**ANOTHER MOTOWN LETDOWN:** The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-2...Simeon Woods Richardson (0-1) made his major league debut as the club's starter, allowing three runs (2 earned) on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts... SWR became the 13th Twin to debut this season, second-most in club history (14 in 2017)... the offense recorded just three hits, including two from Carlos Correa, who also drove in one of the Twins' two runs...the Twins finished their season against the Tigers with a record of 11-8.

TWINS-SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 17th of 19 meetings this season...the Twins are 9-7 against the Sox in 2022, going 6-4 at Target Field and 3-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

♣ This series was originally scheduled to open the 2022 season, from March 31-April 3, but was rescheduled due to the offseason MLB work stoppage.

♣ Twins pitchers have posted a 2.00 ERA (36.0 IP, & ER) with five walks, 37 strikeouts and a .195 (25-for-128) opponent batting average in their last four games vs. the Sox.

♣ Luis Arraez has hit safely in 24 of his last 25 games against the White Sox, dating back to July 5, 2021, hitting .373 (38-for-102) in that span...in 16 games against the Sox this season, he is hitting .371 (26-for-70) with a .405 on-base percentage and an .871 OPS.

**GAME OF THRONES:** Arraez is looking to become the fifth different Twin to win the AL batting title, joining Rod Carew (7x), Joe Mauer (3x), Tony Oliva (3x), and Kirby Puckett...the 14 batting titles for the Twins are the fifth-most in AL/NL history (since 1901), trailing the Detroit Tigers (28), Boston Red Sox (26), Pittsburgh Pirates (24) and St. Louis Cardinals (23).

JOSE HITS: Jose Miranda is hitting .353 (12-forr-34) in his last eight games...Miranda made his debut on May 2 at Baltimore and began his major league career by hitting .094 (5-for-53) with a .332 OPS in his first 14 games...in 108 games since then, he has hit .294 (114-for-388) with an .810 OPS...below are Miranda's ranks in a few offensive categories among all AL rookies with a minimum of 300 at-bats this season:

C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa has reached safely in a 2022 team-high 19-straight games, hitting .351 (27-for-77) with a .419 on-base percentage and a .964 OPS in that span...19 is the second-longest streak of his career, with his career-high being 27 in 2017 with Houston...additionally, since September 1, Correa has hit .347 (41-for-118) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, a .408 on-base percentage, a .593 slugging percentage and a 1.001 OPS in 29 games. 
◆ Correa is now hitting .289 (149-for-516) in 134 games on the season, the second-highest mark of his career after he hit .315 in 109 games with Houston in 2017...he has raised his batting average 26 points in 48 games since August 12, going from .263 to .289. 
◆ He is hitting .423 (11-for-26) with a 1.115 OPS in his last 21 games with runners in scoring position...he is 7-for-his-last-16 with RISP.

**G-FORCE:** Gio Urshela has 139 hits on the season, tying his single-season career-high, done in 2019 with New York-AL...this season, he has set career-highs in games (141), at-bats (491) and walks (40)...in his last 25 games, dating back to game two on September 7 at New York-AL, he is hitting .385 (35-for-91) with five doubles, one home run, nine RBI, 14 runs scored, 10 walks and a .924 OPS.

OCTOBER 3RD FOR THE WIN(FIELD): Happy 71st birthday to Hall of Famer, former Twin and St. Paul native Dave Winfield...Winfield played two season for the Twins and recorded his 3,000th career hit at the Metrodome on September 16, 1993.

LAST TIME OUT: Ober earned the win in his last start on September 27 vs. the White Sox at Target Field...tossed a career-high 7.1 shutout innings, allowing just two base runners (2 H, 1 BB) while fanning a career-high 10 batters in a 4-0 Twins victory...tossed a season-high 91 pitches, two shy of his career high of 93 (done on July 5, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL)...became the first Twins pitcher to allow two-or-fewer hits and strike out at least 10 batters in a start of 7.0-plus shutout innings since José Berríos (7.0 IP, 2 H, 0 BB, 11 K) on July 31, 2019 at Miami.

Also became just the third Twins pitcher to record an out in the eighth inning this season, joining Dylan Bundy on June 18 at Arizona (8.0 IP) and Joe Ryan on September 18 at Cleveland (7.2 IP).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ober took the 5-2 loss on September 21 at Kansas City, allowing three runs on seven hits (1 home run), with one walk and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...yielded a pair of runs in the first inning on an MJ Melendez home run and a Salvador Perez RBI double, the second time in his career he's permitted multiple runs in the opening frame (also, July 20, 2021 at Chicago-AL).

**REHAB AND RETURN REDUX:** Ober was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List prior to his start on September 16, after missing 89 games with injuries related to a right groin strain; was originally placed on the Injured List on June 6 (retroactive to June 3)... an MRI and subsequent second opinions in late June revealed an aponeurotic plate injury, for which

an MRI and subsequent second opinions in late June revealed an aponeurotic plate injury, for which the only cure is rest...this most recent stint on the IL was Ober's second of the season, after missing time from April 30-May 21 with a similar injury.

Prior to his reinstatement, Ober made a trio of rehab starts earlier this month, two with Low-A Fort Myers on September 1 and 6, and one with Triple-A St. Paul on September 11...posted a combined 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in those outings.

Returned to the mound on September 1 at Bradenton, allowing one run on three hits (1 home run), with no walks and three strikeouts, throwing 42 pitches...ramped up further in his next outing for Fort Myers on September 6 vs. St. Lucie; worked 4.0 shutout innings, with just one hit and one walk allowed, and three strikeouts while throwing 52 pitches...increased both his inning and pitch counts further in his final rehab outing on September 11 for St. Paul at Toledo; allowed one run on a solo homer, with two walks and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work, while throwing 66 pitches.

FAMILIAR FOE: Ober is facing the White Sox for the third time this season and eighth time in his career, his most outings against any single opponent; has gone 2-1, 3.34 ERA (35.0 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks and 40 strikeouts in his seven prior starts (Twins are 5-2)...earned the win over Chicago-AL in his last start on September 27 and earlier this season, did not factor into the decision of a 2-1 Twins win on April 22 at Target Field (5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 6 K).
