THE TWINS: Began their final roadtrip of the season by splitting the first two games in Detroit,
winning game one on Friday night, followed by a loss last nighttoday, the Twins will play the three-
game series finale at Comérica Park after this afternoon's game they will travel to Chicago to play
the White Sox for three games from Monday-Wednesday and complete the regular season schedule.
The lwins have gone 46-35 at home, compared to 31-46 on the roadthey have gone 2-8
in their last 10 road games and 4-18 in their last 22 away from Target Field.

MOTOWN LETDOWN: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 3-2... Dylan Bundy made his final start of the season and did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits as Luis Arraez went 2-for-5, raising his batting average to .315, cushioning his lead in the AL batting race by two points over Aaron Judge (.313)...Mark Contreras added a solo home run, the third of his career.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson...Woods Richardson, 22, split the minor league season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul. combining to go 5-3, 2.77 ERA (107.1 IP. 33 ER), 36 walks, 115 strikeouts and a 1.05 WHIP in 23 games (22 starts)...he ranked second among all Twins farmhands in WHIP (min. of 70.0 IP), third in strikeouts, innings pitched and ERA (min. of 70.0 IP) and was also tied for third in starts...he was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month for April while pitching for the Wind Surge and is currently listed as the organization's sixth-best prospect, per MLB.com...the 6-toot-3, 210-pound right-hander was acquired by the Twins via trade with Toronto along with infielder/outfielder Austin Martin on July 30, 2021, in exchange for right-handed pitcher José Berríos...the Sugar Land, Texas native was originally selected by the Mets in the second round (48th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Kempner High School and has gone 15-18, 3.67 ERA (284.2 IP, 116 ER), 98 walks, 344 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 71 games (66 starts) over four minor league seasons with the Mets, Blue Jays and Twins organizations...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Iwins have optioned right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez...to make room on 40-man roster, the Iwins have optioned right-handed Sandy León to the 60-day Injured List (right knee meniscus surgery).

CATCH 22: Woods Richardson was born on September 27, 2000 and turned 22-years-old five days ago...he's the second player born in the 2000s in Twins history (1961-present), joining Ronny Flenriquez (born June 20, 2000)...the duo are the two youngest players to pitch in the majors this season, with Woods Richardson being the youngest.

The At age 22,005, Woods Richardson is the youngest player to debut for the Twins since Brusdar Graterol (age 21,006) on September 1, 2019 at Detroit...he's also the youngest to debut as a starting pitcher since José Berrios (age 21,336) on April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the last of 19 meetings in 2022... Twins are 11-7 against Detroit this season, going 7-2 at Target Field and 4-5 at Comerica Park.

These two will meet for 10 games in 2023, starting with a four-game series at Target Field from June 15-18.

11 wins over the Tigers are their most since going 14-5 in 2019...their season-high for wins over Detroit in a season is 15, done in 2001 and 2003.

Twins most wins vs. any opponent this season: KC — 12, DET — 11, CWS — 9 and CLE — 6.

Gio Urshela is a career .331 (44-for-133) hitter with an .848 OPS in 42 games against the Tigers. he is hitting .387 (24-for-62) with three doubles, two home runs. 13 RBI and a .961 OPS in 17 games vs. the Tigers this season...he has multiple hits eight times this season and in four of his last six games.

Jose Miranda is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with a .386 OBP in 12 games vs. the Tigers this season.

C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa has reached safely in 18-straight games, hitting .338 (25-for-74) with a .402 on-base percentage and a .929 OPS in that span. .18 is tied for the second-longest streak of his career, with his career-high being 27 in 2017 with Houston... additionally, since September 1, Correa has hit .339 (39-for-115) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .397 on-base percentage, a .583 slugging percentage and a .979 OPS.
