season was Kent Hrbek with 92 in 1982. Miranda is the cousin of actor, playwright and filmmaker Lin-Manuel Miranda...the two met for dinner last night, along with other members of the family.

KINGDOM COME: Carlos Correa is hitting .299 (23-for-77) with 16 walks, 10 RBI, a .411 on-base percentage and an .878 OPS in his last 22 games...in his last 10 games, he is slashing .333/.442/.556 with 12 hits and seven walks...on the season, he is slashing .244/.333/.403 in 53 road games, compared to .295/.372/.462 in 56 home games. Correa needs one home run to reach 150 for his career...he has eight home runs on the road this season and eight at home.

DIRT OFF YOUR SHOULDER: Nick Gordon has hit safely in 21 of his last 33 games...in that span, he is hitting .311 (32-for-103) with 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs, 22 RBI, eight walks, a .354 on-base percentage, a .515 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS.

THE B-LUE-PRINT: Luis Arraez enters today with a team-leading 120 games played, one short of his career-high of 121, done last season... additionally, he enters today with a .314 batting average, trailing Boston's Xander Bogaerts (.315) in the AL batting race.

TAKEOVER: Right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober made a rehab start for Low-A Fort Myers last night against St. Lucie, pitching a 0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and three strikeouts, throwing 42 pitches...Ober was placed on the 10-day IL on June 6 with a right groin strain.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 278-240 for a winning percentage of .538, the third-highest winning percentage for an AL manager since 1919, trailing Tampa Bay's Kevin Cash (.602 - 312-206) and New York-AL's Aaron Boone (.595 - 309-210).

WATCH THE THRONE: Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Kala'i Rosario was recently named Florida State League Player of the Week...Rosario hit .440 (11-for-25) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, eight runs scored, a .462 OBP, a .720 SLG and a 1.182 OPS in six games for the Mighty Mussels...the Papaikou, HI native was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Waiakea (HI) High School.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the 5-1 loss in his last start on August 31 vs. Omaha at CHS Field...tossed 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with no walks and three strikeouts...exited the game after getting hit by a line drive off the bat of Clay Dungan in the fifth inning...was able to pick up the ball to record the out, but then departed the game...St. Paul's lone run came in the sixth inning on Matt Wallner's RBI double.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the 2-1 Saints lost at Iowa on August 25...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing three hits with one walk and striking out nine...the Saints took a 1-0 lead in the second inning on David Bañuelos' RBI single, but the Cubs tied the game on a sacrifice fly in the seventh...the Cubs won on a walk-off homer to lead off the ninth inning.

MINNESOTA MADE: Varland was born and raised in St. Paul, Minnesota and attended North St. Paul High School, where he was an All-Metro East Conference performer and letterwinner in three sports (baseball, wrestling and football)...continued his academic and athletic career at Division II Concordia University in St. Paul, Minnesota where his 1.41 ERA as a sophomore in 2018 was second best in school history and fourth best in the nation by a DII pitcher...was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft.

- ☞ Today will be the eighth Minnesota-born player to make a start for the Twins, the first since Cole De Vries (St. Louis Park, MN) made two starts in 2013.
- ☞ Varland and Caleb Thielbar (Northfield, MN) become the first Minnesota-born Twins teammates since Glen Perkins (St. Paul, MN) and Joe Mauer (St. Paul, MN) in 2017.

DOUBLEHEADER DEBUT: Will become the third player in Twins history (1961-present) to make his major league debut as the starting pitcher in the first game of a doubleheader today, joining Charlie Barnes (July 17, 2021 at Detroit; L, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 1 HR, 1 K) and Bert Cueto (June 18, 1961 at Chicago-AL; ND, 8.1 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 3 K).

- ☞ Varland, along with Joe Ryan starting game two of today's doubleheader, will be the first two rookies to start both games of a doubleheader for the Twins since September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland (Ryan in Game 1 and Charlie Barnes in Game 2)...the last time two rookies started both games of a doubleheader for the Twins on the road was September 14, 2019 at Cleveland (Devin Smeltzer in Game 1 and Lewis Thorpe in Game 2).

SAINTS SUMMARY: Made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season after his promotion on August 8, going 1-1, 1.69 ERA (21.1 IP, 4 ER) with one home run, three walks and 27 strikeouts...made his Triple-A debut on August 12 vs. Colorado, earning the 5-1 victory (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R/ER, 2 BB, 8 K)...Varland became the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became the Twins' Triple-A affiliate in 2020.

SO FAR IN 2022: Has posted an 8-5 record, 3.06 ERA (126.1 IP, 43 ER) with 42 walks and 146 strikeouts in 24 games (23 starts) between Wichita and St. Paul this season...the Wind Surge were 14-6 in games which Varland pitched and the Saints were 2-2.

