THE TWINS: After completing their final homestand of the season with a record of 3-3 (1-2 vs. the Angels and 2-1 vs. the White Sox), the Twins began their final roadtrip of 2022 with a win over the Tigers last night...tonight, they will play the second of three games against the Tigers at Comerica Park...after tomorrow's series finale in Detroit, they will travel to Chicago to play the White Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday and complete the regular season schedule.
 ☞ The Twins have gone 46-35 at home, compared to 31-45 on the road...they have gone 2-7 in their last nine road games and 4-17 in their last 21 away from Target Field.
 ☞ The Twins need to win all five remaining games to finish the season over .500.

RYAN WRAPS UP ROOKIE SEASON WITH DOMINANCE: The Twins shut out the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 7-0...Joe Ryan (13-8) made his final start of the season, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with five hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts...Ryan set a Twins rookie record for strikeouts in a season (since 1961), fanning Spencer Torkelson in the second inning with his 145th strikeout of the season, passing Francisco Liriano's 2006 total of 144; he finished with 151 on the season...the offense recorded 14 hits, including five players with multiple hits, highlighted by Jermaine Palacios, who snapped an 0-for-34 and finished the night with three singles.

SUPER-ZEROS: Last night's shutout marked the 17th of the season for the Twins' staff...below are where the 17 shutouts rank among all MLB teams and where it ranks in club history (since 1961):

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 18th of 19 meetings in 2022...Twins are 11-6 against Detroit this season, going 7-2 at Target Field and 4-4 at Comerica Park.
 ☞ 11 wins over the Tigers are their most since going 14-5 in 2019...their season-high for wins over Detroit in a season is 15, done in 2001 and 2003.
 ☞ Twins most wins vs. any opponent this season: KC — 12, DET — 11, CWS — 9 and CLE — 6.
 ☞ Gio Urshela is a career .323 (42-for-130) hitter with an .833 OPS in 41 games against the Tigers...he is hitting .373 (22-for-59) with three doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, 10 runs scored and a .935 OPS in 16 games vs. the Tigers this season.
 ☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with a .400 OBP in 11 games vs. the Tigers this season.
 ☞ Twins pitchers have struck out 159 Tigers this season, tied with Kansas City for their most vs. any opponent in 2022.
 ☞ Twins pitchers have posted a 2.62 ERA (151.0 IP, 44 ER) against Detroit this season with Tiger batters hitting .207 (115-for-556) and a .570 OPS.

ALL ARRAEZ: Luis Arraez has hit safely in six straight, going 9-for-26 (.346) in that span...on the season, he is now hitting .31471, just ahead of Aaron Judge (.31408) in the American League batting race...below are the top three hitters for average in the American League:

SEPTIMIO TO REMEMBER: Carlos Correa has reached safely in 17-straight games, hitting .348 (24-for-69) with a .416 on-base percentage and a .966 OPS in that span...17 is tied for the third-longest streak of his career, with his career-high being 27 in 2017 with Houston... additionally, in 27 September games, Correa hit .345 (38-for-110) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .405 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.005 OPS... more info on Correa's September to the lower right.

☞ Among all MLB players this month (minimum 500 total pitches), Correa ranked second in average exit velocity at 90.5 mph, trailing Matt Chapman (91.3 mph)...additionally, he ranks first in xSLG (.504) and wOBA (.431).

UR ON FIRE: Gio Urshela has hit safely in six-straight games, going 13-for-24 (.542) in that span...his career-long is 13 (done in 2015, 2019 and 2020) and his season-long is seven, done twice (May 21-27 and June 1-9)...in fact, in his last 23 games, dating back to game two on September 7 at New York-AL, he is hitting .393 (33-for-84) with five doubles, one home run, eight RBI, 14 runs scored, nine walks and a .946 OPS.

SHOOTING FOR TWO: The Twins are 21-22-6 in series play this season, going 14-8-4 at home and 7-14-2 on the road...the Twins are 4-1 in series play against the tigers this season.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1989, Kirby Puckett and San Diego's Tony Gwynn each won batting titles on the final day of the regular season...Puckett went 2-for-5 to edge Carney Lansford, .339 to .336; Gwynn went 3-for-4 to beat Will Clark, .336 to .333...Puckett led the AL with 215 hits that season and earned the only batting title of his career...in 2002 at Oakland, the Twins played their first playoff game since Game 7 of the 1991 World Series...after falling behind 5-1 after two innings, the Twins rallied to score six runs between the third and seventh innings, highlighted by home runs from Corey Koskie and Doug Mientkiewicz in a 7-5 victory...the Twins went on to win the series 3-2 over the "Moneyball" A's...in 2006, the Twins clinched the AL Central on the final day of the regular season with a 5-1 victory over Chicago-AL...they finished with a record of 96-66, ahead of Detroit, who finished 95-67...the Twins went 71-33 from June 8 through the rest of the season...Joe Mauer went 2-for-4 on the day to finish with a .347 batting average, winning his first career batting title and outlasting Derek Jeter (.343) and Robinson Cano (.342).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO THE GOAT: Twins legend and Hall of Famer Rod Carew is celebrating his 77th birthday today...he shares a birthday with former Twins closer and 1987 World Series Champion Jeff Reardon (67), Orioles outfielder Cedric Mullins (28), Red Sox shortstop Xander Bogaerts (30), Mariners pitcher Robbie Ray (31), former All-Star Mark McGwire (59) and former Twin and teammate of Glen Perkins — outfielder Erik Komatsu (35).

