as core of 4-5, avoiding the four-gainer sweep....the will shapped an eight-gainer losing stream at Yankee Stadium as they won there for the first time since May 4, 2019...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision against his former team, allowing two runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...Michael Fulmer earned his first save as a Twin with 0.2 innings pitched, the first save for a Twin in Yankee Stadium since Glen Perkins on July 13, 2013...Carlos Correa hit the go-ahead two-run homer in the top of the eighth inning...it marked the second time this season (also June 28-G1 at Cleveland) he has homered to put his team into the lead in the eight inning-or-later.

The Twins struck out 43 times over the four games in New York.

HOW IT STARTED vs. HOW IT'S GOING: Two weeks ago the Twins began a four-game series against Texas on August 19...they went 1-3 against the Rangers, finishing the series 2.0 games back of the Guardians...since then, they have gone 0-3 at Houston (August 23-25), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (August 26-28), 2-1 vs. Boston (August 29-31), 1-2 at Chicago-AL (September 2-4) and 1-3 at New York-AL (September 5-8), compiling a record of 7-9 and still gained a half game in that span...below is a look at the standings entering today:

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the 12th of 19 meetings in 2022...the Twins have gone 5-6 against the Guards this season, going 3-3 at Target Field and 2-3 at Progressive Field...their last series was in five games in Cleveland as the Twins went 2-3... their last series at Target Field came June 21-23 as the Twins went 2-1.

▼ The Twins have outscored Cleveland 61-45 this season.

▼ Since the start of 2020, 31 of the 40 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and 21 have been decided by two runs-or-less...six of the 10 games this season have been decided by one run...since the start of last season, eight of the 30 games between these two have gone into extra innings.

▼ Notables this season vs. the Guardians: Carlos Correa is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, five walks, a .469 on-base percentage, an .852 slugging percentage and a 1.321 OPS in eight games...Gio Urshela is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, nine RBI, a .721 slugging percentage and a 1.047 OPS in 11 games...Nick Gordon is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with one double, two home runs and three RBI in 10 games.

MORE ON MIRANDA: Jose Miranda has a team-leading 60 RBI on the season despite not joining the Twins until May 2 and playing in just 99 games this season...since July 1, Miranda has 40 RBI, tied for fifth-most in the AL since that date.

DEALIN' BUNDY: Dylan Bundy has allowed two runs-or-fewer in six straight starts, going 2-1, 2.17 ERA (29.0 IP, 7 ER) that ranks fifth in the American League since August 6 (minimum 6 starts)...in five career starts against Cleveland, he's 3-1, 3.12 ERA (27.1 IP, 9 ER), his second lowest against any AL opponent.

C4: Carlos Correa has hit safely in five-straight games, hitting .318 (7-for-22) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, a .348 on-base percentage, an .818 slugging percentage and a 1.166 OPS in this span...in his last 13 games, he is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a .404 on-base percentage, a .620 slugging percentage and a 1.024 OPS.

ALREADY HOME: Since August 1, the Twins have posted a record at Target Field of 13-7, including winning five of their last six in Minnesota...in those 20 games, they have outscored opponents 92-63, while their 13 wins are second-most in the AL, trailing only Tampa Bay (15-4)...on the season, they have gone 40-29 at home, tied with Baltimore for the fourth-most home wins in 2022, trailing New York-AL (48-21), Tampa Bay (47-24) and Houston (45-21).

The Twins have 497 wins at Target Field in 989 games (since 2010).

HBD, BILLY HAMILTON: Twins outfielder Billy Hamilton is celebrating his 32nd birthday today...he has appeared in five career games on his birthday, going 3-for-16 with two walks and one stolen base...he shares a birthday with actors Adam Sandler, Eric Stonestreet and Hugh Grant, singer Michael Bublé and former Vikings punter Greg Coleman, who was on Twins Hall of Famer Dan Gladden's fantasy football team in 2019.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Rod Carew hit a pinch-hit grand slam in the seventh for the Twins as Minnesota beat Texas, 6-0...it marked Carew's third grand slam of that year...it was the eighth pinch-hit grand slam in Twins history and one of 13 to date... the last to do it was Matt LeCroy on May 19, 2004 at Toronto.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win in his last start on September 4 at Chicago-AL...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with one walk and four strikeouts...improved to 7-0, 3.15 ERA (54.1 IP, 19 ER) in 10 games (9 starts) against the White Sox...Minnesota won 5-1, highlighted by Carlos Correa's two-run home run in the fifth inning and Jose Miranda's two-RBI double in the top of the ninth.

TWO STARTS AGO: Bundy did not factor into the decision on August 29 vs. Boston, a 4-2 Twins win... allowed two runs on nine hits, with one walk and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...departed with the Twins down 2-1; Minnesota scored thrice in the bottom of the fifth inning to take the lead for good...marked Bundy's first career start in which he allowed at least nine hits but only two runs.

HOT STREAK: Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 12 of his last 14 starts, dating back to June 18; is 5-3, 3.36 ERA (72.1 IP, 27 ER) with 15 walks and 47 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 8-6)...has also yielded two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his last six starts, since August 6; is 2-1, 2.17 ERA (29.0 IP, 7 ER) with six walks and 16 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 4-2)...six games with two-or-fewer earned runs marks the longest such streak of his career, as a starter.

STAYING IN THE ZONE: Bundy threw 47 of his 66 pitches for strikes in his last start on September 4, good for a 71.2 strike percentage...has posted a strike percentage of over 70 percent in 14 of his 24 starts this season...ranks second in MLB (min. 100.0 IP) with a 69.48 strike percentage this season, trailing only Toronto's Kevin Gausman (69.83).

WALKING IN STYLE: Has walked just 25 batters in 118.1 innings, including five starts with no walks allowed and 13 starts with one walk...this equates to a career-low 5.0 walk percentage and a 1.90 walks-per-9.0 innings...also has a career-high first-pitch swing percentage (32.5%) and first-pitch strike percentage (67.5%).

This 5.0 walk percentage is 10th in the American League (min. 100.0 IP), while his 1.90 walks-per-9.0 IP is 12th under those same parameters.

Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 90th percentile in baseball this season and his character tasks in the 90th percentile.

HOME SWEET HOME: Bundy has pitched well at Target Field so far this season, going 4-1, 2.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 14 ER) with nine walks, 29 strikeouts and a .231 (40-for-173) opponent batting average in his nine home starts (Twins are 6-3)...however, just nine of his 24 starts this season have come at home...this compares to his 4-5, 5.28 ERA (73.1 IP, 43 ER), 16 walks, 55 strikeouts and a .273 (79-for-289) opponent batting average he's posted in 15 road starts.

© The Twins have won each of Bundy's last four home starts, dating back to July 16...he is 2-0, 3.72 ERA (19.1 IP, 8 ER) with four walks and 14 strikeouts in that span.

© Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in seven of his nine home starts this season...the two exceptions are June 9 vs. New York-AL (4 ER) and July 16 vs. Chicago-AL (3 ER)...if you remove those two home starts, Bundy has a 1.77 ERA (35.2 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 25 strikeouts at home this season.

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.1 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.3 seconds when there are runners on base, the fourth-fastest worker among qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds, Joe Ryan - 21.7 seconds and Tyler Duffey - 22.1 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.3 seconds with runners on base.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 24 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...40 of his 84 strikeouts this season (47.6 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch... below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.