- ☞ Enters today tops among all Twins minor league pitchers in strikeouts, innings pitched and games started.
- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight starts from May 18-present, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams have gone 12-6.
- ☞ Entered the season ranked as the No. 27 prospect in the Twins organization, per MLB.com...is currently ranked as the No. 10 prospect.

BREAKING OUT IN 2021: Varland was named the Jim Rantz Award winner in 2021 as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year, after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERA (103.0 IP, 24 ER), 30 walks, 142 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids.

- ☞ Led all Twins minor leaguers in ERA, strikeouts and WHIP.
- ☞ Was named the starting pitcher on the Twins' MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.

MECHANICAL WORK: During the COVID-19 pandemic and 2020 cancelled minor league season, Varland worked on refining his mechanics to become more efficient with his delivery...changing his arm action to reduce joint stress led to increased velocity and movement on his fastball...entered professional baseball at a maximum of 92 MPH put averaged 94 MPH in 2021 and maxed out at 98 MPH.

NEW FACES: Varland becomes the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and the fifth pitcher...the others are: Joao Duran (April 8), Josh Winder (April 12), Cole Sands (May 1), Jose Miranda (May 2), Royce Lewis (May 6), Yennier Cano (May 11), Mark Contreras (May 11), Jermaine Palacios (May 31) and Caleb Hamilton (July 17).

- ☞ In 2021, nine players made their major league debuts for the Twins, including five pitchers.

- Began the 2022 season with Double-A Wichita...fanned 10 batters on April 14, 2022 at Northwest Arkansas, his fifth career 10-plus strikeout game.
- Has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight starts from May 18-present, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams have gone 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 -- was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- In 2021, combined to go 10-4, 2.10 ERA (103.0 IP, 24 ER) with 30 walks, 142 strikeouts, a .214 opponent batting average and a 1.09 WHIP in 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids...held right-handed batters to a .225 (34-for-151) average and left-handed batters to a .250 (28-for-112) average.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan was saddled with his seventh loss of the season in his last start on August 31 vs. Boston at Target Field...allowed five earned runs – matching his second-highest total of the season for the second time – on eight hits (2 home runs), with one walk, one hit batter and eight strikeouts...marked his fourth start this season with at least eight strikeouts (season high is nine, done twice), as well as his sixth with at least 100 pitches thrown...paired with his outing on August 26 vs. San Francisco, threw at least 100 pitches in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career (also, June 21-26); also in conjunction with that August 26 start (8 K), fanned at least eight batters in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.

DOUBLEHEADER HISTORY: Tonight will mark Ryan's second career start in a major league doubleheader and first in the second game...did not factor into the decision of a 3-1 Twins loss in the first game of the doubleheader on September 14, 2021 vs. Cleveland (5.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K)...that day also marked the last time prior to today (Louie Varland in Game 1, Ryan in Game 2) that the Twins had two rookies start both games of a doubleheader (Ryan in Game 1, Charlie Barnes in Game 2)...last time this occurred for the Twins on the road was September 14, 2019 at Cleveland (Devlin Smeltzer in Game 1, Lewis Thorpe in Game 2).

NEW YORK CITY TOURIST: Ryan is due to face New York-AL for the first time in his career tonight...also will mark his fifth start of the season/his career against the American League East division, going 1-1, 3.57 ERA (22.2 IP, 9 ER) with three walks, 25 strikeouts and a 1.06 WHIP in his four prior starts...this includes 1-0, 2.53 ERA (10.2 IP, 3 ER) with one walk, 10 strikeouts and a 1.13 WHIP in two road starts against the AL East.

☞ Ryan is 5-5, 4.92 ERA (71.1 IP, 39 ER) in 14 prior starts when facing an opponent for the first time...earned the win in his last start against a first-time opponent on August 26 vs. San Francisco (6.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 8 K).

NIGHTTIME EXPERIENCE: Is starting under the lights for the 14th time this season...has a 5-5 record, 4.84 ERA (70.2 IP, 38 ER) with 22 walks and 78 strikeouts in his 13 prior night starts, compared to 5-2, 2.45 ERA (47.2 IP, 13 ER) with 13 walks and 43 strikeouts in nine day games...is also 2-3, 6.82 ERA (30.1 IP, 23 ER) with eight walks and 30 strikeouts in six night road starts this season.

MAKING THE LORAX PROUD: In partnership with Players for the Planet, Ryan is having 50 trees planted for each strikeout he records during the 2022 season; he's fanned 121 batters so far, which will lead to 6,050 new trees planted.