LAST TIME OUT: Took the 10-3 loss in his last start on September 25 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field...allowed five runs (4 earned) on seven hits (1 home run), with a season-high-tying two walks and two strikeouts in just 3.1 innings of work...walked multiple batters for the seventh time this season and first since July 26 at Milwaukee, with 10 starts between...also marked his third-shortest outing of the season, behind only his 2.1 innings on June 4 at Toronto and his 3.0 innings on May 17 at Oakland...has completed 5.0 innings only once in his last five starts (5.0 IP on September 4 at Chicago-AL).

TWO STARTS AGO: Received a no-decision on September 20 at Kansas City as the Twins fell, 5-4...allowed four runs on four hits (2 home runs), with one walk and two strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...gave up a two-run home run to MJ Melendez in the third inning and a solo homer to Hunter Dozier in the fifth inning...marked his seventh start with two-or-more home runs this season.

BUMP IN THE ROAD: After going 2-2, 3.74 ERA with six walks and 17 strikeouts in seven starts from August 6-September 4, Bundy has gone 0-2, 9.18 ERA (16.2 IP, 17 ER) with three walks and seven strikeouts in his last four starts, since September 9.

☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 13 of his last 18 starts, dating back to June 18; is 5-5, 4.45 ERA (89.0 IP, 44 ER) with 18 walks and 54 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 9-9).

☞ Has also yielded two-or-fewer earned runs in seven of his last 10 starts, since August 6; is 2-3, 4.73 ERA (45.2 IP, 24 ER) with nine walks and 23 strikeouts in that span (Twins are 5-5).

☞ His 4.9 walk percentage is ninth in the American League (min. 125.0 IP) and is 13th in the majors, while his 1.87 walks-per-9.0 IP is 10th in the AL/17th in the majors under those same parameters.

☞ Additionally, his walk percentage ranks in the 90th percentile in baseball this season and his chase rate ranks in the 88th percentile.

VS. ☞ Detroit is one of three teams that Bundy has started against at least three times in his career and never defeated (also, 0-4 vs. Houston and 0-5 vs. Minnesota).

☞ Tonight is Bundy's 11th start and appearance of the season against the American League Central division; has gone 3-1, 4.29 ERA (50.1 IP, 24 ER) with six walks and 32 strikeouts in his 10 prior starts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Bundy has gone 4-5, 5.42 ERA (78.0 IP, 47 ER), 17 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .270 (83-for-307) opponent batting average in 16 road starts this season, compared to 4-3, 4.26 ERA (57.0 IP, 27 ER) with 11 walks, 34 strikeouts and a .273 (63-for-231) opponent batting average in 12 home starts.

☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in four of his last five road starts, dating back to July 31 at San Diego; is 1-2, 3.28 ERA (24.2 IP, 9 ER) with four walks, 10 strikeouts and a .172 (15-for-87) opponent batting average in that span (Twins are just 1-4 in those starts)...his road opponent batting average ranks fourth in the American League and seventh in the majors in that span (min. 75 opponent AB).

KEEP IT MOVING: Bundy is averaging 15.8 seconds between pitches with the bases empty, per Baseball Savant, the fastest worker with the bases empty among qualified Twins pitchers...works faster than the league average of 18.0 seconds...his pitch tempo falls to 22.3 seconds when there are runners on base, the fifth-fastest worker among qualified Twins pitchers this season (trails Trevor Megill - 20.0 seconds, Joe Ryan - 21.6 seconds, Devin Smeltzer - 21.6 seconds and Tyler Duffey - 22.1 seconds)...also works faster than the league average of 23.3 seconds with runners on base.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Bundy has used a five-pitch mix in his first 28 starts of this season, including a four-seam fastball, slider, changeup, sinker and curveball, according to Baseball Savant...42 of his 91 strikeouts this season (46.2 percent) have come on his slider, his second-most-used pitch...below is a look at his repertoire so far this season.
