THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-4 through five games in their seven-game roadtrip, going 1-2 at Chicago-AL and 0-3 at New York-AL...tonight, they will wrap up the trip with the fourgame series finale at Yankee Stadium...after tonight's game, Minnesota will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand, with three against the Guardians this weekend, an off-day on Monday, then three against the Royals from September 13-15...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 28-38 on the road...the Twins are 2-13 in their last 15 road game; their two road wins in that span are a 4-0 victory on August 12 at Los Angeles-AL and a 5-1 victory on Sunday afternoon at Chicago-AL.

The Twins are looking to avoid falling to .500 tonight for the first time since being 8-8 through their game on April 24.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE IN THE BRONX:** The Twins lost both games of their doubleheader with the Yankees in the Bronx yesterday, dropping game one by a score of 5-4 in 12 innings and game two by a score of 7-1...Louie Varland made his major league debut in a game one start, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts... Jose Miranda hit his 14th home run in game one and drove in two runs as Minnesota fell to 5-9 in extra innings this season...Joe Ryan (10-8) was the game two starter and loser, allowing four runs on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched, including a fourth inning grand slam to Isiah Kiner-Falefa — Ryan's second straight start allowing a grand slam (Bogaerts - August 31 vs. Boston)...Carlos Correa drove in the only run for the Twins in game two, hitting his 17th home run of the season and 150th of his career — the 22nd Puerto Rican born player in AL/NL history to reach the mark...it marked the first doubleheader sweep for the Twins since July 17, 2021 at Detroit and fourth time in their last two seasons getting swept (9 total doubleheaders).

SANDS TIME: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Cole Sands from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Sands missed the Twins' last 14 games with a right elbow contusion, an injury he suffered on August 23 at Houston on a line drive off the bat of Yuli Gurriel...Sands made two appearances for Triple-A St. Paul on his rehab assignment, allowing three runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins have designated left-handed pitcher Austin Davis for release or assignment...Davis, who was claimed off waivers from Boston on August 31, appeared in two games for the Twins, allowing three runs on one hit in 1.2 innings pitched, with four walks and three strikeouts...additionally, the Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Louie Varland to Triple-A St. Paul.

TWINS-YANKEES These two teams are playing the seventh and final time in 2022 tonight...the Twins are 1-5 against New York this season, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 7-9 and 0-3 this week at Yankee Stadium...they have been outscored by the Yankees 26-38 this season... since 2002, the Twins have gone 37-98 against the Yankees in regular season play...since the start of 2017, they are 1-16 in regular season games at Yankee Stadium...their only win came on May 4, 2019 by a final score of 7-3 (Odorizzi over Happ).

♣ Gary Sánchez hit his 75th career home run at Yankee Stadium on Monday, which ranks fifth all-time in his ballpark, trailing Aaron Judge (114), Mark Teixeira (113), Robinson Canó (82) and Brett Gardner (78)...he has six home runs in his last 15 games at Yankee Stadium.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .312 (43-for-139) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 16 walks, a .381 on-base percentage, a .587 slugging percentage and a .968 OPS in 35 career regular season games against the Yankees.

MIRANDA WATCH: With two more RBI yesterday, Miranda now has a team-leading 60 RBI on the season despite not joining the Twins until May 2 and playing in just 98 games this season... since July 1, Miranda has 40 RBI, tied for fifth-most in the AL since that date.

4 Since the All-Star Break, Jose Miranda is hitting .299 (47-for-157) with six doubles, six home runs, 28 RBI, a .366 on-base percentage, a .452 slugging percentage and an .818 OPS in 41 games.

LEFT TURNS: The Twins have slashed .286/.357/.490 in their last eight games vs. left-handed pitching, compared to .240/.321/.376 vs. righties.

◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with five walks and a 1.078 OPS in his last 14 games vs. left-handed pitching.

◆ Kyle Garlick is slashing .277/.342/.569 with six homers vs. lefties, compared to .222/.268/.397 with three homers vs. righties.

◆ Nestor Cortes set a new season-high in runs allowed in his start on June 8 at Target Field with four...he allowed home runs to Byron Buxton and Ryan Jeffers...Jose Miranda had his first career three-hit game that night.

CLEMENTE AWARD: Major League Baseball today announced that centerfielder Byron Buxton was named the Twins' 2022 nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award...the Roberto Clemente Award is the annual recognition of a Major League player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field...as part of the annual program, each MLB Club nominates one player to be considered for the league-wide Award in tribute to Clemente's achievements and character...this is Buxton's first time being nominated for the Roberto Clemente Award in his eight-year major league career...four past Twins nominees have been named winner of the award – Rod Carew (1977), Dave Winfield (1994), Kirby Puckett (1996) and Nelson Cruz (2021).

