- Making his team-leading 25th start of the season...also his 158th career start and 186th appearance. Facing Cleveland for the second time this season after starting at Progressive Field on June 29 (ND, 5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/2 ER, 1 BB, 1 K)...is a career 4-1, 2.96 ERA (27.1 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks and 24 strikeouts in six games (5 starts) against the Guardians. Signed with the Twins as a free agent on December 1, 2021...was previously with Los Angeles-AL (2020-21) and Baltimore (2012-19).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his last start on September 4 at Chicago-AL...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with one walk and four strikeouts...improved to 7-0, 3.15 ERA (54.1 IP, 19 ER) in 10 games (9 starts) against the White Sox...Minnesota won 5-1, highlighted by Carlos Correa's two-run home run in the fifth inning and Jose Miranda's two-RBI double in the top of the ninth.

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy did not factor into the decision on August 29 vs. Boston, a 4-2 Twins win...allowed two runs on nine hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...departed with the Twins down 2-1; Minnesota scored thrice in the bottom of the fifth inning to take the lead for good...marked Bundy's first career start in which he allowed at least nine hits but only two runs.

HOT STREAK: Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 12 of his last 14 starts, dating back to June 18; is 5-3, 3.36 ERA (72.1 IP, 27 ER) with 15 walks and 47 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 8-6)...has also yielded two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last six starts, since August 6; is 2-1, 2.17 ERA (29.0 IP, 7 ER) with six walks and 16 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 4-2)...six games with two-or-fewer earned runs marks the longest such streak of his career, as a starter.

STAYING IN THE ZONE: Bundy threw 47 of his 66 pitches for strikes in his last start on September 4, good for a 71.2 strike percentage...has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in 14 of his 24 starts this season...ranks second in MLB (min. 100.0 IP) with a 69.48 strike percentage this season, trailing only Toronto's Kevin Gausman (69.83).

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 25 batters in 118.1 innings, including five starts with no walks allowed and 13 starts with one walk...this equates to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.90 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (32.5%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.5%).

- His 5.0 walk percentage is 10th in the American League (min. 100.0 IP), while his 1.90 walks-per-9.0 IP is 12th under those same parameters. Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 90th percentile in baseball this season and his chase rate ranks in the 89th percentile.

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Will be making his second start against Cleveland this season after not factoring into the decision of a 7-6 Twins loss on June 29 at Progressive Field (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/2 ER, 1 BB, 1 K)...is a career 4-1, 2.96 ERA (27.1 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks and 24 strikeouts in six games (5 starts) against the Guardians...those numbers are skewed by his June 19, 2017 start, allowing six earned runs over 4.1 innings; if that start is omitted, Bundy's career ERA against Cleveland falls to 1.17 (23.0 IP, 3 ER).

- Has allowed one-or-fewer runs in four of his six games against the Guardians, including two starts with no earned runs. His career 2.96 ERA against Cleveland is his second lowest against any team he has faced (min. 5 GS), trailing his 2.44 ERA mark against Seattle.

HOME SWEET HOME: Bundy has pitched well at Target Field so far this season, going 4-1, 2.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 14 ER) with nine walks, 29 strikeouts and a .231 (40-for-173) opponent batting average in his nine home starts (Twins are 6-3)...however, just nine of his 24 starts this season have come at home...this compares to his 4-5, 5.28 ERA (73.1 IP, 43 ER), 16 walks, 55 strikeouts and a .273 (79-for-289) opponent batting average he's posted in 15 road starts.

- The Twins have won each of Bundy's last four home starts, dating back to July 16...he is 2-0, 3.72 ERA (19.1 IP, 8 ER) with four walks and 14 strikeouts in that span. Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in seven of his nine home starts this season...the two exceptions are June 9 vs. New York-AL (4 ER) and July 16 vs. Chicago-AL (3 ER)...if you remove those two home starts, Bundy has a 1.77 ERA (35.2 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 25 strikeouts at home this season.

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.3 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth-fastest worker among qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds, Joe Ryan - 21.7 seconds and Tyler Duffey - 22.1 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.3 seconds with runners on base.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 24 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...40 of his 84 strikeouts this season (47.6 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2021, spent second season with Los Angeles-AL and was the club's Opening Day starter on April 1 vs Chicago-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts. In 2020, spent first season with Los Angeles-NL, finished ninth in American League Cy Young voting, receiving a third place vote and two fifth place votes. Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhardt Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season. Tossed third career complete game August 6, 2020 at Seattle, allowing one earned run on four hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts; marked first complete game for an Angels pitcher since Andrew Heaney, June 5, 2018 vs. Kansas City. Ranked among 2020 AL leaders with six wins (T-4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51-for-245) opponent batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T-9th). Threw first career complete game on August 29, 2020 vs. Seattle, throwing a one-hit shutout with 12 strikeouts, only hit allowed was bunt single by Kyle Seager in fourth inning and was first Orioles individual one-hitter since Jason Hammel June 16, 2012 at Atlanta. Became 17th Orioles pitcher to record 10 wins in rookie season and first since Wei-Yin Chen (12 wins in 2012). Named Orioles top prospect according to Baseball America and Baseball Prospectus following the 2014 season. Underwent Tommy John surgery on right elbow June 27 2013, performed by Dr. James Andrews. Named Carolina League 2012 Midseason All-Star and Baseball America Minor League All-Star. Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April, 2012 (30 consecutive scoreless IP) and named Orioles top prospect by Baseball America following the season. Originally selected by Baltimore in the first round (4th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

WELL SUPPORTED: The Twins have scored 81 runs in support of Bundy in his 24 starts this season, including 45 cumulative runs of support across his last 14 starts, since June 18 (5.60 RSA in span)...however, has received a combined eight runs of support in his last five starts... he has a 6.16 run support average this season, good for sixth in baseball (min. 100.0 IP), trailing only Atlanta's Ian Anderson (7.82 RSA), Houston's Jose Urquidy (6.72), Cleveland's Cal Quantrill (6.51), New York-AL's Jameson Taillon (6.30) and Atlanta's Kyle Wright (6.18).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP CHRIS ARCHER (2022 SEASON: 2-7, 4.47 ERA // CAREER: 63-88, 3.92 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Archer is due to start the middle game of the series tomorrow night at Target Field...did not factor into the decision in his last start on September 5 at New York-AL, allowing two runs on four hits, with two walks and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched...is due to face the Guardians for the second time this season after not factoring into the decision of a 5-3 Twins loss on June 30 at Progressive Field (4.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R/ER, 6 BB, 2 K)...has never defeated Cleveland in his career, going 0-7, 5.53 ERA (42.1 IP, 26 ER) with 28 walks and 39 strikeouts in his eight prior starts (his teams are 0-8 in those games).