**OHL MY!:** Low-A Fort Myers Mighty Mussels right-hander Pierson Ohl has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Month for August...Ohl went 2-1 with a 1.33 ERA in five games (4 starts) as he allowed just four earned runs over 27.0 innings...Ohl struck out 26 while walking just one batter and did not allow an earned run in his first 21.0 innings of the month...Ohl, 22, was selected by Minnesota in the 14th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Grand Canyon University in Phoenix.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision as the Twins fell to the White Sox, 4-3, on September 2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...tossed 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and two strikeouts...grabbed his hamstring in the bottom of the third inning but came back out for the fourth before being removed from the game...allowed just two base runners (two singles) in his first three innings before giving up two runs on three hits and one walk in the fourth...the White Sox earned a walk-off win on José Abreu's walk-off RBI groundout in the bottom of the ninth inning.

© Of Gray's 101 strikeouts this season, 48 (47.5%) have been on called third strikes.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 3-2 victory on August 27 vs. San Francisco...allowed one run on one hit, with four walks and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...the Twins scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning on two-out, RBI singles from Carlos Correa and Jake Cave to tie the game, before earning a walk-off win on a Gilberto Celestino bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the 10th.

walk in the bottom of the 10th BACK IN THE NEW YORK GROOVE: Gray will be starting against New York-AL for the sixth time in his career, his first since June 15, 2017 (ND, 5.1 IP, 8 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 6 K) with Oakland...has one career win against the Yankees, earning the victory (8.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 2 BB, 5 K) on May 29, 2015 at the Oakland Coliseum...is a career 1-2, 4.55 ERA (29.2 IP, 15 ER) with 13 walks and 26 strikeouts in five starts against New York-AL.

▼ Was lined up to face the Yankees during their series at Target Field but was placed on the 15-day IL with a right pectoral strain just prior to the series.

▼ Was a member of the Yankees from 2017-18 after being traded at the July 31 deadline in 2017 from Oakland to New York-AL, along with international signing bonus slot money, in exchange for outfielder Dustin Fowler and minor leaguers right-handed pitcher James Kaprielian and shortstop Jorge Mateo.

▼ Went 15-16, 4.51 ERA (195.2 IP, 98 ER) with 84 walks and 182 strikeouts in 41 games (34 starts) for New York-AL.

▼ His 11 wins for the Yankees in 2018 ranked third on New York-AL's staff (Luis Severino - 19, Masahiro Tanaka - 12).

Faced the Twins twice as a member of the Yankees' staff, on April 25, 2018 at Yankee Stadium (ND, 4.2 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 5 BB, 4 K) and September 11, 2018 at Target Field (L, 3.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/2 ER, 3 BB, 2 K).

SHINING POST ALL-STAR BREAK: After yielding 14 runs combined in 13.1 innings in his three starts from July 2-14 (9.45 ERA), has a 2.16 ERA (41.2 IP, 10 ER) in his eight starts after the All-Star Break, since July 24...his ERA after the All-Star Break is fifth lowest in the American League and 11th in the majors (min. 35.0 IP)...Gray is 3-1 in that span, while the Twins are 4-4.

**SONNY SIDE OF SUCCESS:** Gray's strikeout-to-walk ratio of 3.06 is his fourth-highest single-season mark and his current 2.84 walks-per-9.0 innings is the fourth-lowest mark in a single season in his career...has allowed just nine home runs through his first 21 starts (104.2 IP) of the season...is tied for the second-fewest home runs surrendered by an American League starter this year (min. 21 GS), trailing Los Angeles-AL's Patrick Sandoval (7 HR in 23 GS/127.0 IP)...is tied for fifth-fewest home runs by a pitcher in the major leagues this season under the same parameters.

IN A NEW TURN STATE OF MIND: Scheduled to make his second-straight road start, after not factoring into the decision on September 2 at Chicago-AL...will be his 10th start on the road season, producing a 4-2 record, 3.27 ERA (44.0 IP, 16 ER) in his previous nine efforts (Twins are 5-4)...numbers are skewed by a five-run outing on July 8 at Texas (L, 4.2 IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 0 K)...has allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in all his other road starts this season...if his July 8 start is excluded, his ERA on the road drops to 2.52 (39.1 IP, 11 ER)...by comparison is 3-2, 2.97 ERA (60.2 IP, 20 ER) in 12 starts at Target Field this year. IN A NEW YORK STATE OF MIND: Scheduled to make his second-straight road start, after not factoring

Gray is averaging 17.9 seconds between pitches with the bases empty this season, faster than the league average (18.1 seconds), but fifth slowest among Twins qualified pitchers...averages 25.0 seconds between pitches with runners on, fourth slowest on the Twins, and slower than the league average (23.3 seconds).
